

Father Gary writes

Today marks a new beginning in the Christian Calendar; Advent heralds a new year for the Church. During every Mass, immediately after the Our Father, the priest says a short prayer: *“Deliver us, Lord, we pray, from evil, graciously grant peace in our days, that, by the help of your mercy, we may be always free from sin and safe from all distress, as we await the blessed hope and the coming of our Savior, Jesus Christ.”* This prayer is particularly meaningful during Advent, the season when we consciously “await the blessed hope and the coming of our Savior, Jesus Christ” with joyful expectation. This kind of waiting is often difficult, as joy and expectation do not generally characterize our everyday experiences of waiting. Few of us are filled with hope when we experience travel delays. We shop online and are willing to pay for guaranteed two-day, or overnight delivery. We assume that Wi-Fi access will be fast and omnipresent – and we grow less patient when we have to wait for websites to load! Amid these everyday experiences, the season of Advent plays a crucial role in teaching and reminding us how we ought to wait with joyful expectation. PATIENCE is the key word of the Advent season. Are we a patient people? What do we have to do in order to embrace the gift, the quality of patience?

Advent also teaches us that we are to wait actively. The Sunday readings leave no room for passivity. They require, demand action. We do not wait in a state of apathy or indifference. Rather, as disciples of Jesus Christ, we are always open to continual conversion and transformation. We are always open to the call, the invitation, of John the Baptist to repentance. If we want to discover our true selves, our potential, and destiny we need a living relationship with our God. If we want to be the best version of ourselves we need a living relationship with our God through His Son, Jesus Christ by the power and working of the Holy Spirit. We are invited to focus our lives on God. Advent invites us to model our waiting on Mary, Mother of God. I am sure she carried uncertainty in her heart even though she said ‘yes’ to what was asked of her. But she waited patiently for God’s plan to be revealed through the Son she carried, and she never lost hope or allowed fear or apprehension to stifle her faith. Nothing is impossible for God! Over the last few months our faith and hope has been tested, but these are the very gifts we need to bring us through challenging and difficult times. Life is never going to be plain sailing, but it is the gift of faith which can lead us through choppy and very stormy waters.

The most obvious symbol of this season is the Advent Wreath. The CIRCLE reminds us that God has no beginning and end. God’s love is everlasting and universal. GREEN is the color of hope, the hope we receive from our faith in Christ, the God who comes among us. The FOUR CANDLES represent the four weeks of the season. The purple candles symbolize repentance, and the rose candle the gift of joy. Spread the joy and light of Christ! Happy New Church Year!

## STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION ON GUARD


The author of Saint Mark's Gospel was what we call a straight shooter. His writing style is plain, with no elaboration or sophistication. In today's Gospel reading he gets right to the point: be on your guard; stay awake; the Lord must not find you asleep when he arrives. Advent comes from the Latin word *advenire*, which means "to come to." The season of Advent, then, is a time to think about and to reflect on three advents in particular: God's coming into the world as a human child, God's coming into our world today, and God's glorious coming at the end of time. These reflect three promises: God's promise to bring salvation to all people, Jesus' promise to be with those who follow him, and Jesus' further promise to return at the end of time. It is not enough simply to admire Jesus and be impressed by what he says. We are asked to take the extra step and follow the way of discipleship. We do not know where the path of discipleship will lead us, or when Christ himself will return. In the meantime we are the gatekeepers, the stewards, and the ones left in charge. Our responsibility is to stay alert and focused, even when others seem to be asleep or distracted, so that we are ready to welcome Christ into the world when he comes



again. We are also asked to be attentive to the coming of God into our lives today: in the sacrament of Christ's Body; in the unlikely guise of the homeless, the hungry, the prisoner, the addict in whom Christ appears before us; and in the Spirit who is within us. We are urged to live with hope in our hearts for Christ's final return.



Starting the year you turn 70-1/2, the IRS requires that you take a Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) - the minimum amount that you need to withdraw from your retirement account each year. With the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017, it is estimated that only 10% of taxpayers will itemize deductions. Those age 70-1/2 and older can make a charitable donation directly from their retirement account to a qualified charity, satisfy their RMD, and not pay tax on that distribution. 
Are you interested in discovering more about the Catholic Church, its beliefs, and growing in your own faith and understanding? Then you should join RCIA.

- You may bring gifts and gift cards to the DuBois Center lobby during office hours (M-Th, 9am-5pm and Fri 9am-12pm).
- If your gift has accessories or batteries, please keep them together in a bag and make sure the tag is visible.
- The deadline for gift giving is **Sunday December 20<sup>th</sup>**.

The gifts will be removed from the Narthex weekly to keep the space open for social distancing. Without the generosity of our parishioners, most migrant farm workers' children would receive no gifts on Christmas. May our Lord bless you abundantly.




