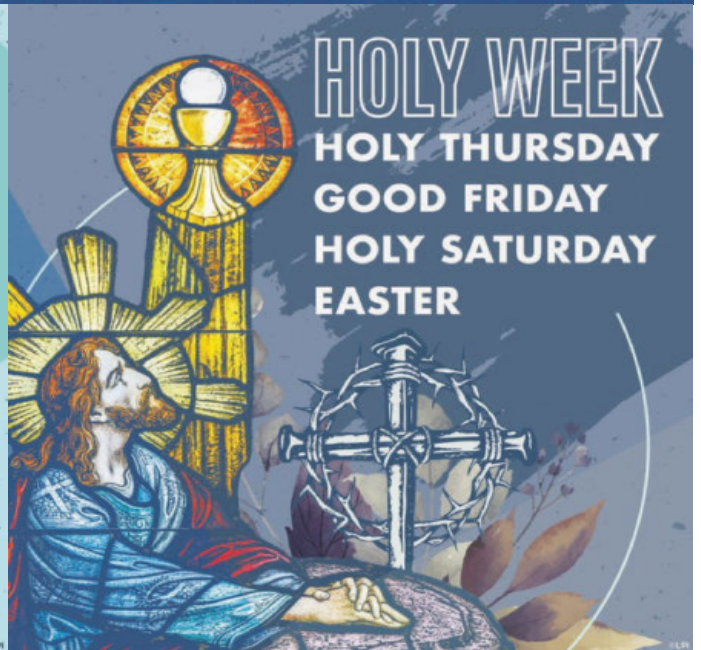
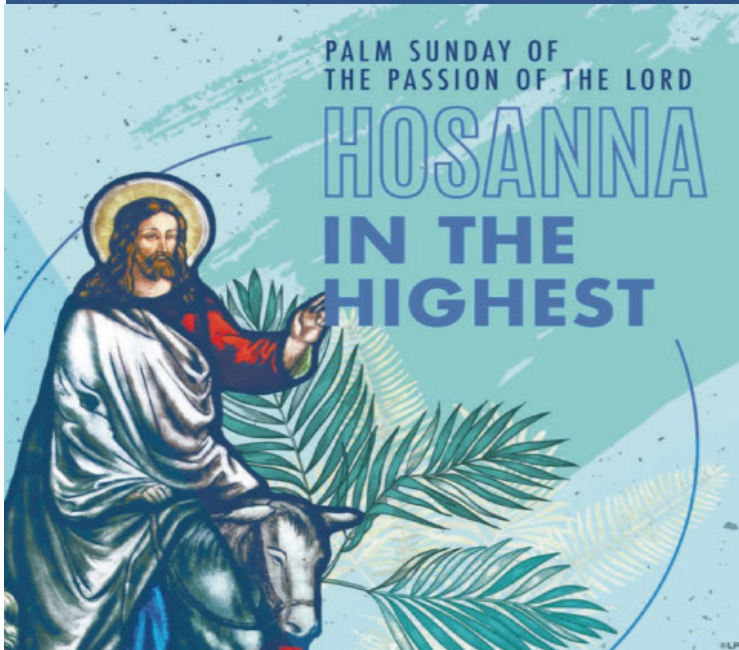

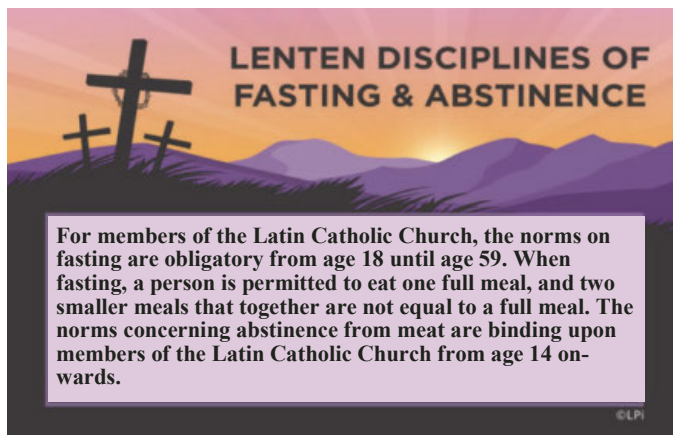

**PALM SUNDAY: A LOVE THAT SAVES**

Dear Parishioners,

Two brothers lived together in one apartment. The elder was honest, hardworking, and God-fearing. The younger was reckless—addicted to substances, surrounded by violence, and lost in crime. Many nights, the elder brother pleaded with him, urging him to change, but the younger never listened.

One fateful night, the younger brother stormed in, shaken, gun in hand, blood on his clothes: “I killed a man,” he confessed. Sirens wailed outside as police surrounded the apartment. With no time left, the elder brother did the unimaginable—he swapped clothes with his guilty sibling. The innocent brother was arrested, tried, and condemned to death. He died so his younger brother could live. It’s a painful story, but also a story of **love**—deep, selfless love. This is the kind of love we encounter this week. The Passion of Christ is not simply a tragedy. It is **God’s love story for us**—His innocent Son taking our place, dying so that we might live. How should we respond? With **gratitude**.

Gratitude that transforms us—turning us away from sin, helping us to live a life worthy of the One who gave everything for us.

Gratitude that keeps the memory of Christ alive—not just in our minds, but in our actions. Gratitude that shows itself in love—love for His people, for His Church, for the broken, and the least among us.

This Holy Week, let us walk with Jesus:

- **Palm Sunday** – We wave our palms and sing "Hosanna," welcoming Christ the King. But let’s remember: this King enters humbly, riding a donkey. And if the Lord has need of your “donkey”—your time, your gifts, your heart—will you offer it?
- **Holy Thursday** – We celebrate the gift of the **Eucharist** and the **priesthood**—Jesus stooping low to wash feet, and lifting us high through His Body and Blood.
- **Good Friday** – We venerate the Cross—the tree on which Love hung for our sake. God’s love wasn’t abstract. It was pierced, nailed, and bled.
- **Holy Saturday** – In the silence of the tomb, new fire, new water, new life is prepared. The Easter Vigil calls us to keep watch, for the dawn of Resurrection is near.

As we journey through this sacred week, may we open our hearts to the One who died that we might live. And when Easter breaks upon us in glory, may our lives sing **Alleluia**—a song not just of joy, but of deep, grateful love. Please follow the Holy Week schedule and participate in the services with great devotion and love.
