My dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,


The crowds *murmured* about Jesus because he said, **“I am the bread that came down from heaven”**. To murmur is to complain or grumble, which echoes the grumbling of the Israelites in the desert when they failed to understand the significance of their freedom (see Ex. 16:2). In our Gospel, the people murmured because they were *hungry* for truth but could not understand Jesus’ revelation as the Bread of Life, the ultimate source of fulfillment. Today, many seek for knowledge, but struggle with this fundamental truth, that only God can satisfy our deepest longings. He gives us *eternal life* through the partaking of his Body and Blood: **“The bread that I will give is my flesh”**; **“Whoever eats this bread will live forever.”**

In our First Reading, Elijah was begging God to take his life, for he has had “enough!” How did God respond? The Lord sent an angel to order him to get up and eat. Through his obedience, Elijah was strengthened and continued his journey to Mt. Horeb. What does Elijah’s story teach us about our relationship with God and one another? Many times, on our spiritual journey, we face hunger, exhaustion, and the temptation to give up, crying out: “This is enough, O LORD!” The Lord commands us to EAT and DRINK, not just once, but *twice*. In Biblical terms, a double portion indicates *abundance*. Thus, the Lord feeds us abundantly!

The Eucharist, the living bread of Jesus, is the **“source and summit of the Christian life”** (CCC 1324). We cannot look to Jesus only with human eyes and understanding. Let us not murmur in disbelief: “Is this not bread? Is this not wine?” Rather, let us recognize that Jesus is truly present under the appearance of bread and wine in order to become both physically and spiritually present to us: **“Whoever believes has eternal life.”**

How can we avoid grumbling in the daily struggles of life, especially in our dealings with one another? How can we practice kindness, compassion, and forgiveness in Christ?

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,


La multitud *murmuraba* de Jesús porque decía: **“Yo soy el pan que descendió del cielo”**. Murmurar es quejarse o quejarse, lo que hace eco de las quejas de los israelitas en el desierto cuando no entendieron el significado de su libertad (ver Éxodo 16: 2). En nuestro Evangelio, la gente murmuraban porque tenían *hambre* de la verdad, pero no podían entender la revelación de Jesús como el Pan de Vida, la fuente suprema de plenitud. Hoy en día, muchos buscan el conocimiento, pero luchan con esta verdad fundamental, que solo Dios puede satisfacer nuestros anhelos más profundos. Él nos da *vida eterna* a través de la participación de su Cuerpo y Sangre: **“El pan que yo daré es mi carne”**; **“El que coma de este pan vivirá para siempre”**.

En nuestra primera lectura, Elías le rogaba a Dios que le quitara la vida, porque ya había tenido “¡suficiente!” ¿Cómo respondió Dios? El Señor envió un ángel para ordenarle que se levantara y comiera. A través de su obediencia, Elías se fortaleció y continuó su viaje al monte. Horeb: ¿Qué nos enseña la historia de Elías acerca de nuestra relación con Dios y con los demás? Muchas veces, en nuestro viaje espiritual, enfrentamos el hambre, el cansancio y la tentación de rendirnos, clamando: “¡Ya es suficiente, oh SEÑOR!” El Señor nos manda COMER y BEBER, no solo una vez, sino *dos veces*. En términos bíblicos, una doble porción indica abundancia. ¡Por lo tanto, el Señor nos alimenta en *abundancia!*

La Eucaristía, pan vivo de Jesús, es **“fuente y cumbre de la vida cristiana”** (CIC 1324). No podemos mirar a Jesús solo con ojos humanos y comprensión. No murmuremos con incredulidad: “¿No es esto pan? ¿No es esto vino? Más bien, reconozcamos que Jesús está verdaderamente presente bajo la apariencia del pan y del vino para estar presente tanto física como espiritualmente para nosotros: **“El que cree tiene vida eterna”**.

¿Cómo podemos evitar las quejas en las luchas diarias de la vida, especialmente en nuestro trato con los demás? ¿Cómo podemos practicar la bondad, la compasión y el perdón en Cristo?



Saint Lawrence



(c. 225 - August 10, 258)

The esteem in which the Church holds Lawrence is seen in the fact that today's celebration ranks as a feast. We know very little about his life. He is one of those whose martyrdom made a deep and lasting impression on the early Church.

He was a Roman deacon under Pope Saint Sixtus II. Four days after this pope was put to death, Lawrence and four clerics suffered martyrdom, probably during the persecution of the Emperor Valerian. Legendary details of Lawrence's death were known to Damasus, Prudentius, Ambrose, and Augustine. The church built over his tomb became one of the seven principal churches in Rome and a favorite place for Roman pilgrimages.

A well-known legend has persisted from earliest times. As deacon in Rome, Lawrence was charged with the responsibility for the material goods of the Church, and the distribution of alms to the poor. When Lawrence knew he would be arrested, he sought out the poor, widows, and orphans of Rome and gave them all the money he had, selling even the sacred vessels of the altar to increase the sum. When the prefect of Rome heard of this, he imagined that the Christians must have considerable treasure. He sent for Lawrence and said, "You Christians say we are cruel to you, but that is not what I have in mind. I am told that your priests offer in gold, that the sacred blood is received in silver cups, that you have golden candlesticks at your evening services. You must render to Caesar what is his. Bring these treasures—the emperor needs them to maintain his forces. God does not cause money to be counted: He brought none of it into the world with him—only words. Give me the money, therefore, and be rich in words."

Lawrence replied that the Church was indeed rich. "I will show you a valuable part. But give me time to set everything in order and make an inventory." After three days he gathered a great number of blind, lame, maimed, leprous, orphaned, and widowed persons and put them in rows. When the prefect arrived, Lawrence simply said, "These are the treasure of the Church."

The prefect was so angry he told Lawrence that he would indeed have his wish to die—but it would be by inches. He had a gridiron prepared with coals beneath it, and had Lawrence's body placed on it. After the martyr had suffered the pain for a long time, the legend concludes, he made his famous cheerful remark, "It is well done. Turn me over!"





Family Faith Formation - Class Options

Sacramental Preparation: To be considered eligible for sacramental preparation please register in one of the options below. Families will be invited to preparation of the sacraments in the second year of programming. This is separate and in addition to regular class attendance.

Traditional Program: Wednesdays at 6:30pm to 7:45pm Grades 1 thru 8 at ASCS, Chapel and Social Hall. Classes begin August 18th (High School is offered at another date/time.)

Family + Faith Program: One Sunday a month, grades Pre K to HS. At least ONE parent attends adult faith enrichment sessions while child(ren) attend grade appropriate classes. On dates that the program is in session families attend 8am Mass as part of the session. Program begins Sunday, August 22nd with 8am Mass at the church on SR-46.
