Dear Friends,

Have you ever returned to the neighborhood where you grew up, perhaps passing by the house that used to be your home? I don't recommend it. Chances are it is all very different from the neighborhood and home that you remember. When I drove by the home I lived in growing up, the house wasn't even there!

In today's Gospel, Jesus, in a sense, returns home perhaps for the first time after beginning His public ministry. All begins well, as He sits in the synagogue He's probably known since a young boy, and He begins reading from the prophet **Isaiah**:

*The Spirit of the Lord is upon me,
because he has anointed me
to bring glad tidings to the poor.
He has sent me to proclaim liberty to captives
and recovery of sight to the blind,
to let the oppressed go free,
and to proclaim a year acceptable to the Lord.*

Jesus purposely chose these words, because they refer to the Messiah. It is no wonder that He follows reading this quote with the important words: **Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your midst.**

You'll have to wait until next week or read ahead to see what happens!

STEWARDSHIP & ONE BODY, MANY PARTS...

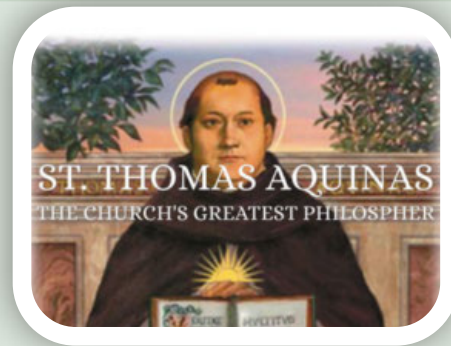
In *St. Paul's letter to the Corinthians*, it states ***If they were all one part, where would the body be? But as it is there are many parts, yet one body.*** (1 COR 12:18-20).

What does this teach us as Christian stewards? It shows us that we all have equal dignity and worth in God's sight, and that if God sees us as equally precious, we should view each other in this same light. It teaches us to humbly recognize our own gifts as well as the giftedness of every member of our parish family. And, while God designed us to be ultimately dependent on Him, it seems He has also designed us to need each other!

This is part of the beauty and richness of a stewardship way of life. No one person can "do it all" in life — whether in family life or parish life. But God does not ask us to do it all. He simply asks us to share the gifts and talents we do have in the season of life we find ourselves right now. It might feel uncomfortable at first. But the good news is you don't have to do it all. Do your part; let your brothers and sisters in the Body of Christ do theirs; and know that the Spirit of the Lord is upon us all as we live out this stewardship way of life. Ω



STEWARDSHIP & ST. THOMAS AQUINAS...



We have consistently pointed to saints as excellent examples of stewardship. On **Friday, January 28**, we will celebrate the ***Feast Day of St. Thomas Aquinas***, priest and doctor of the Church, patron of all universities and of students. Born toward the end of the year 1226, he renounced the things of this world and entered the Dominican order in Naples, Italy in 1243.

He was sent to Cologne, Germany to study. After his ordination he taught there until he was sent to Paris. There at the age of 31 he received his doctorate. **St. Thomas** was an excellent and prolific writer, a theologian extraordinaire. In Paris he became friends with **King Louis** with whom he frequently dined.

Pope Urban IV called him to Rome. He continued to write and was a popular preacher. Although offered many ecclesiastical positions by multiple Popes, he always declined. His greatest work may have been his *Summa Theologica*. **St. Thomas** was one of the greatest and most influential theologians of all time. He was canonized in 1323 and declared Doctor of the Church by **Pope Pius V**. Following are some of his more famous quotes:

- ***Love takes up where knowledge leaves off.***
- ***Three things are necessary for the salvation of man: to know what he ought to believe; to know what he ought to desire; and to know what he ought to do.***
- ***To one who has faith, no explanation is necessary. To one without faith, no explanation is possible.***
- ***Sorrow can be alleviated by good sleep, a bath, and a glass of wine.*** Ω
