LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

On this Fourth Sunday of Lent, Laetare Sunday, we hear the beautiful words of Jesus in St. John's Gospel, "God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him" (3:15). Jesus is the Word of God who saves us from our sins. In turn, we who believe in him are to be his reconciling presence in the world. For the times when we have not been a people of reconciliation, we ask the Lord's mercy. I invite you to make a good confession during the Lenten season. God desires that we be saved and that we in turn offer the gift of reconciliation to others. Presently, the Sacrament of Reconciliation is held via drive-thru on Wednesdays 4:00 – 5:00 p.m., on Saturdays 9:30 – 10:30 a.m. and by calling the parish office to set up a time with one of our priests.

Since the church's reopening last May, we have been attentive to how we gather for Mass based upon guidance from the diocese and the CDC. Thank you to those who have been patient with the process. There have been many learning curves throughout and the good-will displayed by most parishioners has helped to ameliorate the challenges. At this juncture, we are adjusting our gathering for Mass once again. On the St. Joseph side of the church those who have immunity or are two weeks past their full COVID-19 vaccination are invited to be seated as they wish. On the BVM side of the church, we will maintain a six-foot distance between families or individuals with seating in every other pew. For the reception of Holy Communion, we will resume approaching the priest in a communion line one section at a time. At the end of Mass, please exit via any door. Everyone attending Mass should wear a mask. Again, thank you for your understanding and cooperation. Our kindness to one another at Mass is essential to our Christian growth and witness as we take Christ with us into the world.

Our on-line Novena to St. Joseph (www.popcc.org) continues until Thursday, March 18. On Friday, March 19, the Solemnity of St. Joseph, Husband of Mary, join us for the daily 8:00 a.m. Mass followed by the recitation of prayers in the outdoor garden and our annual St. Joseph Day blessing of breads and pastries. During this Year of St. Joseph, an indulgence can be gained by participating in Mass, the prayers and making a sacramental confession. Let us avail ourselves of the graces offered.

Next weekend, Father John Tapp, Pastor of Nativity Catholic Church, Brandon, will speak at all Masses regarding the 2021 Diocese of St. Petersburg Missionary Cooperative Appeal. Each year we have one special collection to benefit an assigned missionary endeavor. Father will speak about the food bank in Dover. There will be a separate basket in the narthex to receive donations or donations can be made on-line or dropped off at the parish office. Thank you for your annual support.

In those days, all the princes of Judah, the priests, and the people added infidelity to infidelity, practicing all the abominations of the nations and polluting the LORD's temple which he had consecrated in Jerusalem. Early and often did the LORD, the God of their fathers, send his messengers to them, for he had compassion on his people and his dwelling place. But they mocked the messengers of God, despised his warnings, and scoffed at his prophets, until the anger of the LORD against his people was so inflamed that there was no remedy. Their enemies burnt the house of God, tore down the walls of Jerusalem, set all its palaces afire, and destroyed all its precious objects. Those who escaped the sword were carried captive to Babylon, where they became servants of the king of the Chaldeans and his sons until the kingdom of the Persians came to power. All this was to fulfill the word of the LORD spoken by Jeremiah: "Until the land has retrieved its lost sabbaths, during all the time it lies waste it shall have rest while seventy years are fulfilled." In the first year of Cyrus, king of Persia, in order to fulfill the word of the LORD spoken by Jeremiah, the LORD inspired King Cyrus of Persia to issue this proclamation throughout his kingdom, both by word of mouth and in writing: "Thus says Cyrus, king of Persia: All the kingdoms of the earth the LORD, the God of heaven, has given to me, and he has also charged me to build him a house in Jerusalem, which is in Judah. Whoever, therefore, among you belongs to any part of his people, let him go up, and may his God be with him!"
