

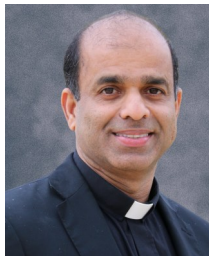

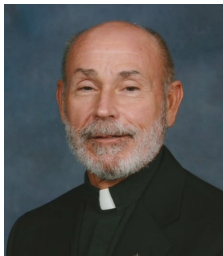

Dear Mary Queen Family,

As summer begins and another school year comes to a close, many families are looking forward to vacations, camping trips, family gatherings, and a slower pace of life. Summer can be a beautiful season of rest, renewal, and joyful time together. I encourage families to take advantage of these months by planning activities that everyone can enjoy, whether it be a day at the beach, a family barbecue, hiking, visiting relatives, or simply spending meaningful time together at home.

Children especially need time during the summer to recharge physically, emotionally, and spiritually. Encourage them to get adequate rest, spend time outdoors, and engage in healthy physical activity. In a world increasingly centered on screens, summer also offers an opportunity to build healthier habits. Please remain attentive to your children's use of electronic devices, social media, and online content. While technology can be helpful and entertaining, without guidance it can also become harmful, distracting, or isolating.

At the same time, parents are encouraged to remain attentive to the friendships and influences shaping their children's lives. Summer often brings greater freedom and less structure. Knowing where your children are, who they spend time with, and the values influencing them remains an important part of loving and responsible parenting.

Most importantly, while school may pause for the summer, our faith does not take a vacation. Catholics are not dispensed from participating in Sunday Mass simply because of travel or summertime activities. In fact, summer can become a beautiful opportunity to deepen our relationship with God as a family. Whether at home or away, I encourage you to make Sunday Mass a non-negotiable part of your summer plans. If you are traveling, take a few moments beforehand to locate a nearby Catholic church so your family may continue to worship together.

Children learn what is truly important not only from what we say, but from what we consistently do. When parents place God at the center of family life, children grow to understand that faith is not merely one activity among many, but the foundation upon which everything else rests.

May this summer be filled with joy, safety, rest, and God's abundant blessings for all our families.

PRAY & REFLECT

June 7, 2026

The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ
John 6:51-58

When I was a young altar server, I once overheard two very different comments about the Eucharist. One person asked, "Is Father distributing the bread or the wine?" Later, another asked, "Can you go get Jesus from the tabernacle?" Same parish, same Mass, but two very different ways of speaking. I pondered: So, is it bread that we pretend is Jesus? Or is Jesus a tiny white thing in a box? I was utterly confused.

This Feast of Corpus Christi is an excellent time to think about how we should speak about the Eucharist. In today's Gospel, Jesus declares: "My flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink." (John 6:55) His words scandalized his listeners, who feared cannibalism, and even today puzzle many, who reduce them to metaphor. Both miss the truth.

The Church gives us better words that honor Jesus' words in the Gospel. After the consecration, we do not call it "bread" or "wine." Nor do we say, "a piece of Jesus" or even "Jesus." We say: the Eucharist. We say: the Body and Blood of Christ. We say: the Real Presence. We say: the Most Blessed Sacrament. These words safeguard the astonishing reality that Christ himself is truly present, whole and entire, under the appearances of bread and wine.

If we speak well about the Eucharist, we will think more clearly and believe more deeply. And if we believe more deeply, we will adore more truly the One who gives himself to us — not bread, not wine, but Jesus Christ himself, whole and entire.

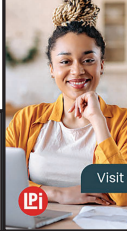
