

My dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Over the past several weeks, we have heard from the Gospel of Mark, chapters 8-10, Jesus' journey from Caesarea Philippi to Jerusalem. The Gospel readings tell us of misunderstandings, provocations, reversals, ambitions and finally, the revelation of Jesus' identity and mission on earth. Each time they misinterpret, Jesus teaches them about the meaning of discipleship and true greatness in the kingdom of God.



Mis Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas en Cristo,

Durante las últimas semanas, hemos escuchado del Evangelio de Marcos, capítulos 8-10, el viaje de Jesús desde Cesarea de Filipo a Jerusalén. Las lecturas del Evangelio nos hablan de malentendidos, provocaciones, retrocesos, ambiciones y, finalmente, la revelación de la identidad y misión de Jesús en la tierra. Cada vez que malinterpretan, Jesús les enseña sobre el significado del discipulado y la verdadera grandeza en el reino de Dios.

In the first prediction, Jesus tells the disciples that he will suffer, be rejected, killed, and will rise after three days. After Peter's rebuke, Jesus tells them to deny themselves, take up their crosses, and follow him. In the second prediction, the disciples did not understand and were afraid to ask him. Sensing that something momentous is about to happen, they debated among themselves who would be the greatest. Jesus takes another opportunity to teach them that the first will be the last and that those who receive children in his name receive him.

In this Sunday's Gospel, James and John boldly ask that they may take the highest places of honor next to Jesus, with one at his right and the other at his left. The others became indignant when they heard of this, because they too want places of honor and authority. Jesus again teaches them that to be the greatest, they must become the servant of all. He also tells them that *"the Son of Man did not come to be served but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many."*

On our journey of discipleship, we are tempted to give into fear and doubt when difficulties arise. Like the first disciples, we selectively hear what we want and disregard what doesn't appeal to us. We want to follow the triumphant Risen Christ and put aside the Crucified Christ. Yet as St. Paul says, "we preach Christ crucified" (1 Cor 1:23). Let us offer our trials, sufferings, and difficulties to the Lord Jesus, our High Priest, in the hope that we will rise again with him on the last day.

*What compels you to follow Jesus? What do you wish Jesus to do for you?*

*How can we follow Jesus' example of servant leadership in the positions that we occupy in life?*

En la primera predicción, Jesús les dice a los discípulos que él sufrirá, será rechazado, asesinado y resucitará después de tres días. Después de la reprimenda de Pedro, Jesús les dice que se nieguen a sí mismos, tomen sus cruces y lo sigan. En la segunda predicción, los discípulos no entendieron y tuvieron miedo de preguntarle. Sintiendo que algo trascendental está a punto de suceder, debatieron entre ellos quién sería el más grande. Jesús aprovecha otra oportunidad para enseñarles que los primeros serán los últimos y que los que reciben niños en su nombre lo reciben a él.


En el Evangelio de este domingo, Santiago y Juan piden con valentía que puedan ocupar los lugares más altos de honor junto a Jesús, uno a su derecha y el otro a su izquierda. Los demás se indignaron al enterarse de esto, porque ellos también quieren lugares de honor y autoridad. Jesús nuevamente les enseña que para ser los más grandes, deben convertirse en siervos de todos. También les dice que *"el Hijo del Hombre no vino para ser servido, sino para servir y dar su vida en rescate por muchos"*.

En nuestro viaje de discipulado, nos sentimos tentados a ceder al miedo y la duda cuando surgen las dificultades. Como los primeros discípulos, escuchamos selectivamente lo que queremos y hacemos caso omiso de lo que no nos atrae. Queremos seguir al Cristo resucitado triunfante y dejar de lado al Cristo crucificado. Sin embargo, como dice San Pablo, "predicamos a Cristo crucificado" (1 Co 1, 23). Ofrezcamos nuestras pruebas, sufrimientos y dificultades al Señor Jesús, nuestro Sumo Sacerdote, con la esperanza de que resucitemos con él en el último día.

*¿Cómo podemos seguir el ejemplo de Jesús de liderazgo de servicio en los puestos que ocupamos en la vida?*



## Saints Isaac Jogues, Jean de Brébeuf, and Companions

Isaac Jogues and his companions were the first martyrs of the North American continent officially recognized by the Church. As a young Jesuit, Isaac Jogues, a man of learning and culture, taught literature in France. He gave up that career to work among the Huron Indians in the New World, and in 1636, he and his companions, under the leadership of Jean de Brébeuf, arrived in Quebec. The Hurons were constantly warred upon by the Iroquois, and in a few years Father Jogues was captured by the Iroquois and imprisoned for 13 months. His letters and journals tell how he and his companions were led from village to village, how they were beaten, tortured, and forced to watch as their Huron converts were mangled and killed.

An unexpected chance for escape came to Isaac Jogues through the Dutch, and he returned to France, bearing the marks of his sufferings. Several fingers had been cut, chewed, or burnt off. Welcomed home as a hero, Father Jogues might have sat back, thanked God for his safe return, and died peacefully in his homeland. But his zeal led him back once more to the fulfillment of his dreams. In a few months he sailed for his missions among the Hurons.

In 1646, he and Jean de Lalande, who had offered his services to the missionaries, set out for Iroquois country in the belief that a recently signed peace treaty would be observed. They were captured by a Mohawk war party, and on October 18, Father Jogues was tomahawked and beheaded. Jean de Lalande was killed the next day at Ossernenon, a village near Albany, New York.

The first of the Jesuit missionaries to be martyred was René Goupil who with Lalande, had offered his services as an oblate. He was tortured along with Isaac Jogues in 1642, and was tomahawked for having made the sign of the cross on the brow of some children. Father Anthony Daniel, working among Hurons who were gradually becoming Christian, was killed by Iroquois on July 4, 1648. His body was thrown into his chapel, which was set on fire.

Jean de Brébeuf was a French Jesuit who came to Canada at the age of 32 and labored there for 24 years. He went back to France when the English captured Quebec in 1629 and expelled the Jesuits, but returned to his missions four years later. Although medicine men blamed the Jesuits for a smallpox epidemic among the Hurons, Jean remained with them. He composed catechisms and a dictionary in Huron, and saw 7,000 converted before his death in 1649. Having been captured by the Iroquois at Sainte Marie, near Georgian Bay, Canada, Father Brébeuf died after four hours of extreme torture.

Gabriel Lalemant had taken a fourth vow—to sacrifice his life for the Native Americans. He was horribly tortured to death. Father Charles Garnier was shot to death in 1649 as he baptized children and catechumens during an Iroquois attack. Father Noel Chabanel also was killed in 1649, before he could answer his recall to France.

These eight Jesuit martyrs of North America were canonized in 1930.





Starting in November, All Souls will be hosting a three-part series of seminars designed to provide information and resources for legacy planning.



### Presence: The Mystery of The Eucharist




