My dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,


In the First Reading, Moses announced to the people what became known as the Shema, or Sh'ma, an essential prayer and declaration of faith recited every morning and evening by the Israelites. Shema is Hebrew for the verb "to hear", which also means "to obey" or "to follow", and it comes from the first line of Deuteronomy 6:4-5: "Hear, O Israel! The LORD is our God, the LORD alone!" This statement encapsulates God's uniqueness and covenant relationship with Israel. The central theme throughout the book of Deuteronomy focuses on Israel's call to undivided love and faithfulness to the Lord, for He alone is their God.

In today's Gospel, Jesus quoted the Shema in response to a question from one of the scribes, "Which is the first of all the commandments?" After their dialogue, Jesus said to him, "You are not far from the kingdom of God". Not far, but not yet in it. Thus Jesus implies that hearing and understanding the commandments of God is the beginning of entrance into God's kingdom. To be in it, we must also observe His commandments. "He who has ears to hear, let him shema!" Jesus is calling us not only to hear God's commandments, but to heed them as well.

"If you love me, keep my commandments" (Jn 14:15). God's commandments are life-giving and self-giving; keeping them is the way for us to demonstrate both our love for God and for others. In our personal experiences, we may find it difficult or impossible to keep all of God's commandments at all times, and to love Him with all of our being. Yet what we are unable to do, God has accomplished through His Son Jesus, our high priest (Rom 8:3-5). As our Second Reading tells us, Christ lives forever to intercede for us; "He is always able to save" (Heb 7:25).

This week, let us find ways to love God in each of the categories of Heart, Mind, Body, and Soul. Spend some time alone with the Lord in prayer and reflection, especially in the hearing of His Word in the Scriptures. Let us then put what we hear into action by sharing our God-given gifts to serve others according to His holy will.

Mis Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas en Cristo,

En la primera lectura, Moisés anunció al pueblo lo que se conoció como el Shemá, o Sh'ma, una oración esencial y una declaración de fe que los israelitas recitan cada mañana y cada noche. Shema es el verbo hebreo "escuchar", que también significa "obedecer" o "seguir", y proviene de la primera línea de Deuteronomio 6: 4-5: "¡Oye, Israel! ¡El SEÑOR es nuestro Dios, el SEÑOR solo!" Esta declaración


resume la singularidad de Dios y la relación de pacto con Israel. Este es un tema central en todo el libro de Deuteronomio: el llamado de Israel al amor indiviso y la fidelidad al Señor, porque solo Él es su Dios.

En el evangelio de hoy, Jesús citó el Shemá en respuesta a una pregunta de uno de los escribas: "¿Cuál es el primero de todos los mandamientos?" Después de su diálogo, Jesús le dijo: "No estás lejos del reino de Dios". No muy lejos, pero todavía no. Así, Jesús da a entender que escuchar y comprender los mandamientos de Dios es el comienzo de la entrada al reino de Dios. Para estar en él, también debemos observar Sus mandamientos. "¡El que tenga oídos para oír, que sea shema!" Jesús nos está llamando no solo a escuchar los mandamientos de Dios, sino también a prestarles atención.

"Si me amas, guarda mis mandamientos" (Jn 14:15). Los mandamientos de Dios dan vida y se entregan a sí mismos; guardarlos es la forma en que podemos demostrar tanto nuestro amor por Dios como por los demás. En nuestras experiencias personales, es posible que nos resulte difícil o imposible guardar todos los mandamientos de Dios en todo momento y amarlo con todo nuestro ser. Sin embargo, lo que no podemos hacer, Dios lo ha logrado a través de Su Hijo Jesús, nuestro sumo sacerdote (Romanos 8: 3-5). Como nos dice nuestra Segunda Lectura, Cristo vive para siempre para interceder por nosotros; "Siempre puede salvar" (Heb 7, 25).

Esta semana, encontremos formas de amar a Dios en cada una de las categorías de Corazón, Mente, Cuerpo y Alma. Pase algún tiempo a solas con el Señor en oración y reflexión, especialmente al escuchar Su Palabra en las Escrituras. Pongamos en práctica lo que escuchamos compartiendo los dones que Dios nos ha dado para servir a los demás de acuerdo con Su santa voluntad.

Solemnity of All Saints

The earliest certain observance of a feast in honor of all the saints is an early fourth-century commemoration of "all the martyrs." In the early seventh century, after successive waves of invaders plundered the catacombs, Pope Boniface IV gathered up some 28 wagon-loads of bones and reinterred them beneath the Pantheon, a Roman temple dedicated to all the gods. The pope rededicated the shrine as a Christian church. According to Venerable Bede, the pope intended "that the memory of all the saints might in the future be honored in the place which had formerly been dedicated to the worship not of gods but of demons" (On the Calculation of Time).



But the rededication of the Pantheon, like the earlier commemoration of all the martyrs, occurred in May. Many Eastern Churches still honor all the saints in the spring, either during the Easter season or immediately after Pentecost.

How the Western Church came to celebrate this feast, now recognized as a solemnity, in November is a puzzle to historians. The Anglo-Saxon theologian Alcuin observed the feast on November 1 in 800, as did his friend Arno, Bishop of Salzburg. Rome finally adopted that date in the ninth century.

Reflection

This feast first honored martyrs. Later, when Christians were free to worship according to their consciences, the Church acknowledged other paths to sanctity. In the early centuries the only criterion was popular acclaim, even when the bishop's approval became the final step in placing a commemoration on the calendar. The first papal canonization occurred in 993; the lengthy process now required to prove extraordinary sanctity took form in the last 500 years. Today's feast honors the obscure as well as the famous—the saints each of us have known.

The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed

The Church has encouraged prayer for the dead from the earliest times as an act of Christian charity. "If we had no care for the dead," Augustine noted, "we would not be in the habit of praying for them." The theological underpinning of the Feast of All Souls is the ac-



knowledge of human frailty. Since no human achieves perfection in this life but, rather, goes to the grave still scarred with traces of sinfulness, some period of purification seems necessary before a soul comes face-to-face with God. The Council of Trent affirmed this purgatory state and insisted that the prayers of the living can speed the process of purification. These days, purgatory is often seen as the purifying fire of God's love! Observances of this day include public processions or private visits to cemeteries and decorating graves with flowers and lights. This feast is observed with great fervor in Mexico, as is known as the "Día de los Muertos".

All Souls Church is named after this important feast day, grounding us all in the work to be done here on earth, before we enter into Our Lord's presence and are united in eternal love. We strive to serve God's purposes for our lives in this world, while keeping our eyes and hearts fixed on Jesus.

An "All Souls Mass" will be offered at the All Souls Cemetery, on Nov. 2nd, at 5pm. Chairs are provided or you are welcome to bring your own. (In the case of inclement weather, Mass will take place at All Souls Church on S.R. 46.




All Souls Catholic School TV Production Program




