



Fr. Gary writes:

Today is a day of great joy as a number of our children receive their First Holy Communion at the 9:30 and 11:30 Masses. We pray for them and their families. May this day of great rejoicing be forever in their hearts. For their parents this is another milestone in their children's faith journey. At baptism parents promise, in the presence of God, to be the best teachers of their children in the ways of faith. I cannot imagine why any parent would not want Christ to be the foundation stone upon which they and their children build their lives and relationships. Parents have a huge responsibility in forming young lives, in developing young hearts. What parents instill in their children, how they treat and encourage them, will stay with them throughout their lives. In the Gospels of the Easter season, Christ has been encouraging us to remain in him. If we remain anchored in Christ, we will be able to walk through most, if not all the challenges we have to face, the sadness and heartache which inevitably come our way. If we lay the right foundation stones for our children, and anchor them in Christ, in relationship with Christ our Risen Savior, they will be able to weather many a storm. May the food of everlasting life, the Risen Christ, sustain and nourish these children throughout their lives. Jesus is the Bread of Life, whoever comes to Him will never be hungry, will never hunger for truth, beauty and goodness. The Eucharist seals our relationship with Christ. We need the Eucharist because we need Christ, we need to remain in him so as to live life to the full.

At the 5pm Sunday Mass we will honor our Seniors, those who are graduating from High School. They are about to open a new chapter in their lives. This has been an academically challenging year for our students and teachers. It's challenging also to be a young Catholic Christian in today's world, to remain faithful to Christ and the Church. We need to give our young people as much support as we can, as Pope St. John Paul II stated: "They are the Church of today and the hope of tomorrow." This year has definitely been a learning curve for us all, but especially for our children and young people. Our personal attitudes and beliefs about how the pandemic has been handled, obviously rubs off onto our children. You can turn anything into a negative, or alternatively into a life changing learning opportunity. In his bestselling book, 'Let Us Dream', Pope Francis writes: "In the trials of life, you reveal your own heart: how solid it is, how merciful, how big or small. From this crisis we can come out better or worse. We can slide backward, or we can create something new. This is a moment to dream big, to rethink our priorities – what we value, what we want, what we seek. We need to proclaim that being kind, having faith, and working for the common good are great life goals. I see an overflow of mercy spilling out in our midst. That fills me with hope that we might come out of this crisis better. But we have to see clearly, choose well and act right." I hope and pray that our children and young people will create a better and less divisive tomorrow. As the Pope states, if we are kind, have faith, and work for the common good, we will create a better world.

Dispensation Lifted

Bishop Gregory Parkes has announced that the obligation for Catholics to attend Mass on Sunday will resume on May 22, the vigil of Pentecost. Bishop Parkes said, "It's my intention that the general dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass issued last March will be lifted effective on the vigil of Pentecost, which is the weekend of May 22 and 23. We will be updating and providing suggested protocols and guidelines to our parishes so that they remain among the safest places to be." He also added: "On April 5th, the vaccine (was) made available to every adult in our diocese, and in the state of Florida. This is a reason for hope. In the same way that many are returning to shopping, to restaurants, social gatherings, and vacations, it's time to come back to Mass. It's time to come back to church, it's time to come home."


A Fond Farewell

STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

Perseverance

Life would be so much easier for us if Jesus were still walking the earth among us. It would eliminate so many arguments and provide undeniable proof that Jesus lived, died, and rose again. But what would his physical presence mean to us? There would indeed be benefits: we really could ask the question, "What would Jesus do?" and get an answer! But there would also be enormous temptation to expect him to solve all life's problems directly. "Jesus, please stop the war in . . .," "Lord, please find me a new job," "I beg you, Lord, to cure my friend." We might want to spend countless hours in his presence, neglecting our personal vocation and responsibilities. Jesus commanded his disciples to proclaim the good news to every nation. He promised that the power of the Holy Spirit would be given to them to help them persevere. This power would also help them do extraordinary things in his name. Then Jesus disappeared from their sight, and returned to his place at the right hand of God. We have never had the grace of knowing Jesus in human form. The disciples were promised they would be clothed with power from on high; by the same token we received a white garment at our baptism and were told we were now clothed in Christ. For those of us



who were baptized as infants, the idea of being clothed in power meant nothing at the time. But this power was indeed given to us, to be nurtured and to come to fulfillment in our adult lives. For us to persevere as followers of Jesus we continually need the power of the Spirit. Let us set aside a time each day, as the first disciples did, to seek out the Spirit's power in prayer as we approach the feast of Pentecost.



2021 Annual Pastoral Appeal Hope in the Lord

Thank you to the **476** families who have responded so generously to the Appeal so far. We have reached **\$183,672** in pledges and **\$156,653** has been paid toward our goal of **\$239,862** for this year. If you have not yet made a gift or pledge, please prayerfully consider the blessings you have received.

On April 28 Bishop Parkes, representatives from Catholic Charities, and city and county leaders joined to bless the construction site of the future Mercy Oaks Apartments in Hillsborough County. This project is part of the *Courageously Living the Gospel* **diocesan goal to expand affordable housing**. To date, five affordable housing properties have been completed and three are in development.

Mercy Oaks has been made possible because of generous donors to the Diocese of St. Petersburg and Catholic Charities, and through a grant from Hillsborough County. Bishop Parkes spoke about the 20 units that will be built and said this project will make a positive difference to the 20 families who will call this community home. *“When someone has shelter, a safe place to life, a roof over their head, an address, they have a future hope and opportunity,”* said Bishop Parkes.



There are over 3,100 children in community based care in Pinellas and Pasco counties.

Bread for the World urges elected leaders in Washington, D.C., to enable people in our nation and our world to feed their families and move out of poverty. Personalized emails stand out. They tell senators and representatives that you, as a constituent, really care about an issue. Members of Congress want to hear from their constituents about the issues on which they will vote in the Senate & House of Representatives.

The following are issues moving in Congress and/or in the administration. This is your opportunity to change policies, programs, and conditions that allow hunger and poverty to continue.

Refundable Tax Credits

When it comes to fighting hunger, the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) and the Child Tax Credit (CTC) are proven to be the most successful at moving more children out of poverty than any other government program.

COVID-19 exposed the vulnerability of the U.S. safety net and amplified the inequity that shows that Black, Latino, and Indigenous children have disproportionately higher levels of food insecurity than their white counterparts. Children are more vulnerable than any other group to the damaging impacts of hunger even for short periods. ***By making the recent expansion in the refundable tax credits permanent, Congress can cut child hunger in half***, with even greater impacts in communities of color.

Child Nutrition Reauthorization

Reauthorization of child nutrition programs is long overdue. The programs were last authorized in 2010 when lawmakers passed the Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act. Congress is supposed to pass legislation that funds and sets policies for national child nutrition programs every five years. The programs include school lunch and breakfast programs, afterschool and summer feeding programs, and the Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC). These programs serve millions of low-income children annually and ensure their access to the nutritious food they need to thrive.

One in seven families with children are not getting enough to eat because they cannot afford it, according to the U.S. Census Bureau’s Household Pulse Survey. Congress must enact policy that strengthen and protect child nutrition programs.


