LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Merry Christmas! During this holy season we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph. To mark the 150th anniversary of the declaration of St. Joseph as Patron of the Universal Church, Pope Francis has proclaimed a Year of St. Joseph to be observed until December 8, 2021. Pope Francis' reflection on St. Joseph establishing the year is against the backdrop of the COVID-19 pandemic, which, he says, has helped us see more clearly the importance of ordinary people who, though far from the limelight, exercise patience and offer hope every day. In this, they resemble Saint Joseph, "the man who goes unnoticed, a daily, discreet and hidden presence," who nonetheless played "an incomparable role in the history of salvation" (*Patris corde*).

You can obtain a plenary indulgence during the Year of St. Joseph by one or more of the following:

Meditate of the Our Father prayer for at least 30 minutes or take part in a spiritual retreat of at least one day that includes a meditation on St. Joseph;

Perform a corporal or spiritual work of mercy;

Families or engaged couples who recite the rosary together;

Entrust your daily work to St. Joseph and ask St. Joseph to intercede for the unemployed;

Recite a prayer to St. Joseph for the relief of Christians persecuted both inside and outside of the Church;

Recite any legitimately approved prayer or act of piety in honor of St. Joseph, with an encouragement to do so on the March 19 and May 1 feasts of St. Joseph, the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph, and on the 19th of every month and on every Wednesday, which has been dedicated to St. Joseph;

To the elderly, sick, dying and those legitimately unable to leave the house, who recite an act of piety to St. Joseph under his title of Comfort of the Sick and Patron of a happy death, provided they offer their discomfort to God and fulfill the conditions for the indulgence as soon as possible.

The usual conditions of going to confession, receiving the Eucharist, and praying for the intentions of the Holy Father are required.

Friday, January 1 is the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God. Mass will be offered on Thursday, December 31 at 4:00 p.m. and on Friday, January 1 at 8:00 and 10:00 a.m. The morning Mass on Thursday, December 31 will not be celebrated publically, but will be available on our parish's social media.

Thanks to the thoughtfulness and financial generosity of parishioner Jorge Gomez, we are giving away copies of Matthew Kelly's book, I Heard God Laugh for Christmas. The book asks, "Are you taking care of your soul? Are you feeding it and nurturing it?" You can learn more about Matthew Kelly's ministry at www.dynamiccatholic.com. Please take a copy after Mass or stop by the parish office during the week.



OUTPOURING OF LOVE AND SUPPORT!




Our new process with gift cards was challenging, but we accomplished our goal of bringing Christmas cheer to the students and families at RCMA Wimauma Community Academy. UPDATE ON THE VIRTUAL JOURNEY OF THE CAMINO DE SANTIAGO TRAIL



On November 1, 49 ‘Pilgrims’ from Prince of Peace began a virtual walk of the Camino de Santiago Trail. After virtually flying into France, we started in the town of St. Jean Pied de Port, following the French way towards Santiago, Spain. We will travel 484.2 miles over 33 weeks to reach our final goal. Our overall goals during this time of the pandemic are to encourage healthy habits, grow spiritually and enjoy a sense of community with other Parishioners of Prince of Peace.

On December 13, we started our 7th week of the Pilgrimage, departing from Los Arcos, Spain. Over the previous 6 weeks, we visited many small villages, as well as large cities along the way. Via a weekly narrative, which includes photos of the landscape, ancient church buildings, hotels, people, etc., Pilgrims are virtually transported to the beautiful countryside along the Trail.

Each week, the Pilgrim Guides share health tips, healthy recipes and prayers for meditation while exercising. And, each week, Pilgrims tabulate the number of minutes spent in their chosen form of exercise. Some of us walk, some ride bikes, some run, some swim, others work in the garden. All of the minutes are submitted by email and tabulated by our Pilgrim Guide Tom. For every hour spent in exercise, the Pilgrim group “earns” 1 mile on the Trail. As of Saturday, December 12, the Pilgrims have traveled 84 virtual miles of the Trail, with 1,626.25 hours of exercise!
