A number of you have asked about our twin parish and school of the Sacred Heart in Acul des Pins, Haiti, in light of the recent devastating earthquake. Our twin parish is in the north east of the country, the earthquake was in the south, the epicenter around the city of Les Caynes. On our last visit we travelled to Les Caynes to meet the Cardinal, Chibly Langlois, the first ever Haitian Cardinal, appointed by Pope Francis in 2014. He is a wonderful man, and greeted us with such love and grace in 2018. He was visiting a parish when the earthquake struck. While he survived, the house he lived in (where we visited him) collapsed, and one of the priests who shared the rectory was killed. Five other rectories were destroyed, along with a number of schools and convents. Haiti seems to go from one disaster to another, one crisis to another. Just a few weeks ago, President Jovenel Moise was assassinated in his residence. We met the President, and his wife, at Mass on our last visit. Covid-19 is rampant with little availability to vaccines. Haiti, being the poorest country in the Western Hemisphere, seems to go from one crisis to another. The situation would be more dire without the love that flows from the Catholic Church, providing much of the medical, social and educational needs of the Haitian people. Bishop Parkes has sent \$50,000 from our Diocese, and Catholic Relief Services are providing emergency aid. We will continue to support our twin parish and school, and I thank you for your continued love and generosity. You are beacons of hope, vehicles of love and channels of faith.

Pope Francis has once again spoken about the merits of vaccination in combating the Covid-19 pandemic, describing it as an "act of love." He urges us to get vaccinated: "Thanks to God's grace and the work of many, we now have vaccines to protect us from Covid-19. They bring hope to end the pandemic, but only if they are available to all and if we collaborate with one another." He added: "Getting the vaccines that are authorized by the respective authorities is an act of love. And helping the majority of people to do so, is an act of love. Love for oneself, love for our families and friends, and love for all peoples. Getting vaccinated is a simple yet profound way to care for another, especially the most vulnerable. I pray to God that each one of us can make his or her own small gesture of love. No matter how small, love is always grand. Small gestures for a better future." The Archbishop of Los Angeles, Jose Gomez, President of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, echoed the words of the Pope: "The terrible coronavirus pandemic has caused illness, death and suffering across the entire world. May God grant us the grace to face it with the strength of faith, ensuring that vaccines are available for all, so that we can all get immunized."

We take Christ's words to heart, "Be not afraid, I am with you always." Amen!



If you will be arriving after audition week, please contact the Director of Music to schedule a time to hear you sing.


## COVID-19 Precautions

## STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION HEARING AND DOING

It is made clear throughout the Gospels and Epistles that our discipleship, as followers of Jesus, is not over until our bodily death. In today's second reading we are urged, "Be doers of the word and not hearers only" (James 1:22). Discipleship is hard. Sometimes we have "reasons" why we cannot do things—we are too tired, too old, too sick, too needy. We are too busy with work, with children, with other responsibilities. Yet some of the best "prayers" are people confined by illness or disability. Some of the wisest listeners are the elderly, who have a lifetime of patience and wisdom to draw on. Some of the most generous givers are those who have endured poverty and suffering themselves. Some of the most admired organizers are those who delegate and let other people shine. And let us not forget the heroes who put their lives on the line in time of crisis. Not everyone is called to heroism, but *all* of us are called to live generously and selflessly. The opportunities are endless: in our families, our parish, our neighborhood or town, and in places around the world. Try to balance prayer, action and financial giving. A busy mother with three toddlers can hardly spend hours in prayer or at church. A man who must work two jobs to support his family has limited time to volunteer, and a person on



a tiny fixed income cannot give large donations to the church or charity. However, the busy mother can talk to God as she chases after her little ones. The hardworking man can help with an occasional parish event, and the person with a limited income can put a steady few dollars in the collection each week. Everyone can be a "doer."

### SuperFit Kidz Health Tip

Becoming the best version of yourself

Anaerobic exercise should be a part of your Superfit lifestyle. There are many challenges in life, and if we incorporate different exercises into our daily life, we can achieve strength, perseverance, self-confidence, and happiness. Anaerobic exercise is fast paced and shorter in duration, and includes high intensity sports like weight-lifting, high intensity interval training, jumping, and sprinting. These exercises strengthen muscles and assist in burning calories and losing fat. The energy system "without oxygen" pushes our bodies and lungs to rely on energy sources stored in our muscles, breaking down glucose for energy, which is called "glycolysis." This process produces lactic acid in the muscles and is why we get tired after the energy burst. The benefit of regular anaerobic exercise is that it enables our bodies to be more efficient in eliminating lactic acid and therefore we feel tired less quickly. This type of exercise increases bone strength and density, boosts metabolism, fights depression, reduces the risk of disease, protects the joints, and increases our energy to be more productive in life. Often, individuals avoid this training system because it is difficult. We must face the challenge and change our mindset, seeking assistance from fitness professionals who can guide and motivate us.
