



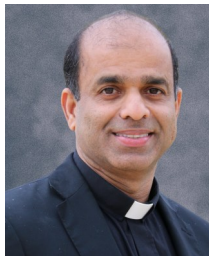

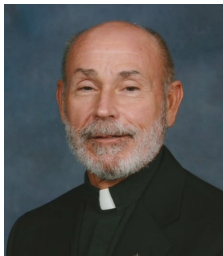

Dear Mary Queen Family,

Today, the Second Sunday of Easter is known as Divine Mercy Sunday. It invites us to rest in the boundless love and mercy of God. Flowing from the Heart of the Risen Christ, Divine Mercy reminds us that no sin is too great, no burden too heavy, and no soul beyond the reach of His compassion. Today, we are called to trust more deeply in Jesus, to open our hearts to His forgiveness, and to extend that same mercy to others.

Over the years, I have read and written about the tragedies of Shakespeare. In his play *The Merchant of Venice*, he reflects on the beauty of mercy in words that have always stayed with me:

*“The quality of mercy is not strained;
it drops as the gentle rain from heaven
upon the place beneath.
It is twice blest:
it blesses him that gives and him that takes.”*

St. Thomas Aquinas once said, “Mercy is the greatest attribute of God.” In other words, mercy is love in action. As Jesus tells us, “Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them.” This gift and mission are given to all of us who have been baptized into the Risen Christ. Having been reconciled to the Lord, we are sent forth as ministers of reconciliation. God calls us to be His agents of love and mercy.

Mercy means caring for the needs of others. When we live with true concern for one another, no one is left out and no one is left in need. Yet our society is often wounded by individualism, indifference, and division. Too often, we fall into the mindset of “mind your own business,” guarding our lives with a kind of isolation that keeps us from one another. But the truth is simple: care is a form of healing.

As St. Faustina reminds us, we are called to be instruments of God’s mercy. Let us go forth, then, as witnesses of His love—bringing compassion, forgiveness, and hope to all we encounter.

JESUS I TRUST IN YOU

Divine Mercy Sunday

Divine Mercy Sunday is celebrated on the Sunday after Easter. It was established for the universal Church in 2000 by Pope John Paul II during the canonization of St. Faustina Kowalska.

The devotion originates from the private revelations received by St. Faustina in the 1930s, in which Jesus emphasized the urgency of trusting in God's mercy. Among the requests recorded in her diary was the institution of a feast dedicated to Divine Mercy, to be celebrated on the Sunday after Easter.

The Plenary Indulgence

On Divine Mercy Sunday, the Church grants a plenary indulgence, meaning the complete remission of all temporal punishment due to sin for a soul properly disposed. This indulgence follows the same norms as all plenary indulgences, but is specifically connected to Divine Mercy devotions on this day.

Conditions for Receiving the Indulgence According to the Apostolic Penitentiary:

- Sacramental Confession (within about 20 days before or after)
- Holy Communion (received on Divine Mercy Sunday)
- Prayer for the intentions of the Pope (e.g., an Our Father and Hail Mary)
- Complete detachment from all sin, even venial
- Participation in Divine Mercy devotions, such as attending Mass and prayers in honor of Divine Mercy; praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet in church before the Blessed Sacrament; or praying before the tabernacle with devotion to Divine Mercy

** An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven*



Our priests are being called into great heroic action, all while pouring out an overabundant amount of love and support for all of us. In 2020, the Vocation Ministry launched the "Uplift Your Priest" campaign on the Monday after the 2nd Sunday of Easter. This campaign inspires the laity to affirm and encourage our priests, especially after Lent and Easter.

Ways to Uplift Your Priest

- Call, text, or email your priest to let him know you're praying for him
- Offer a spiritual bouquet (a gift of prayers, Masses, sacrifices, or devotions offered for his intentions)
- Pray, fast, or make a small sacrifice specifically for him
- Send a handwritten thank-you card or note of encouragement
- Have a meal delivered or drop off dinner or lunch
- Bring popcorn or snacks for a simple movie night
- Send a gift card (Amazon or a local restaurant)
- Share drawings, paintings, or notes from children
- Create a short family video message or even a song of encouragement
- Write a message in chalk outside the church or rectory
- Post a photo with your priest and share a word of gratitude
- Invite others by tagging 3 friends or families to pray a Rosary for him
- Support the parish financially, if you are able
- Bring a note of thanks and share how your priest has made a difference in your life or your family
- And don't forget to remember our retired priests, too. Their years of faithful service continue to bear fruit in the life of the Church.

Dear Parishioners of Mary Queen and Friends in the Friendswood Community, As we reflect on the blessings of this past Lenten season, the Knights of Columbus, Council 8494 would like to extend our sincere thanks for the wonderful support you showed during this year's Lenten Fish Fry. Your participation, encouragement, and fellowship are what make this tradition such a special part of Lent in our parish.

This year brought some remarkable numbers that reflect the generosity and enthusiasm of our community. Over the course of the six Fish Fry evenings, our volunteers were open for a total of nine hours and served 4,485 plates of fish, an average of one plate every 7.2 seconds. To make that happen, we cooked and served 2,200 pounds of fish, 1,900 pounds of French fries, and 600 pounds of hush puppies. In addition, we prepared 600 pounds of coleslaw and used 24 gallons of coleslaw dressing.

Behind these numbers are many dedicated volunteers and, most importantly, a parish and community that continues to show up year after year in support of this Lenten tradition. We are grateful for the fellowship it creates and for the opportunity it gives us to serve together.

Thank you, Mary Queen Parish and the Friendswood community, for making this year's Fish Fry such a success. We look forward to welcoming you again next Lent.

PRAY & REFLECT

April 12, 2026
2nd Sunday of Easter (Sunday of Divine Mercy)
John 20:19-31

“Then he said to Thomas, ‘Put your finger here and see my hands, and bring your hand and put it into my side, and do not be unbelieving, but believe.’” (John 20:27)

In my early 20s, I volunteered at a parish youth group. I witnessed teens encountering Jesus with a fresh, romantic wonder that reminded me of my own teenage conversion. But something had changed in me. I was quietly jaded and cynical. When teens shared stories of encountering Christ, I'd want to sarcastically murmur, “Well, good for you.” I had grown suspicious of the zeal I once knew.

Then we brought the group on a pilgrimage. I was standing in an old church in France, ignoring a long-winded tour guide. I found myself before a crucifix. In that moment, I heard something, not audibly, but unmistakably in my heart: “I came to be your friend... and you wish to be my enemy? Why do you stand far from me? I suffer gladly for you. I was pierced for you. Why do you run from me?” My heart opened. I saw how cold and cynical I had become. But Jesus had not given up on me. He had returned, and his mercy broke through.

So I can relate to the scoffing — and transformation — of Thomas when the Risen Jesus presents his wounds for inspection. Thomas is not simply doubting; he is guarded, suspicious, even cynical. But Jesus comes to him. No lecture. Just understanding and mercy. He invites Thomas to touch his wounds. This burns away his cynicism like the morning mist.

Divine Mercy Challenge: This week, rejoice with someone who is newly alive in faith. If your own heart has grown skeptical or tired, ask Jesus to help you. He will.

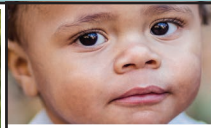
