


SACRAMENTAL LIFE OF THE CHURCH - RCIA

Are you Catholic? Have you received all the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion? Do you or someone you know want to be able to participate fully in the sacramental life of this community? Did you have a civil wedding ceremony thinking that you would one day get around to a "church wedding?" Has that day arrived? Have you ever said to yourself "I will do that later, when I have more time." Is this the time?

If you, a friend or family member can answer yes to any of these questions then the RCIA (becoming Catholic) process here at St. Joseph Catholic Church is the place to start.

BAPTISM

We are happy to welcome new members to our Catholic faith community. Infant baptisms are usually celebrated on the third Sunday of the month.

Requesting the sacrament of baptism for a child involves a serious obligation and faith commitment on the part of the parents and godparents. Parents must be registered and active members of the parish for three months before beginning the baptismal preparation process. We encourage parents to begin this process prior to the birth of their child.

Call Angela Trybul in the Pastoral Office at 772-287-2727, ext. 109 to schedule an initial appointment. After the necessary paperwork, which may be obtained at the initial appointment, is filled out, baptismal preparation class is attended and completed godparent eligibility form and birth certificate are received, then the baptism will be scheduled. Our baptismal preparation class is held once a month in the Pastoral Office Conference Room.

Please call 772-287-2727, ext. 109 to confirm class attendance.



MATRIMONY

Wedding Masses are celebrated on Saturday, and may begin as early as 12:00 noon, but no later than 1:00 p.m. Engaged couples must be registered in this parish for a minimum of 6 months, attending Mass regularly, and participating in our envelope system before initiating the marriage preparation process, which requires approximately 6 months to complete. You must call the Parish Office ext. 109 at least six (6) months prior to your intended marriage to begin the marriage preparation program, and in advance of scheduling the wedding reception hall. Tentative wedding dates require meeting with a parish priest and his subsequent approval, before being confirmed/scheduled on the Church calendar.



RECONCILIATION

A priest is available to hear confession on Saturday, from 11:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m., from 3:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m., and on Thursday before First Friday, from 3:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. Penitential Services are held during the Seasons of Advent and Lent. First Reconciliation is usually celebrated in the Second Grade prior to First Eucharist. Please call the Parish Office ext. 100 for more information or to schedule a time convenient for you.



CONFIRMATION

Candidates for this sacrament are those already baptized and who have received formation in religious education. We celebrate Confirmation with the Bishop. For High School students, this is a 2-year program. Contact the Parish Office ext. 107 Adults wishing to be confirmed can contact the Religious Education Office for the RCIA program.



HOLY ORDERS

If you feel you may have a vocation to serve the People of God through the Ordained Ministry as a Priest or Deacon, or the Vowed Religious Life, please contact the Diocesan Vocation Office at (561) 775-9555 or speak to one of the parish priests.



FIRST EUCHARIST

First Eucharist is usually celebrated in the Second Grade after attending the required religious instruction classes either at St. Joseph Catholic School or through the Parish Religious Education Program. Participation at weekend mass is also required. Preparation for First Eucharist is a two-year program. First Eucharist for children takes place in the Spring. Please call the Parish Office ext. 107 for more information.



ANointing of the Sick

This Sacrament will be celebrated with a special Liturgy for the Sick twice a year, Lent and Advent, or in the case of immediate need, upon request. If you are homebound or in the hospital and desire to be anointed, please contact the Parish Office. When a patient is in the hospital, please ensure you register as a Catholic so that our Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion can visit you.

ACTIVE PARISHIONER STATUS

We receive many requests for parishioners to be godparents or sponsors for the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, to rightfully enjoy the number of services offered at St. Joseph Church, and to receive the active Catholic school rate. Part of the request is to be able to verify that a person is an "active member" of St. Joseph.

An "active member" is:

- Properly registered on the parish rolls.
- Faithfully attends Mass on Sundays and Holy Days
- Participates in parish activities/ministries when possible
- Uses the parish envelope system for donations

These are the main factors that will be considered in making the determination.

