

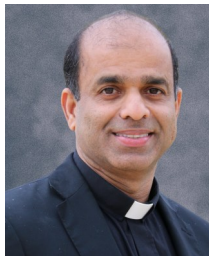

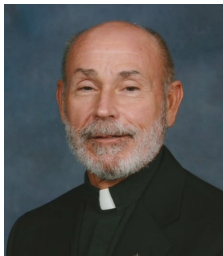

Dear Mary Queen Family,

One of the greatest joys in the life of the Church is welcoming a child into the family of God through the Sacrament of Baptism. We are grateful to walk alongside families as they prepare for this beautiful and sacred moment in the life of their child.

Families interested in scheduling a baptism are encouraged to begin by visiting our parish website for information regarding the preparation process and required documents. After reviewing the information, parishioners are welcome to contact the parish office with any questions.

Parents seeking baptism for their child should be registered members of Mary Queen or another Catholic parish. Families belonging to another Catholic parish will need a letter of permission from their pastor.

Once the parish office receives the completed baptism registration form, birth certificate or birth facts document, and Godparent Covenant forms, Anita will coordinate the next steps, including the baptism interview, preparation instructions, and the baptism class with Fr. Paul and Deacon Vince. Parents and godparents are ordinarily expected to attend the class in person. However, if attendance is not possible, arrangements may be made to complete the class online or at another parish, a practice that has remained available since the Covid pandemic. Baptism class certificates must be submitted at least one week before the baptism date.

After all paperwork has been reviewed and approved by Fr. Paul and Deacon Vince, the baptism date will be finalized.

Private Baptisms

I encourage families to celebrate baptisms during our communal parish baptisms, which take place on the third Sunday of each month following the 11:30 AM Mass. These celebrations beautifully reflect the communal nature of our Catholic faith and allow our parish family to share in the joy of welcoming new members into the Church.

Families seeking a private baptism for a serious reason may request special permission through the pastor. To avoid confusion, all baptisms — whether communal or private — must be scheduled through the parish office.

The same general process applies to weddings, funerals, wake services, and convalidations. Ministerial assignments are made by the pastor, who then assigns assisting clergy as needed.

I hope these guidelines are helpful to you as we continue to celebrate the sacraments together as a parish family.

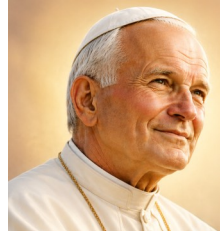

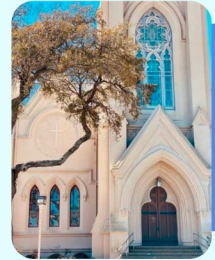

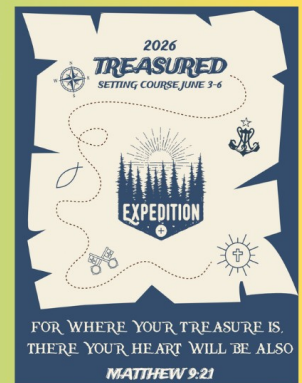

PRAY & REFLECT

May 31, 2026
The Most Holy Trinity
John 3:16-18

I was 16 years old on a youth group retreat in the mountains. One night, I opened my heart to the message being proclaimed: that God so loved the world that He sent His Son for us. Later, I lay under the pine trees and looked up at the countless stars. They seemed different. No longer cold, distant balls of chemical reactions, they appeared as an expression of God's love, as if He were giving those stars directly to me. The truth of God sending His Son changed how I saw the whole universe.

That is what today's Gospel reveals: "*God so loved the world that he gave his only Son.*" (John 3:16) The universe is not just a whirl of impersonal forces or empty space. At its heart is a gift: the Father eternally giving the Son, not to condemn, but to bring life.

This is not abstract doctrine but deeply personal. God gives His Son for you and me. Each human life is precious enough to be caught up in that eternal gift.

It is in the Mass where we encounter this most directly. In the Word proclaimed, in the assembly gathered, in the priest, and above all in the Eucharist, the Father once again gives His Son. What looks like bread and wine is the drama of the Trinity, laboring to love us here and now.

The Trinity is not a puzzle to solve but the blazing Truth at the center of everything: the Father gives the Son for you and me. Lord, help us to see this more clearly.


