Dear Parishioners,


On this Second Sunday of Advent, Sacred Scripture tells us to await new heavens and a new earth. We are to make clear the way of the Lord by being servants of justice, truth and peace.

Beginning this weekend, we will distribute Holy Communion during Mass. Please remain in your pew and the priest will come directly to you. If you are not receiving Holy Communion, you can place your hands over your heart and the priest will offer you a blessing. After the concluding prayer, final blessing and the priest's departure, you are welcome to exit the church from any of the doors. Thank you to our seating guides for their ongoing good work. Please kindly remember that they are parishioner volunteers. Your cooperation with their direction is much appreciated.

Tuesday, December 8th is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Masses will be offered on Monday, December 7th at 4:00 p.m. and Tuesday, December 8th at 8:00 and 10:00 a.m. As the Catechism states, "The 'splendor of an entirely unique holiness' by which Mary is 'enriched from the first instant of her conception' comes wholly from Christ: she is 'redeemed, in a more exalted fashion, by reason of the merits of her Son'" (§492).

We continue to pray for an end to the coronavirus pandemic. We ask God's blessings upon those providing for the healthcare needs of the sick and suffering. We bid the Lord to grant wisdom and understanding to our government officials and scientists working for a vaccine and cure. Let us ask God to give us patience and forbearance to carry the cross of this present moment. As the calendar year draws to a close, I ask for your financial generosity to our parish. Like most churches, we are presently operating in the red. Our donations are significantly down as usual donors have simply stopped giving. We trust in the Lord to provide for our needs and open all of our hearts to care for one another.
