

Many of you know this prayer: "Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love..." What is this fire?

Let's start at the beginning. Fire creates. We know this even from modern physics. They talk about a moment when the universe was tiny, smaller than an apple. According to this theory what the cosmos lacked in size it made up for in temperature: trillions and trillions of degrees. The numbers are beyond imagining - higher even than our national debt! Anyway from this primal fire comes the matter to make up the galaxies, stars and planets, including our own.

So fire creates. The Holy Spirit prayer says, "Kindle in us the fire of your love," and adds, "send forth your Spirit and they shall be created..." The fire of the Holy Spirit creates us.

Besides creating, fire purifies. The Knights at St. Joseph Parish many times grill hamburgers. The fire not only gives the burgers a delicious taste but also kills harmful bacteria. Fire likewise purifies gold or silver. Just so, the Holy Spirit burns away the greed, lust and bitterness that poison our hearts.

Because fire creates and purifies we pray, "kindle in us the fire of your love." Fire also sustains. We hear today how the Holy Spirit came upon the Apostles in tongues of fire. Before receiving the Holy Spirit, they were uncertain and fearful. The Holy Spirit gave them courage and directed them.

We need the Holy Spirit to keep going. We sometimes feel dry and discouraged - even paralyzed or frozen. Sometimes anger or guilt will well up and we feel impotent. We need the Holy Spirit. We need the Holy Spirit so much that Jesus says it is good that he go away so he can send the Advocate. We live now in the age of the Holy Spirit.

When we began the Easter Season we heard Jesus say, "Peace be with you... Receive the Holy Spirit." The Spirit enables a person to believe, that is to trust Jesus. Then take the decisive step of touching his Body. The Holy Spirit is behind what we do. For example, when I extend my hands over the bread and wine, it's by the Holy Spirit that they become the Body and Blood of Jesus.

The Holy Spirit is the life of the Church. In baptism we see water; the reality is the Holy Spirit. So it is in all sacraments. So it is when we pray - the Spirit prays in us. The Holy Spirit creates, heals and sustains. If only we would open our hearts to the fire of his love: "Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created and you shall renew the face of the earth."

Have a Blessed Pentecost Sunday 2022, the Sunday of the Holy Spirit!

DO YOU SPEAK STEWARDSHIP?

If you are married, I'm guessing that you know the best way to break bad news to your spouse, whether you realize it or not. Maybe it's simply that you know not to talk about the budget after your wife's football team has lost. Maybe you know your husband will take the news that your sister is coming to stay a little easier if you tell him over his favorite dinner. We do the same thing with our children, our friends, our coworkers — we have all learned the language of the people we love.


The truth is the same in every language, but it's important for us to convey that truth graciously. That's what Pentecost teaches us. The gift of being able to speak in tongues afforded the Apostles a practical skill to spread the Gospel message, but it also served as a powerful symbol of the importance of effective communication. Evangelization can only happen when you're speaking in words a person is able, ready, and willing to hear.

Let's ask ourselves: what is the language we need to speak to share the truth with the person who is standing in front of us? Is it the language of quality time? The language of concern? The language of laughter and friendship? The language of authenticity, of plain talk and frankness?

The Holy Spirit gave the Apostles the ability to speak in tongues, and it seems miraculous when we read about it in the Gospels — but only consider that we all have this same ability, in a certain way. The Holy Spirit can and will show us how to speak the truth, if we only ask.





LET HER KNOW SHE'S NOT ALONE



If you heard someone you know is pregnant and considering abortion, what would you do?

Maybe she's a family member or friend; perhaps you don't really know her but just met her in a store or at an event.

- Start by letting her know she's not alone. Before she makes a regrettable decision that can't be undone, tell her about the life-affirming help she can receive through a local pregnancy help center. Share the website through the QR code below for the nearest location. There she can receive accurate information about her options, have her pregnancy confirmed, see her child via ultrasound, learn from parenting classes and more.
- Resources for financial and emotional help are available. The center can help her find housing if she needs it, perhaps at a local maternity home and a home for moms and babies after the birth so she can pursue her career.
- Parishioners can join others in determining how the parish can help on a deeper level by working alongside the pregnancy help center, aiding clients by providing needed assistance, personalized to each mother.
- The center can help her stay connected to the parish or rediscover her Catholic heritage. Maybe she doesn't belong to a particular faith community but is open to experiencing one that cares about her.






