The Power of Prayer

"I'll pray for you." What a simple promise. When we make this promise, what do we expect it will accomplish? The sentence is really a statement of faith. It assumes a caring relationship between us and those for whom we pray. It presumes the other person trusts that we do care. Most importantly, it acknowledges there is so much we humans cannot achieve by ourselves, and so we turn in confidence to God that our needs are the concern of God as well.

Today's first reading is the startling account of Abraham's prayer for two sinful cities. He pleads with God to spare them for the sake of any righteous citizens found there. God is willing to do that if righteous citizens can be found. Abraham prays for people who do not deserve God's mercy. But there it was. God's mercy outstrips the most horrendous crimes. Abraham kept pleading, and God kept saying, "All right."

The same persistence in prayer is found in the Gospel passage. The message there? Keep at it. We don't know whether the praying will end as Abraham's did or like that of the determined friend in the Gospel. That's not our concern, because the way prayer is answered belongs to God, not to us. So then why pray if we can't be confident about the answer? Because we believe we are connected to each other, and together we stand in need before a loving God who wants the best for us.

CONVERSATION WITH GOD

Prayer is our focus this weekend. In the Gospel, Jesus gives his disciples, and us, the Lord's Prayer, which we have cherished through the centuries. The first two words encompass much about our faith—unity among all Christians (Our), and a sense that we are in a deeply bonded relationship with God (Father). In Genesis, we see Abraham in conversational prayer, in his creaturely humility before his Creator, seeking mercy and compassion for the innocent. The psalm is a lyrical prayer of thanksgiving and praise for the God who answered the sincere prayers of a people who had called out for help, showing them mercy. In Luke's Gospel, the disciples want to pray like Jesus, with the same intimacy—to experience God as Abba in the depths of their being.

Do we try to talk to God? Do we listen for answers? This relationship is always a work in progress.

Saints Joachim & Anne and the Importance of Grandparents



On July 26, the Church celebrates the feast of Saints Joachim and Anne, the parents of Blessed Virgin Mary. Although their story is not in sacred Scripture, according to a pious tradition these two saints had been infertile throughout their married lives. Them, like Sarah (Genesis 21:2) and Elizabeth (Luke 1), St. Anne conceived in her old age. Their baby was the Blessed Virgin.

Since ancient times, Saint Joachim and Anne have been venerated in the Church as powerful intercessors. Most importantly, both of them are the patron saints of grandparents since they are the only biological grandparents of Our Lord.

Through his pontificate, Pope Francis has shown a special love for grandparents, He says, "the Holy Spirit . . . arouses thoughts and words of wisdom in the elderly today: their voice is precious because it sings the praise of God and guards the roots of peoples. They remind us that old age is a gift and that grandparents are the link between generations, to transmit to young people an experience of life and faith."

Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI also has a deep respect for grandparents. He said, "Who does not remember their grandparents? Who can forget their presence and their witness by the domestic hearth? How many of us bear their names as as a sign of continuity and gratitude!"

As we celebrate the feast of Saints Joachim and Anne this month - as well as the new World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly - we are reminded that the Church holds a high regard for seniors.

In the words of Pope Francis, "Grandparents are a treasure. Often old age isn't pretty, right? There is sickness and all that, but the wisdom our grandparents have is something we must welcome as an inheritance."

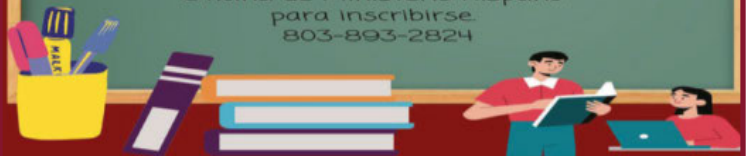

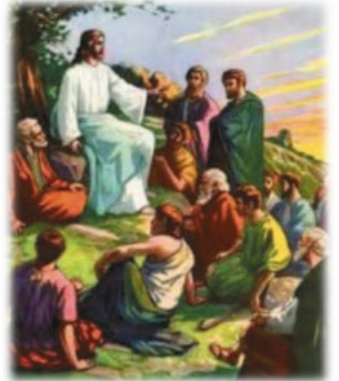


ADORACIÓN

Decimoséptimo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario UNA CONVERSACIÓN CON DIOS

Este fin de semana ponemos nuestra atención en la oración. En el Evangelio, Jesús da a sus discípulos, y a nosotros, la oración del Padre Nuestro, que durante siglos hemos apreciado. Las dos primeras palabras abarcan mucho de nuestra fe: la unidad entre todos los cristianos (Nuestro), y un sentido de que estamos en una relación profundamente vinculada con Dios (Padre). En el libro de Génesis, vemos a Abraham en una oración de conversación, en su humildad de creatura ante su Creador, buscando misericordia y compasión por un inocente. El salmo es una oración poética de agradecimiento y alabanza al Dios que respondió a las oraciones sinceras de un pueblo que había pedido ayuda, mostrando su misericordia. En el Evangelio de Lucas, los discípulos quieren orar como Jesús, con la misma intimidad, para experimentar a Dios como Abba en lo más profundo de su ser. ¿Intentamos nosotros de hablar con Dios? ¿Escuchamos las respuestas? Esta relación siempre es un trabajo en progreso.

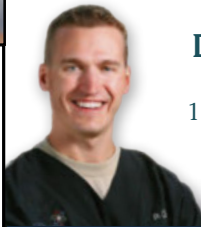
