

**FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK...**

Having received this invitation from our Bishop:

*Most Reverend Frank J. Dewane, Bishop of the Diocese of Venice, invites the faithful to the Ordination to the Priesthood of Transitional Deacons Mark Harris and Alexander Pince. This is to take place at 11:00 a.m., on Saturday, July 31, at Epiphany Cathedral, 350 Tampa Avenue West, Venice.*

I would like to reproduce this reflection on the priesthood from Hugo Wast as an occasion to open in gratitude our heart and lips to thank God for the gift of these new two Alter Christus in our Diocese. Please, pray constantly for vocations.

**“When you think ...”** by Hugo Wast

When you think that not even The Blessed Virgin can do what a priest can do.

When you think that not even the angels, nor the archangels Michael, Gabriel and Rafael, nor any of the princes who defeated Lucifer, can do what a priest can do.

When you think that our Lord Jesus Christ, at the Last Supper, performed a miracle greater than the creation of the Universe, with all its splendor, by making the bread and wine into his Body and Blood to feed the world, and this wonder, which the angels and men kneel before, can be repeated every day by a priest.

When you think in the other miracle only a priest can do: to forgive sins, and that held fast in the bottom of his confessional, God, bound by his word, held too in the heavens, and what the priest is unleashing at that very moment, is the absolution of God Himself.

When you think that humanity is redeemed and that the world exists because men and women are fed every day by the redeeming Body and Blood of Christ that only a priest can do.

When you think that the world would die of starvation if it would miss this tiny morsel of Bread, this one precious drop of Wine.

When you think that might happen because so many priestly vocations are lost.

When this devastating famine happens, the heavens will be in tumult, and the earth will explode, as if the people were no longer held in God's Hand, and they will cry of hunger and distress, and they will ask for this Bread, and no one will be able to give it; they will be asking for absolution from their sins, and there will be no one to absolve them, and they will die in terror, with their eyes wide open to their shame.

When you think that a priest is more necessary than a king, a soldier, a banker, a doctor a teacher, because he can take the place of each one of them but none of them can take his place.

When you think that when a priest at the altar holds a dignity much higher than a king, and that he is not just a symbol, not just an ambassador of Christ, but is Christ himself, truly present, repeating the most supreme miracle of God.

When you think of all of this, one understands the overwhelming need to promote priestly vocations.

One understands the eagerness with which in ancient times, the bosom of a family cherished as it would a stick of costly spikenard, the most honored blessing of a priestly vocation.

One understands the immense respect the people of old had for priests, which was reflected in the laws.

One understands that the worst crime anyone can commit is to prevent or discourage a priestly vocation.


One realizes that this apostasy is to be like Judas, selling Christ again.

One understands that if a parent obstructs the priestly vocation of a child, they are acting the same as if they were to renounce a title of incomparable nobility.

One realizes that a seminary or a novitiate is more necessary than a Church, a school, more necessary than a hospital.

One understands that giving to build or help to maintain a seminary or a novitiate is to perpetuate the birth of the Redeemer.

One understands that to pay for studies of a young seminarian, or a novice, is paving the road to his arrival at the altar, where a man, for half an hour every day, is much more than all the dignitaries of the land, and that all the saints of heaven, recognize in him, Christ Himself, sacrificing His Body and Blood, to feed the world.


**DEAR LADIES OF ST. ANDREW PARISH,**







## MOVIE TRAILERS AND EASTER EGGS

Are you a fan of movie trailers or opposed? Some people prefer to go into a movie knowing absolutely as little as possible about it and can't stand the trailers that 'give too much away.' They want to experience every bit of a movie the first time when watching the whole thing. I respect that, but don't subscribe to it. I love trailers! The second I get a notification of a new trailer released I want to watch it as soon as I can. Trailers work on me: they get me excited about seeing the movie by providing little tidbits that (when done right) then get expanded upon in the film. The appetizer makes the meal more appreciated, at least for me. And as more and more movies become 'franchises' in which many movies interconnect, trailers can include what have become called 'easter eggs,' small things that only those 'in the know' can spot. The MCU (Marvel Cinematic Universe of all those superhero movies) uses these regularly to excite their core comic book fans who revel in catching hints or figuring out clues based on their encyclopedic knowledge of the source material. Today's Gospel is a movie trailer rife with easter eggs! The miracle of the feeding of the five thousand is the only miracle (other than Resurrection) that appears in all four Gospels (easter egg #1). And the way Jesus offers physical nourishment through bread to so many from so little is a preview, a little tidbit, a trailer of what's to come: Jesus nourishing all of us in the Eucharist, the bread from heaven (which is the very next thing he teaches in the Gospel of John—easter egg #2). The passage mentions that the feast of Passover was near (John 6:4); Passover being the annual celebration of the Israelites Exodus from Egypt in which they ate the sacrificial Lamb to be spared death (and which itself is a trailer of Jesus, the Lamb of God, who sacrifices Himself so we can all be spared death—easter egg #3). The leftovers fill twelve baskets (easter egg #4—twelve apostles, twelve tribes of Israel who were saved in the Exodus). We Catholics are 'in the know' about how God saves us: through the spiritual food of Communion miraculously multiplied every day to feed millions of souls. If this miracle of feeding the five thousand is the trailer, our Mass is the movie, the blockbuster to end all blockbusters since it features the ultimate defeat of death, the villain most feared. Let's all take a moment this week to appreciate the miracle that is the Mass, the amazing gift of God offering Himself to us, to nourish, heal, teach, correct, and save us. And we get to be *in* this movie!




