## LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Sacred Scripture teaches us this week that Jesus came as one who spoke in the name of the Lord, teaching with authority. Let us listen to His voice and adhere to Him above anything else.

I am speaking at all Masses in the church this weekend about the 2021 Diocese of St. Petersburg Annual Pastoral Appeal. The theme of the appeal is “Hope in the Lord.” The ministries, programs, and services of the diocese funded from the appeal allow us to fulfill our responsibility to bring about the Kingdom of God on earth. All parishioners, seasonal and year-round, are invited to make a courageous gift that demonstrates how as disciples we are living the Gospel and sharing it with those we encounter as meet our assessment of \$175,521.00.

Please assess your own resources and generously make a gift. The appeal is based on equal sacrifice not equal giving. While it is not possible that each gives the same size gift, it is possible that each of us offers a gift that is a reflection of God’s generosity in our lives. Thank you to all who participated in the appeal last year. Let us “Hope in the Lord” that additional families will participate in the appeal this year thereby allowing us to meet our goal and support the work of the Church here on the west coast of Florida.

Wednesday, February 3 is the Feast of St. Blaise. While we are not able to offer the traditional blessing of throats, there will be a general blessing offered through his intercession at the conclusion of the daily Mass and at the conclusion of the 1:00 p.m. Holy Hour.
