

Praise God for the gifts of **Joseph, Mary** and, of course, **Jesus**!


Praise God for the Holy Family, who teach us that if Jesus is present in our own families, no matter what, we know peace and joy.

Born into a Family

Christmas yesterday, and the Feast of the Holy Family today. The nearness of these feasts remind us of the essential dimension of Jesus' humanity. However extraordinary the circumstances, Jesus was born into a family from whom He received what was necessary for Him to advance in wisdom and age. It is easy enough to dismiss this. Today's Gospel lends itself to a frame of mind that emphasizes Jesus' immediate "pipeline" to His heavenly Father. Taken too far, this reduces Mary and Joseph to functional characters who are a kind of stage set for Jesus' divine mission. This fails to do justice to the humanity of Jesus who learned the measure of manhood from the just man, Joseph, and the surrender of loving obedience from His mother, Mary.

Only in this way can we give proper due to the "both-and" that marks our Catholic sensibility: Jesus the son in the family of Mary and Joseph in Nazareth and Jesus who receives all that He has from the Father.

STEWARDSHIP & FAMILY...

The Holy Family experienced many of the same joys and trials that all parents and children experience today. We can look to this Family for help in our own family lives, and see in them a model of stewardship in family life.

The Gospel passage from *Luke* starts by telling us something about Jesus' parents: "Each year Jesus' parents went to Jerusalem for the feast of the Passover, and when he was 12 years old, they went up according to festival custom." This Family took seriously the stewardship of their time. The *Holy Couple* carefully observed the traditions and practice of their Jewish faith, and brought up their Son to do the same. They worshiped as a family with their faith community. And they did so faithfully.

We can take their example to heart by making Sunday Mass attendance a priority for our families, by making prayer with our family a priority every day, by making sure that we regularly celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and by observing in our family life the feasts and fasts appropriate to the liturgical calendar. When we, as families, prioritize our Time with God and worship of Him, we will be imitating the Holy Family.

On this Feast of the Holy Family, let us reclaim the beauty and importance of family life. Let's commit to steward our families well in 2022, making time spent with God and practicing our faith the most important appointments on our family calendars. Ω

Give more – Good stewards realize that everything they have is entrusted to them as gift to be shared. There is no better place to begin than sharing with the community that gathers around the Lord's table at Mass. Consider what you are giving to your parish and local diocese, and commit to an even greater contribution as circumstances allow.

Make a difference in your parish community — Believe it or not, your parish community can use your talents. Offering your talents to your faith community is one of the most effective ways to feel useful and connected to others, and it is a potentially life-changing New Year's resolution.

MINISTRIES OF SERVICE

The *Rosary Makers Ministry* was formed at St. Bernadette in 2018 to make rosaries for the sick, the poor and for missions both home and abroad. In 2021, we were inspired to send rosaries as a symbol of hope and comfort to areas affected by natural disaster. The letter in last week's bulletin was received from the Bishop of Houma - Thibodaux Diocese in Schriever, Louisiana for a gift of rosaries sent to the victims of Hurricane Ida.

This year, the Rosary Makers Ministry has distributed over 2,000 rosaries to missions and ministries locally and internationally. Missions in India, South Africa, and Tanzania have received our rosaries. We have provided rosaries to CCD programs at St. Bernadette, St. Elizabeth Ann Seton and St. Anastasia. Rosaries have been distributed through several St Bernadette ministries including Bernadette's Angels, Project Mother Teresa, the Knights of Columbus, the Columbiettes and the Bereavement Group. NEWS FROM OUR DIOCESE...



Want to help victims of the tornadoes that hit six states?

Catholic Charities USA is accepting donations at https://www.catholiccharitiesusa.org. The site has a button to hit to donate for tornado relief.

The tornadoes swept across the South and Midwest December 10. On December 14, authorities said at least 70 people were dead in Kentucky; six died when a tornado hit an Amazon warehouse in Illinois; four were dead in Tennessee; two in Arkansas; and one in Missouri. Mississippi also got hit. Towns were leveled and tens of thousands of people remained without power.

Susan Montalvo-Gesser, director of Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Owensboro, Kentucky, said the agency had been in the process of resettling Afghan refugees when the storms hit. She called the group's natural leader and asked him to convey to the others that she would have to redirect efforts toward the storm.

"His response floored me," she said in a post on the Catholic Charities USA site. "He said. Ms. Susan, I led a team for the International Red Cross in Afghanistan and Yemen. I've led teams responding to landslides, earthquakes and floods. Give me a vest and put me to work. I can help. A lot of us can help.

"That was early Saturday morning," Montalvo-Gesser said. "I knew then that Emmanuel was present in (his) response. The refugees had been through 'hell' and wanted to assist their new neighbors. Since then, I have received many more messages from Afghans not yet in their own homes who want to assist."
