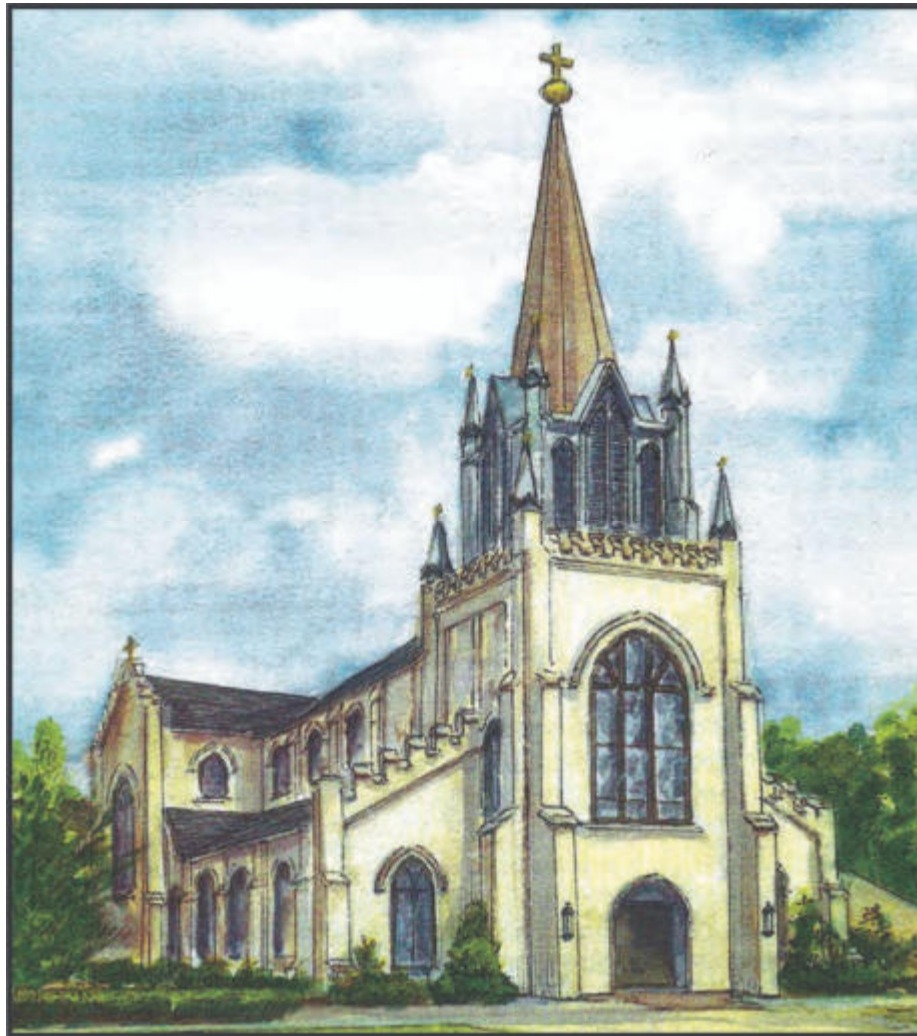

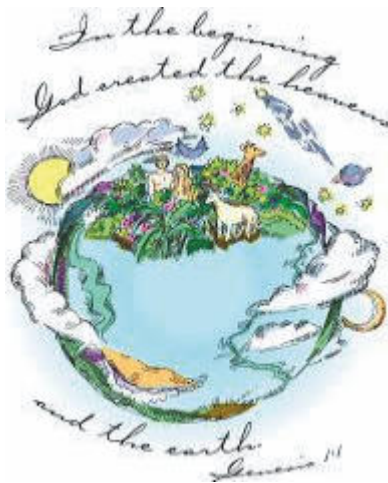

Psalm:

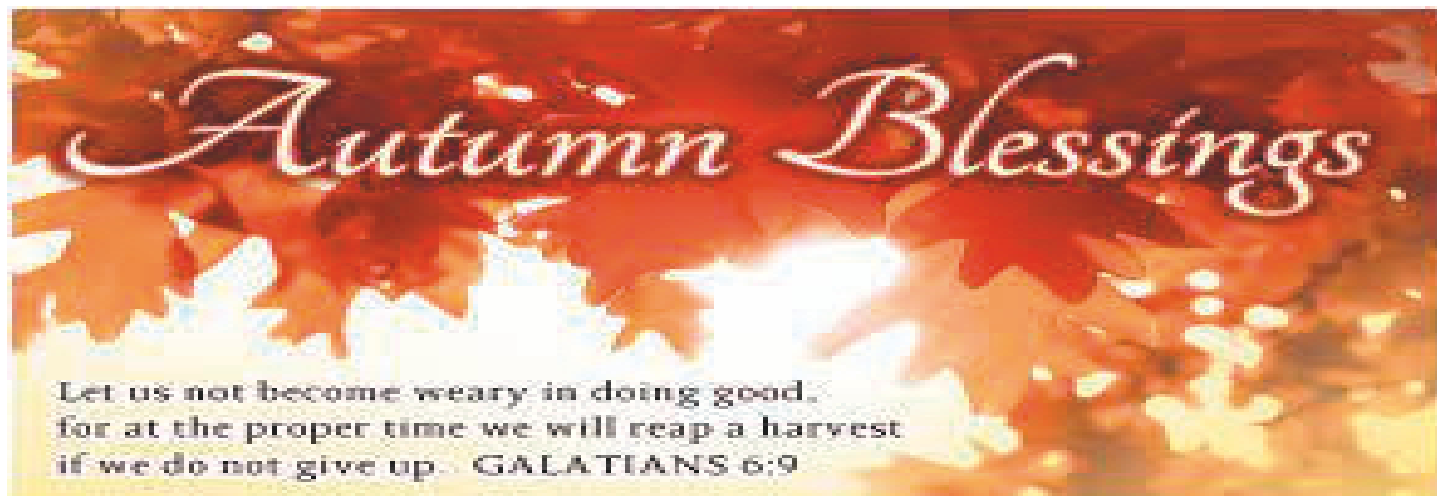
Fill us with your love, O Lord, and we will sing for joy! (Ps 90)

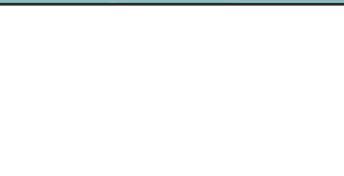

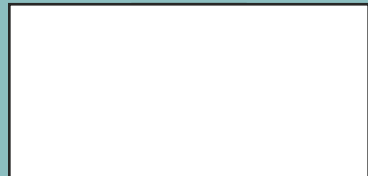
