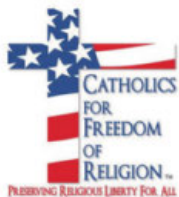

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK



This is the proper name for what is sometimes mistakenly called "Last Rites" or "Extreme Unction." It is meant for anyone who has a serious illness, is facing surgery, or even is dealing with the effects of old age. It should not be limited to the dying. As the Letter of St. James says clearly, "Are there any who are sick among you? Let them send for the priests of the Church, and let the priests pray over them, anointing them with oil in the name of the Lord..." It is a sacrament of healing for spirit, mind and often body. It is administered at a monthly Mass, usually the first Wednesday, and anytime on request.

PLEASE NOTE THAT FR. OSCAR WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE DURING THE WEEKENDS FOR THIS SACRAMENT. Please call the church office and schedule this anointing during the week.

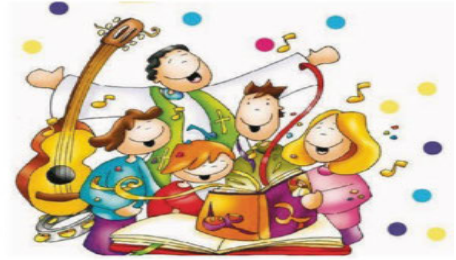
