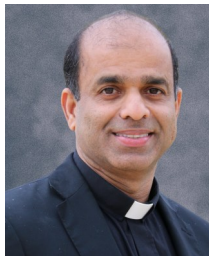

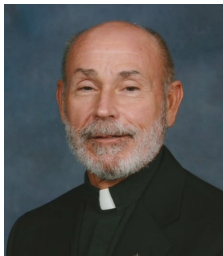

A MOMENT WITH *Mary*

The month of May is dedicated to Mary, Mother of Jesus. We encourage every parishioner to take "A Moment with Mary" each day.

Consider pausing at noon - or even several times throughout your day - to turn your heart to our Blessed Mother in prayer.

In these simple moments, we unite as a parish family, asking Mary to draw us closer to her Son, Jesus.

Whether at home, at work, or on the go, let this brief pause become a source of peace, grace, and connection with Christ.

Please pray this prayer each day.



DAILY PRAYER

O Mary, Mother of Jesus, gentle Mother, take my hand and lead me to your Son. Help me trust as you trusted. Draw me closer to Jesus each day, and keep me near His heart. Amen.

THE VIRTUES OF MARY

Humility

The Blessed Mother's virtue of humility shines quietly yet powerfully. In Mary, Mother of Jesus, we see a heart fully open to God's will, expressed in her simple "yes" at the Annunciation.

She does not seek recognition, but trusts completely, allowing God to work through her life. Her humility is not weakness, but strength rooted in surrender and faith.

By placing God at the center, Mary shows that true greatness is found not in being noticed, but in loving, serving, and trusting God in all things.

The Angelus

V. The Angel of the Lord declared unto Mary,
R. And she conceived of the Holy Spirit.

(Hail Mary...)

V. Behold the handmaid of the Lord.
R. Be it done unto me according to thy word.

(Hail Mary...)

V. And the Word was made flesh,
R. And dwelt among us.

(Hail Mary...)

Pray for us, O Holy Mother of God,
That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Let us pray.

Pour forth, we beseech thee, O Lord, thy grace into our hearts; that we, to whom the Incarnation of Christ, thy Son, was made known by the message of an angel, may by his Passion and Cross be brought to the glory of his Resurrection. Through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.

History

The Angelus prayer traces its origins to the 11th century, when the custom of reciting a Hail Mary three times in the evening in remembrance of the Annunciation first began. By the 14th century, this devotion included morning and midday prayers and was supported by the ringing of the Angelus bell. Named for the opening words of the prayer in Latin, 'Angelus Domini,' it reminds the faithful of the Incarnation of Christ and the cooperation of Mary. The prayer has become a cherished devotion for Catholics around the world.

Meaning

The Angelus is a meditative prayer focused on the mystery of the Incarnation. It helps us reflect on the angel's greeting to Mary, her openness and humility in accepting God's will, and the incredible mystery of the Word made flesh, who came to dwell among us and redeem the world. The Angelus is traditionally marked by the ringing of the Angelus bell, whereas the *Ave Regina Caelorum* is recited during the Easter Season instead.

When to Pray

The Angelus is prayed three times each day: at dawn, mid-day, and dusk—times that sanctify the day as they recall the Incarnation. Traditionally, the Angelus is preceded or followed by the ringing of the Angelus bell.

We genuflect during the line "And dwelt among us," as a sign of reverence for the Incarnation of our Lord Jesus Christ.

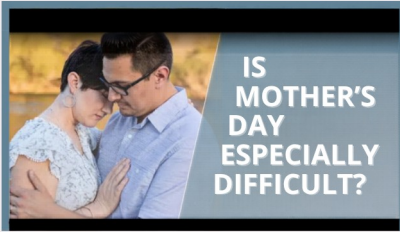

Thursday, May 7 - Confirmation

On May 7, roughly 80 of our Mary Queen teens will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.

"Baptism, the Eucharist, and Confirmation together constitute the 'sacraments of Christian initiation,' whose unity must be safeguarded. It must be explained to the faithful that the reception of the sacrament of Confirmation is necessary for the completion of baptismal grace. For 'by Confirmation, [the baptized] are more perfectly bound to the Church and are enriched with a special strength of the Holy Spirit. Hence they are, as true witnesses of Christ, more strictly obliged to spread and defend the faith by word and deed.'"

(Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1285)

PRAY & REFLECT

May 3, 2026
5th Sunday of Easter
John 14:1-12

We generally approach life with the question, "What can this do for me?" We try a new workout, a low-carb diet, intermittent fasting, or a new career path, hoping it will make us healthier, stronger, happier. The assumption is that if I invest in this, I'll eventually reap some benefit, or I won't do it.

It is easy to think of faith the same way: if I really practice my faith, what will it do for me? Will it make me calmer, more moral, more successful?

But in today's Gospel, Jesus says something astonishing. He doesn't present himself as a teacher who shows us the way to life. He says, "I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life." (John 14:6) He is not merely a guide toward some higher benefit. He is the benefit itself. To know him is to know Life.

Thomas Aquinas explains that every desire in the human heart — love, joy, meaning, all of our restless cravings — is really an indirect cry for life. Even despair testifies to this longing: people despair precisely because they feel they are not, and might never be, fully alive.

The good news is that Jesus is not simply the means to a better life; He is Life itself. To believe in him is to share in God's own eternal vitality. Not simply later but even now. Faith is not a transaction that produces results — it is a union that fills us with joy. To be in communion with Christ is to be truly, fully alive.

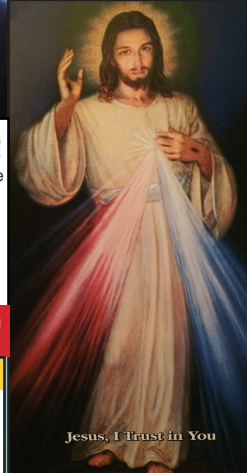

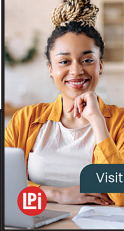
