CONSECRATION TO ST. JOSEPH



Our Holy Father Pope Francis recently declared 2021 as the Year of St. Joseph. St. Joseph is the Patron of the Universal Church and the Terror of Demons. In observance of the year of St. Joseph, Good Shepherd will offer Consecration to St. Joseph classes on Monday mornings and Monday evenings, in-person and virtual, depending on interest level. The program begins on February 15th.

“What does it mean to consecrate yourself to St. Joseph?”

It basically means that you acknowledge that he is your spiritual father, and you want to be like him. Father Francisco Valdovinos, priest of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Mecca, dies of COVID-19

Father Francisco Valdovinos, the Catholic priest of Our Lady of Guadalupe Church in Mecca, has died of COVID-19. He was 58. The Missionary Servants of the Most Holy Trinity announced his death on Facebook Sunday night. Over nearly three decades, Valdovinos served on behalf of the religious order in Puerto Rico and Costa Rica, as well as California and Tennessee.

"We entrust him now to God, the giver of all life, and implore Our Lady of Guadalupe to welcome him into the kingdom," Father Mike Barth, general custodian of the religious order, said in a statement. "We must all be grateful for his life and the zealous and tireless ministry he provided not only to the people of Mecca but also the people of Compton, (Calif.) and Tallahassee, (Fla.)."



Arrangements for prayer, rosary and vigil will be available soon, he said.

Valdovinos' death is deeply felt among residents of the eastern Coachella Valley, who have been disproportionately sickened during the coronavirus pandemic. Within an hour of the church posting the news, nearly 100 people had commented, many writing: "Que descansen en paz." *Rest in peace.*

Valdovinos, who grew up in a farm-working family in Mexico and later immigrated to the United States, was dedicated to serving lower-income people, especially farmworkers and immigrants. That commitment was evident throughout last year, as he worked tirelessly to ensure parishioners from his Mecca church didn't go hungry during the pandemic.

"He dedicated his life to serve God's people, especially the poor," said Father Guy Wilson, who previously served as the pastor of Our Lady of Soledad in Coachella. Both Wilson and Valdovinos belong to The Missionary Servants of the Most Holy Trinity.

Valdovinos grew up in the town of Santa Ana, in the Mexican state of Michoacán, where his family harvested limes, Wilson said. Wilson served as a missionary in Mexico in the early 1980s and met Valdovinos, who was a teenager, at that time. Valdovinos was already a young adult with a job when another priest, Father Eugene Mueller, came to the parish and encouraged Valdovinos to pursue a priestly vocation, according to Trinity Missions, which provides communications on behalf of The Missionary Servants of the Most Holy Trinity. But Valdovinos had to complete some schooling before he could enter the seminary in Mexico City, and the school was hours from his home.

Undaunted, Valdovinos applied for a scholarship and began several years of study. He shared a crowded room in a boarding house with three or four other male students, often sleeping on the floor. While the school provided him with mid-day food, he spent many evenings eating inexpensive meals of avocados, tomatoes and tortillas on park benches.

After he was ordained in 1994, Valdovinos' missionary work in Tallahassee centered around immigrants working in the region's tomato fields, Wilson said. He led church services for the workers, organized food programs and mentored leaders so the work would continue after he left. In Compton, he worked closely with working families, many of whom were also immigrants.

"He's going to go into every situation and he's going to find out who has the greatest needs, and organize programs to touch those needs, whether it be food, whether it be educational opportunities, whether it be immigration support," Wilson said. "He had that gift of knowing the people and analyzing what their needs were, but then getting a hold of politicians, businesses or private citizens, to get them to be committed to the community also." Amid the pandemic, Valdovinos' Mecca church became an important site of COVID-19 relief.

Valdovinos held Mass outdoors, in a socially distanced fashion, and online. The church hosted virus testing events, and distributed tens of thousands of masks and more than 250,000 pounds of foods since March, according to Tom Dolan, executive director of Inland Congregations United for Change, which works with churches across Riverside and San Bernardino counties.

On top of regular food giveaways at the church, Valdovinos also took it upon himself to secure household staples, like beans, rice and sugar, for parishioners in need. Additionally, he always ensured there was warm food at the church, including tortillas, mole and chicken soup, according to Reyes Lopez, a Coachella Valley organizer with Inland Congregations United for Change.

"He wasn't afraid. He was always there, distributing food," Lopez said in Spanish. "He was brave. He didn't lock himself in the church and just hold virtual Masses." "I've worked in a lot of churches," he added. "I've never seen a priest do what he does."

And when families struggled to pay their rent, or electricity or water bills, Valdovinos was known to provide them money from his own pocket, according to church deacon Trinidad Porras.

Wilson said he visited the Mecca church in August and cautioned Valdovinos to be careful as he served the community. "I just said, 'Francisco, make sure you wear your mask,'" Wilson recalled. "Make sure other people around you wear their masks. Make sure you're washing your hands."

Valdovinos fell ill late last year. Parishioners continued meeting virtually over Facebook to pray for him, as Trinity Missions reported in periodic updates on the church's Facebook page that there was irreparable damage to his lungs. "After weeks in the hospital and on a respirator, his condition did not improve and his directives were followed," Barth said in his statement. "We are most grateful to the medical professionals who have patiently and compassionately cared for him."



Assembly member Eduardo Garcia, whose district includes the eastern Coachella Valley, said he was "heartbroken" by the death of "our friend and courageous community champion."

"His dynamic presence and deep love for our residents has left a lasting impact within Mecca and beyond," Garcia said in a statement. "He worked tirelessly, without fear, to support our Eastern Coachella Valley families, alleviate disparities, and uplift our most vulnerable. We must carry on his mission and quest for justice in honor of his legacy."

"Descanse en paz, Padre," he said. "Gracias por su servicio."

31 de enero - **San Juan Bosco**

Giovanni Melchior Bosco Ochienna conocido simplemente como Don Bosco es el santo italiano fundador de las tres ramas de la Familia Salesiana: Sociedad de San Francisco de Sales (**Congregación Salesiana**), Instituto de las Hijas de María Auxiliadora y Asociación de Salesianos Cooperadores. A los 9 años tuvo un sueño premonitorio donde nuestro Señor y la virgen María le decían que se ganaría con mansedumbre y amor a los niños pobres para Cristo. A su muerte, el 31 de enero de 1888, toda Turín salió a la calle durante tres días a honrar a Don Bosco por última vez. Cuarenta mil personas desfilaron ante su cadáver en la iglesia. Fueron tantos los milagros conseguidos al encomendarse a Don Bosco, que el Sumo Pontífice Pío XI lo canonizó cuando apenas habían pasado cuarenta y seis años de su muerte, en 1934, y lo declaró Patrono de los que difunden buenas lecturas y "**Padre y maestro de la juventud**". Su cuerpo permanece incorrupto en la Basílica de María Auxiliadora en Turín, Italia.
