



**SACRAMENTAL LIFE OF THE CHURCH - RCIA**

Are you Catholic? Have you received all the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion? Do you or someone you know want to be able to participate fully in the sacramental life of this community? Did you have a civil wedding ceremony thinking that you would one day get around to a "church wedding?" Has that day arrived? Have you ever said to yourself "I will do that later, when I have more time." Is this the time?

If you, a friend or family member can answer yes to any of these questions then the RCIA (becoming Catholic) process here at St. Joseph Catholic Church is the place to start.

We are happy to welcome new members to our Catholic faith community. Infant baptisms are usually celebrated on the third Sunday of the month.

Requesting the sacrament of baptism for a child involves a serious obligation and faith commitment on the part of the parents and godparents. Parents must be registered and active members of the parish for three months before beginning the baptismal preparation process. We encourage parents to begin this process prior to the birth of their child.

Call Angela Trybul in the Pastoral Office at (772) 287-2727, ext. 109 to schedule an initial appointment and receive a baptism packet. After the necessary paperwork is returned to the office and requirements are met, then the baptism will be scheduled. Our baptismal preparation class is held once a month in the Pastoral Office Conference Room, RSVP is required.

## MATRIMONY

Wedding Masses are celebrated on Saturday, and may begin as early as 12:00 noon, but no later than 1:00 p.m. Engaged couples must be registered in this parish for a minimum of 6 months, attending Mass regularly, and participating in our envelope system before initiating the marriage preparation process, which requires approximately 6 months to complete. You must call the Parish Office ext. 109 at least six (6) months prior to your intended marriage to begin the marriage preparation program, and in advance of scheduling the wedding reception hall. Tentative wedding dates require meeting with a parish priest and his subsequent approval, before being confirmed/scheduled on the Church calendar.



## RECONCILIATION

A priest is available to hear confession on Saturday, from 11:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m., from 3:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m., and on Thursday before First Friday, from 3:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. Penitential Services are held during the Seasons of Advent and Lent. First Reconciliation is usually celebrated in the Second Grade prior to First Eucharist. Please call the Parish Office ext. 100 for more information or to schedule a time convenient for you.



## CONFIRMATION

Candidates for this sacrament are those already baptized and who have received formation in religious education. We celebrate Confirmation with the Bishop. For High School students, this is a 2-year program. Contact the Parish Office ext. 107 Adults wishing to be confirmed can contact the Religious Education Office for the RCIA program.



## HOLY ORDERS

If you feel you may have a vocation to serve the People of God through the Ordained Ministry as a Priest or Deacon, or the Vowed Religious Life, please contact the Diocesan Vocation Office at (561) 775-9555 or speak to one of the parish priests.



## FIRST EUCHARIST

First Eucharist is usually celebrated in the Second Grade after attending the required religious instruction classes either at St. Joseph Catholic School or through the Parish Religious Education Program. Participation at weekend mass is also required. Preparation for First Eucharist is a two-year program. First Eucharist for children takes place in the Spring. Please call the Parish Office ext. 107 for more information.



## ANointing of the Sick

This Sacrament will be celebrated with a special Liturgy for the Sick twice a year, Lent and Advent, or in the case of immediate need, upon request. If you are homebound or in the hospital and desire to be anointed, please contact the Parish Office. When a patient is in the hospital, please ensure you register as a Catholic so that our Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion can visit you.

## ACTIVE PARISHIONER STATUS

We receive many requests for parishioners to be godparents or sponsors for the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, to rightfully enjoy the number of services offered at St. Joseph Church, and to receive the active Catholic school rate. Part of the request is to be able to verify that a person is an "active member" of St. Joseph.

An "active member" is:

- Properly registered on the parish rolls.
- Faithfully attends Mass on Sundays and Holy Days
- Participates in parish activities/ministries when possible
- Uses the parish envelope system for donations

These are the main factors that will be considered in making the determination.

## SMALL GROUPS

### Some Turned Back Scripture Background

**This information isn't meant to be read aloud, but as background for the leader. If helpful, share some of it in with the group.**

The evangelist John suggests a connection between Jesus and the figure of "Lady Wisdom" in the book of Proverbs at several places in his Gospel. Lady Wisdom invites everyone to learn wisdom and depth from her, to turn away from sin, and to join her at a banquet feast where she will provide rich food and drink to all. John's Jesus does the same. We read about Lady Wisdom's invitation in the first reading today, and then hear Jesus' explicit invitation to eat and drink his flesh and blood in the Gospel.

#### Opening Prayer

**Pray the following aloud together, beginning with the Sign of the Cross:**

*In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen*

*Lord, let us know your presence in our midst today as we study your words in Scripture. Holy Spirit, guide our minds and our hearts so that we may hear and understand your message to us. We ask this in Jesus' name. Amen.*

#### Gospel Reading: John 6:51-58

**Ask someone to read this passage aloud, then pause for a minute of silence.**

**Ask:** What struck you about this reading or the liturgy this week?

**Allow for sharing. Move on to the next section once the sharing has died down.**

#### Reflections on the Reading

**Invite each person in the circle to read one paragraph aloud:**

For the third week in a row, we hear Jesus telling his listeners that he is the "living bread that came down from heaven" and that we must eat his flesh and drink his blood to have eternal life (Jn. 6:51). Anyone who has tried to explain transubstantiation to a child for the first time will understand why his listeners are murmuring in surprise and confusion and quarreling amongst themselves about what he means. Earlier in the chapter, Jesus fed the crowd with five loaves of bread and two fish. Remember that Jesus is a Jew speaking to fellow Jews when he reminds them of one of their people's climatic stories—God feeding their ancestors manna on their sojourn through the desert to freedom. Now he reveals that not only does God provide bread for the journey, but that he is the bread for the journey. No wonder his listeners are

incredulous—this sounds like cannibalism! As Catholics, we don't understand it that way. We accept that it is a mystery how the bread and wine are transformed into Jesus' body and blood and feeds us in the Eucharist. We can't wrap our minds around this concept with reason.

#### Questions for Discussion

**Read each question aloud, one at a time, followed by time for sharing.**

1. How do you understand Jesus as the "living bread that came down from heaven?"
2. What is your experience of receiving the Body and Blood of Christ in the Eucharist?
3. How do you experience Jesus feeding you each week at Mass?

#### Closing Prayer

**Pray the following aloud together:**

Lord, thank you for this time to reflect on your Living Word. May what we have heard inspire us to live as more faithful disciples in the coming week. Amen.

July 17, 2024, to Pentecost 2025 will be a Year of Going out on Mission.