SMALL GROUPS

Hearts Before Minds Scripture Background

This information isn't meant to be read aloud, but as background for the leader. If helpful, share some of it in with the group.

The Gospel today has a reference to an unnamed "other disciple" who appears only near the end of John's Gospel. Sometimes this person is referred to as the "Beloved Disciple" because of references in other verses to "the disciple whom Jesus loved." According to John, this Beloved Disciple was the one who reclined next to Jesus at the Last Supper (Jn. 13:23), the person who went with Jesus into the high priest's courtyard at the time of his arrest (Jn. 18:15), the one who stood at the foot of the cross with Jesus' mother (Jn. 19:26), and the one who was the first to recognize him after the great catch of fish after his resurrection (Jn. 21:7). This person's identity is a mystery, but it seems that John is contrasting him to Peter, and he comes off more favorably in every scene he appears. Biblical scholars are still pondering the significance of this "new" character who only appears here at the end of John's Gospel.

Opening Prayer

Pray the following aloud together, beginning with the Sign of the Cross:

+ In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

God of new life, teach us to believe even more deeply that light will always overcome darkness and life will win out over death. Help us live into greater joy during this Easter season.

We ask this in Jesus' name. Amen

Gospel Reading: John 20:1-9

Ask someone to read this passage aloud, then pause for a minute of silence.

Ask: What struck you about this reading or the liturgy this week?

Allow for sharing. Move on to the next section once the sharing has died down.

Reflections on the Reading

Invite each person in the circle to read one paragraph aloud:

Each of the four Gospels recounts slightly different details of Jesus' resurrection. Yet they all begin with a note that the stone which had sealed the tomb has been rolled away, and that the tomb where Jesus' body was laid is now empty. Those who first saw these things were confused and couldn't understand what they were seeing. Despite Jesus' predictions

during his lifetime that he would die and be raised from the dead, none of his followers seemed able to comprehend immediately what had happened. Some Jews at the time of Jesus believed there would be a general resurrection of all of the dead at the end of time. Others, like the Sadducees, didn't even believe in that. It's no wonder, then, that it took some time for Mary Magdalene, Peter, and the "other disciple" (also known as the "Beloved Disciple) to piece together the incredible news that Jesus had been raised from the dead. John tells us that the other disciple was the first to see and believe, but also that they didn't yet understand what Scripture meant that Jesus had to rise from the dead. The Acts of the Apostles, which follow the lives of the apostles after Jesus' resurrection, shows how they gradually came to understand more and more in the days, weeks, and years afterwards the implications of the resurrection. They had nothing in their experiences to compare this to as they lived into a completely new reality-a lived experience of life after death. Their hearts would have felt the joy long before their minds could make sense of Jesus' resurrection.

Questions for Discussion

Read each question aloud, one at a time, followed by time for sharing.

1. Does Easter feel any more significant to you this year because of how you experienced Lent? Why?
2. Have you ever been so surprised by joy that it took you some time for your mind to catch up to what your heart was experiencing? How so?
3. This Share about an experience of believing in something even though you couldn't explain it rationally.

Closing Prayer

Pray the following aloud together:

God of new life, help us to step out of our caves, out of fear and darkness and death, and into the garden of new life you want to offer us. We ask this in the name of the risen Jesus. Amen

PALM SUNDAY

There is both great joy and terrible sorrow associated with this day, the Sunday that begins Holy Week, the Sunday that portends the crucifixion of Our Lord.

It is a time of despair, perplexity and contradiction. The very people who applaud Christ's entrance into Jerusalem that morning, shouting out "Hosanna" and words of adoration will, within a week, be crying, "Crucify Him." They will go from acclaiming Him as the new King of Israel to urging His life be traded in favor of a convicted criminal; they will first praise Him and then mock Him. Even friends entering Jerusalem at His side will desert Jesus. All this discord will take place during one week beginning on what we call Palm Sunday.
