**Come On In!**

**Hospitality has been defined** as entertaining your guests and caring for their needs. It is a gracious custom. However, in some ancient communities it was necessary for survival. Travelers were vulnerable to the climate and topography of an unfamiliar area, as well as to its inhabitants. Every stranger was a potential enemy. Conversely, the traveler might be a thief, murderer, or a spy sent ahead to reconnoiter his enemies. People had to be on their guard, and travelers never really knew how others would receive them. They could be robbed by their host, captured, enslaved, or even put to death.

To guarantee protection on all sides, a certain protocol of hospitality had to be presumed and observed. The host was expected to treat all travelers as guests, not as potential enemies. Such treatment was thought to neutralize any threat to the household. The traveler was expected to act as a guest rather than a threat, accepting the generosity of the host for necessary food, drink, and shelter. Such hospitality was a temporary arrangement, but it assured everyone of a degree of safety.

We see traces of this custom in the first reading from Genesis. Surprise! The visitors were no ordinary travelers. They were messengers from God. In the Gospel reading, Jesus was a guest in the home of Martha and Mary. Their hospitality flowed from love, not social custom. Furthermore, he was no ordinary traveler. Both readings encourage us to practice hospitality. You never know who might appear as a guest.

**PRAYER AND SERVICE**

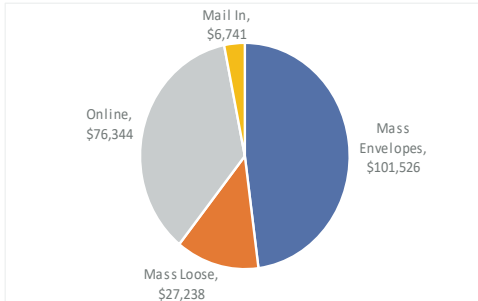

In the Gospel today, Jesus tells Martha that her concern about doing the right thing as dictated by Jewish tradition might not be the best use of her energies. Her sister, Mary, who sits in rapt attention at Jesus' feet, should not be rebuked. Is Jesus trying to show Martha that she needs to make time for her spiritual nourishment? Abraham and Sarah in the first reading seem to be just like Martha. And yet Abraham's eager welcome and joyful serving of his "visitors" seems almost spiritual. How like Paul, in the second reading, rejoicing in his service to the gospel!

We hear in the psalm that those who do justice will live in the Lord's presence. Prayer and service—what greater joy could there be?

**Overnight volunteers needed for SGG's Family Promise ministry, supporting local host congregations that provide shelter to homeless families with children**

There are over 700 homeless children in Beaufort County. Family Promise is an interfaith non-profit organization committed to helping homeless families with children achieve lasting independence. They help families accomplish this by providing **shelter**, meals and support services for them, and by offering programs designed to address the underlying causes of homelessness. Their promise is to link those in need with those who want to help. Those who benefit from the efforts of Family Promise are considered **guests**.

***Saint Gregory the Great participates in the network of Family Promise by being a support congregation, providing additional volunteers to augment existing teams in the facilities of 4 specific host congregations:***

- Lord of Life Lutheran (on Buckwalter Pkwy, opposite Exxon and McD's)
- Church of the Palms (on Hwy 170, just south of Argent Blvd intersection)
- Grace Coastal Church (on Hwy 170, about 1.3 miles north of 278)
- The Unitarian Fellowship of The Lowcountry (Malphrus Rd., 1 mile behind Lowe's)

#### How can you help?

Right now we are looking for volunteers to cover 1 overnight shift every 8 weeks at one of our host churches. The shift runs from 8 PM in the evening to 7 AM the next morning, and involves being present to our guests for conversation, support, and help with children until about 10 PM; then retiring to your own private quarters for reading, prayer, personal time and sleep.

Two hosts are needed for each overnight, so couples would be ideal, but singles are welcome, as are parent with teen child. Orientation will be provided.

We invite you to respond to Jesus' message in Matthew 25:31-46 when Our Lord said: ". . . Whatever you do for even these least brothers of mine, you do for me. . ."

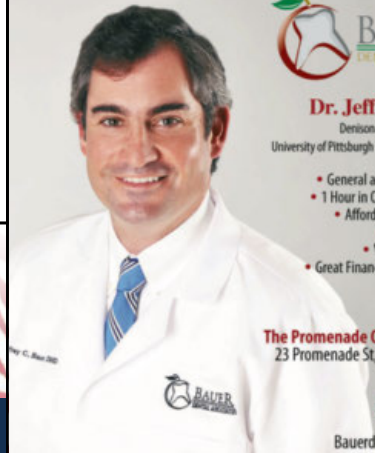

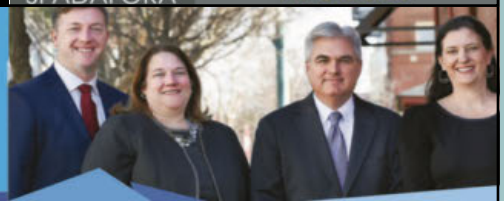

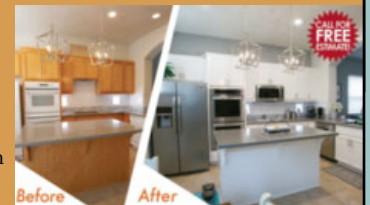
