Fr. Gary writes:

Every Wednesday the Pope holds an audience at the Vatican. For most of the last year it has been virtual because of Covid, but they are now open to the public. Over the last few weeks he has been focusing on prayer. The talk which caught my eye was titled: 'Why does it seem like God doesn't answer our prayers sometimes?' Pope Francis replied: "The *Catechism* offers us a good summary of the matter. It puts us on guard against the risk of not living an authentic experience of faith, but of transforming our relationship with God into something magical. Prayer is not a magic wand: It is a dialogue with the Lord. Indeed, when we pray we can give in to the risk of not being the ones to serve God, but of expecting God to serve us. Jesus had great wisdom in teaching us the 'Our Father'. It is a prayer of questions only, as we know, but the first ones we offer are all on God's side. They ask for the fulfillment not of our plan, but of God's will for the world. Better to leave it to God: "Hallowed be thy name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done" (Matthew 6: 9-10). We can also pray for the wrong reasons, such as to defeat the enemy in war, without asking ourselves what God thinks of such a war. In prayer it is God who must convert us, not we who must convert God. The accounts of Jesus' life are full of prayers: many people wounded in body and in spirit ask Him to be healed; there are those who pray for a friend who can no longer walk; there are fathers and mothers who bring sick sons and daughters. They are all prayers imbued with suffering. It is an immense choir that invokes: "Have mercy on us!"

We see that at times Jesus' response is immediate, whereas in some other cases it is delayed: It seems that God does not answer. Think of the paralytic brought by his four friends: Jesus initially forgives his sins and only later heals his body (Mark 2: 1-12). On some occasions, therefore, the solution to the problem is not immediate. In our life too, each one of us has this experience. Let us look back a little: How many times have we asked for a grace, a miracle, let's say, according to what we wanted in that moment. God's time is not our time."

This was the main point of what the Pope was saying, when it comes to prayer, God's time is not our time. To affirm this he reflected on Jesus' prayer to the Father in the Garden of Gethsemane: "My Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me." Pope Francis continued: "It seems that the Father does not listen to Him. The Son must drink fully from the chalice of the Passion. But Holy Saturday is not the final chapter, because on the third day, Sunday, is the Resurrection. Evil is lord of the penultimate day. Remember this well. Evil is never the lord of the last day. God is the Lord of the last day. Because that belongs to God alone, and it is the day when all human longings for salvation will be fulfilled. Let us learn this humble patience, to await the Lord's grace, to await the final day. The penultimate day is very hard, because human suffering is hard. But the Lord is there. And on the last day, God solves everything."

In Matthew's Gospel, it is said "Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you." This has been the story of my discernment to the priesthood. Asking the Lord for my vocation was something that I thought I knew the answer to. Little did I know, the Lord had more in mind for me. My initial call to the priesthood began when I was just 16, and while the call was always there, I tried my best to ignore the call, simply because I wanted what I wanted.

During my time in the Life Teen program here at Our Lady of Lourdes, I went on many different retreats, Steubenville Youth Conferences, and to Camp Covecrest. While I was at these retreats, the call to priesthood would always come back, but I refused to accept the idea, so I just ignored my potential vocation. Now, as a young adult, after becoming a Core team member for Life Teen, joining the Knights of Columbus, and getting more involved with different ministries, such as Eucharistic Minister and Reader, the call to priesthood has become even more persistent. After years of running, I finally chose to give in to the call and apply for the Seminary. To anyone who is discerning priesthood or religious life, I encourage you to listen to the Holy Spirit and do not be afraid, because the Lord has incredible plans for you.

This process of discernment was not done by myself; there were many people along the way who inspired me to pursue the Lord and His calling for me. I would like to extend a special thank you to Father Victor Amorose; Father Drew Woodke, who was a Deacon during his time here; Father Chuck Dornquast, the Director of Vocations for the Diocese; Nick Gunn, our other parish seminarian; and of course, Father Gary and Father Jonathan Emery for their inspiration and constant joy that they give not only to me, but to many others. I would also like to thank Sarah Davis for being my youth minister, who really opened my mind to the idea of priesthood. Last but not least, I would like to thank my parents for supporting me through the process.



STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

The Greatest Gift

Today is Corpus Christi, the feast of the Eucharist. The feast of Corpus Christi was established in the thirteenth century and is celebrated throughout the Catholic Church today. Saint Thomas Aquinas, the great theologian and doctor of the Church, is given credit for many of the customs and hymns associated with Corpus Christi. In some ways every Sunday is a feast of the Eucharist. As early as the fourth century, Saint Cyril of Jerusalem instructed communicants: "Do not come forward with the palms of the hands outstretched nor with fingers apart, but making the left hand a throne for the right since this hand is about to receive the King. Making the palm hollow, receive the Body of Christ, adding Amen." When we participate in the Mass and receive Communion we are honoring and celebrating the precious gift of the Lord's own Body and Blood. Communion is a fulfillment of Christ's promise to be always with us. Yet, by the Middle Ages the laity rarely received Communion. What became all important was to "see God" as the priest raised the consecrated host and chalice. So it remained, until Saint Pius X (1835–1914) returned us to the earlier tradition by advocating frequent Communion for the laity. In the last century attention to Eucharistic devotions



declined, while more people received frequent Communion. Recent efforts to revitalize adoration of Jesus in the Eucharist, through Perpetual Adoration, Corpus Christi celebrations, and Eucharistic Congresses have brought us back into balance. And whether we receive Jesus or adore him in the reserved sacrament, he always requires a response from us. At the end of every Mass we are sent forth to love and serve the Lord. He gives us his very self—the greatest gift of all—so that we can go into the world and give in return.

Living Stewardship Now

Pray for the willingness to make the love of Christ, as shown to us in the Eucharist, present in our world.






