

2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

God delights in you. How do you feel when you hear that? Delight usually comes with an exuberant flow of joy that seemingly arises from one's toes with the expression of great glee. Reflecting upon the deep measure of joy God has in us can be a source of joy for ourselves. Delight is infectious. A very young brother and sister were playing on the beach when the all too familiar ice cream truck made its daily rounds. The boy shook with excitement and delight as he took his sister's hand and exclaimed, "The ice cream man is here, isn't it great!" As they ran off toward the truck, one could hear the girl reply, "Yeah, I can't wait!" The experience of a child's delight in something so simple as ice cream, lifts our spirits from our burdens and transports us to the lighter, more innocent side of life.



Life is not meant to be a burden. Believe it or not, God actually wants us to be happy! In fact, the wedding feast at Cana shows us that God even puts His blessing on our happiness. It is okay to celebrate the wonder of ourselves and others. Life is good. It is always interesting to note that Jesus saves the good wine until last. You would think it would be the other way around. The superb quality of Jesus' wine points to the superior quality of life we find in Christ. It is not a life of burdens but a life of wonder and delight! In Christ, we are lifted from the superficial and mundane to a life of purpose, hope, and love.

God is with us through the long haul, through the challenges and sorrows as well as the successes and accomplishments. In spite of the fact that we often wander from the path, God's celebratory delight in us remains. As spouses are asked to remain faithful to each other through whatever life brings, God remains faithful too. This promise remains through this life and into the next. All we have to do is take the advice of Jesus' mother to heart when she says, "Listen to him." This wisdom saves us from foolishly giving in to the illusion that we can make better wine than Jesus.

2º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Con la fiesta de la Epifanía y el Bautismo del Señor se cierra el Tiempo de Navidad, que siempre es precedido por el Adviento. Ahora, comenzamos el Tiempo Ordinario. Serán siete domingos de este corto periodo, que termina el día anterior al Miércoles de Ceniza. La segunda etapa de este Tiempo es más larga, da comienzo después del domingo de Pentecostés y termina hasta el sábado antes del primer domingo de Adviento. ¿Para qué sirve a los cristianos este Tiempo Ordinario? ¿Qué nos pide la Liturgia de este tiempo? Pues, es muy sencillo, nos pide meditar en el misterio de Cristo. En su invitación de participar en su Reino con alegría y compromiso verdadero. La Iglesia tiene diversidad de carismas, donde podemos entregarnos al servicio de los demás.

Por ejemplo, hoy el Evangelio nos invita a participar junto con María y Jesús en las bodas de Caná. Y es ahí en esa boda, donde Jesús hace su primer milagro a petición de su Madre María. El diálogo de ambos viene a ser a causa de la falta de vino. Por lo tanto, los novios estaban en apuros por esta razón. Este relato es muy profundo, el hecho de que Jesús participa en la boda, tiene como significado la boda de Dios con la humanidad, que más adelante será la Sangre de Jesús derramada para la salvación de la humanidad. *"Alegrémonos, regocijémonos démosle honor y gloria, porque han llegado las bodas del Cordero"* (Apocalipsis 19,7). También, el profeta en la primera lectura lo pone claro: *"No te llamarán más 'Abandonada', ni a tu tierra 'Desolada', sino que te llamarán 'Mi Preferida' y a tu tierra 'Desposada'. Porque Yavé se complacerá en ti y tu tierra tendrá un esposo"* (Isaías 62,4).





FAITH REFLECTION

Jesus in the Eucharist #25 by Deacon Joe

At each and every mass that we attend a miraculous event occurs. Through the power of the Holy Spirit and the words of consecration uttered by the priest, the bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ. We are then invited to eat His Body and drink His Blood so that we might be transformed into ambassadors of God's love. We are sent forth to proclaim His Gospel in word and in deed. Throughout the centuries, God has provided miraculous events to substantiate this truth. One such event occurred in Augsburg, Germany in the year 1194. A woman who was particularly devoted to the Blessed Sacrament hid a host in her handkerchief, took it home and placed it in a wax container inside a cupboard. Five years passed and on the 11th of May 1199, the woman tormented by remorse confessed what she had done. Fr. Bertold insisted she return the Host. When he opened the wax container he saw that the Host had been transformed into bleeding Flesh. Bishop Udalskalk ordered that the Host be transferred to the cathedral and exhibited in a crystal monstrance for public worship. The miracle continued: the Host began to grow and swell, and this phenomenon was seen by all from Easter Sunday until the feast of St. John the Baptist. Beside the Eucharistic miracle, other extraordinary events took place, such as the apparition above the Host of Baby Jesus dressed in white with a radiant face, His forehead encircled by a crown of gold, the bleeding of the church's crucifix, and the apparition of Jesus blessing the assembly.



En todas y cada una de las misas a las que asistimos ocurre un evento milagroso. Por el poder del Espíritu Santo y las palabras de consagración pronunciadas por el sacerdote, el pan y el vino se convierten en el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo. Por lo tanto, somos invitados a comer Su Cuerpo y beber Su Sangre para que podamos ser transformados en embajadores del amor de Dios enviados a proclamar Su Evangelio en palabra y obra. A lo largo de los siglos, Dios ha provisto eventos milagrosos para corroborar esta verdad. Uno de estos eventos ocurrió en Augsburgo, Alemania, en el año 1194. Una mujer particularmente devota del Santísimo Sacramento escondió una hostia en su pañuelo, la llevó a su casa y la colocó en un recipiente de cera dentro de un armario. Pasaron cinco años y el 11 de mayo de 1199, la mujer atormentada por el remordimiento confesó lo que había hecho. Padre Bertold insistió en que le devolviera la Hostia. Cuando abrió el recipiente de cera vio que la Hostia se había transformado en Carne sangrante. El obispo Udalskalk ordenó que la Hostia fuera trasladada a la catedral y exhibida en una custodia de cristal para el culto público. El milagro continuó: la Hostia comenzó a crecer e hincharse, y este fenómeno fue visto por todos desde el Domingo de Resurrección hasta la fiesta de San Juan Bautista. Además del milagro eucarístico, se produjeron otros acontecimientos extraordinarios, como la aparición sobre la Hostia del Niño Jesús vestido de blanco con el rostro radiante, la frente rodeada por una corona de oro, el sangrado del crucifijo de la Iglesia y la aparición de Jesús bendiciendo a la asamblea.







Saint of the Week

Not much is known about the life of St. Sebastian (256 – 287), except that he was a Roman martyr whose name has been mentioned throughout history since early 350.

We see St. Sebastian many times in art, especially from iconic paintings from Guido Reni, Andrea Mantegna and Hendrick ter Brugghen. Historical scholars now agree that a spiritual story has the beloved saint entering the Roman army because only there could he assist Christian martyrs without arousing suspicion on himself. Eventually he was found out, brought before Emperor Diocletian and delivered to Mauritanian archers to be shot to death. Pierced with arrows, he was left for dead, but managed to survive. He recovered from his wounds but still refused to leave.

One day, St. Sebastian took up a position near where the emperor was to pass. He confronted the emperor, condemning him for his cruelty to Christians. This time the sentence of death was carried out, and St. Sebastian was beaten to death with clubs. Today he is the patron saint of athletes.
