



Fr. Gary writes:

Happy Father's Day to all those who are privileged to carry this beautiful title as a Dad, Grandfather, Godfather, Priest, Guardian, Foster Father, Mentor. This is a day of celebration, and as Catholic Christians we love to celebrate, we love to give thanks for all the graces and blessings we receive through our various vocations. This year's celebration takes place during a year dedicated by Pope Francis to St. Joseph, foster father of Jesus. What a source of inspiration St. Joseph was to Jesus. In a reflection given by Matthew Kelly on St. Joseph he highlighted three things. Firstly, he asked the question, why did God choose him? What was it about Joseph that led God to choose him to look after Mary and Jesus? Did he have some extraordinary skill or incredible knowledge? No. It was because he made himself one hundred per cent available to God. And when anyone makes themselves one hundred per cent available to God, incredible things happen, and St. Joseph is the proof. Secondly, he was blessed with the gift of humility because he was willing to make himself one hundred per cent available to God. There is not one word in the Scriptures flowing from the mouth of Joseph. He is the guy who is very comfortable to be behind the scenes, playing a supportive role. Supportive roles are crucial. We need people who will stand by our side no matter what, people we can totally and utterly trust because we know they will never let us down. It is not in their nature to do so. This describes St. Joseph, the kind of person he was. Thirdly, he is the patron saint of workers. Work plays a central role in all our lives. A lot of people are continually searching for meaningful work. God calls us to bring meaning to our work. How can we do it? One way, is to offer each hour of work as a prayer. To offer each hour as an intention for a particular person or situation. We would then be transforming every hour of work into a prayer, and in doing so we grow in humility, making ourselves one hundred per cent available to God, opening the door for incredible things to happen. St. Joseph, Patron of the Church, pray for us and with us!

A few words of wisdom to those who carry the beautiful title of Father. From Roy T. Bennett: "Be an encourager. When you encourage others, you boost their self-esteem, enhance their self-confidence, make them work harder, lift their spirits and make them successful in their endeavors. Encouragement goes straight to the heart and is always available. Be an encourager. Always." Michael Jordan: "My father used to say that it's never too late to do anything you wanted to do. And he said, "You never know what you can accomplish until you try." Adam LaRoche: "As fathers, we have an opportunity to help mold our kids into men and women of character, with morals and values that can't be shaken by the world around them. Of one thing I am certain: we will regret NOT spending enough time with our kids, not the other way round." Steve Chapman: "Becoming a dad is one thing – being a dad is many things." The Lion King: "Oh yes, the past can hurt. But the way I see it, you can either run from it or learn from it."

Our scientists wrapped up an especially important unit celebrating Earth Day, where students were encouraged to wear Earth Day themed t-shirts to school to bring awareness to the plight of the planet and learn how we could each do our own part to help save it.

The 6th graders learned about Plastic Pollution and the Great Pacific Garbage Patch and what they could do to reduce their use of plastics in their own life. Students produced their own creative solutions of swapping plastic straws for metal straws, using a refillable water bottle, and bringing their own reusable grocery bags when shopping instead of using the plastic ones.

The 7th graders had a lesson on the Carbon Cycle and its connection to climate change. They role-played a game as a carbon atom and followed its path through the

carbon cycle to learn how long carbon can stay in one area of the carbon cycle, and quickly learned how we are outputting more carbon dioxide into the atmosphere and ocean than the planet can keep up with.

The 8th graders had the opportunity to learn about the plight of coral reefs around the world, especially here at home in the Florida Keys. They learned about the increased frequency of coral reef bleaching events due to ocean acidification, siltation, and rising ocean temperatures. They also had the opportunity to learn about coral reef restoration efforts that have been hard at work to help save such an important biodiverse ecosystem.

Making Amends

Aki Ra was no more than a toddler when he was conscripted by Cambodia's murderous Khmer Rouge régime to be a child soldier. At age five, instead of reciting the alphabet, he learned to plant deadly land mines. He had no choice in the matter, he said. The child soldiers had bags full of landmines on their backs, which they threw behind them as they walked. If anyone was too slow he was shot. After the Vietnamese army liberated Cambodia, the now teenaged Aki Ra was finally set free. Yet because of the work he and other child soldiers had done for the Khmer Rouge, Cambodia was strewn with thousands of active landmines, killing and maiming hundreds of people every year. Ra deeply regretted what he had done, and vowed to spend his life in restitution. He knew where he had buried many of the mines and how to disarm them safely. Armed only with a metal detector and a few simple tools, he began locating land mines and deactivating them one by one. Filled with TNT, a mine can detonate at any second, but Ra has never been injured in his work. For more than twenty years, he has continued this painstaking and dangerous work, and has also led safety education programs in villages. In 1999 he founded the Cambodia Landmine Museum, a non-profit group that provides education and



resources concerning the country's land mines and allows visitors to view hundreds of disabled mines. The museum also serves as Ra's home, where he cares for more than twenty children who have been injured or disabled by these terrible weapons. Ra, now a widower, describes it as a place of healing for bodies, minds, and hearts, a place where love, support, and education will help secure a better future for the children who live there.



To observe the best method for naming your parish or school in your will, ask your attorney to use the following terminology: "I give, devise, and bequeath (amount, article, stock, etc.) to Gregory Parkes, as Bishop of the Diocese of St. Petersburg, and his successors in office, a Corporation Sole, for the use of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish, 750 San Salvador Drive, Dunedin, FL 34698."


