MESSAGE FROM FATHER WILSON

Dear Friends in Christ,

In the baptism of Christ in the waters of Jordan the sky opened and the voice of the Father was heard: “*You are my beloved Son.*” We too are those dear children, adopted children, reborn in the waters of baptism by the power of the Holy Spirit.

St. Gregory Nazianzen wrote: “*He plunged into the water alone, but he lifted up the entire world; he stooped down to raise us up; he bore all our sins so that we would stay forgiven.*” Just as the Epiphany was the manifestation of Christ in Bethlehem as the son of Mary, Christ’s baptism in the Jordan is his manifestation as the “*Son of the Father*” and the beginning of his public life.

When our parents asked for the grace of baptism for us even though we were very young, they knew that they were giving us a great treasure and leaving us their best inheritance. Exteriously, it is a washing in water. With this sign, Christ cleanses us from all guilt and begets us again into the divine life, unites us intimately to himself, imprints his own image on our soul in an indelible way, incorporates us into the Church and into the people of God, and sanctifies us with the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

A Christian is one who follows Christ in everything. The Christian life is based on the fundamental and irreversible decision to adhere to Christ, follow him and imitate him. But how? And when? In all situations of life: the joys, hardships, at work, at rest, in risk, temptation, and death. The Christian seeks to reproduce in his own life what Christ would do in his place, so he grows familiar with the Gospel readings to find Christ’s words and examples.

Through the sacrament of baptism we are born to new life, we partake of the life of God, and we are marked with an identity stamp that will identify us forever. Just as Jesus’ baptism in the Jordan River marks the beginning of his redemptive mission, a Christian’s baptism is the fundamental and decisive event that dominates his way of being, thinking and acting and influences him altogether. Today is a day when we remember the privilege of our baptism and renew our commitments as new men and women in Christ. May we never forget this great event in our lives!




