**12<sup>th</sup> Sunday Ordinary Time**

**Let Jesus take the wheel**

"Then he asked them, 'Why are you terrified? Do you not yet have faith?' – Mark 4:40

I remember one time, when I was bishop in Pensacola-Tallahassee, some friends invited me to go sailing with them. It started out as a beautiful day, but a couple of hours later a large area of thunderstorms appeared in the distance. It became clear that we were in the path of an incoming storm as the skies got darker and the wind began to pick up. The next thing we knew, we were in the middle of strong storm and rough seas. I remember feeling the sense that we were helpless and just had to ride out the storm.

Now, imagine being in a wooden boat in that same storm 2000 years ago. One had to be brave to venture off of land back then. Now to be caught in a storm as the disciples were, as we read in the Gospel from Mark, could be dangerous and even catastrophic. Yet, here were the twelve in a boat in the middle of the night with Jesus. They couldn't see where they were going and had no control of the boat. They were at the mercy of the seas and felt like they were perishing. The waves are crashing, the boat is nearly capsizing, and yet Jesus is sleeping. (Even our Lord needs His rest!) His friends wake Him, and immediately Jesus commands the seas to calm. And they do! His friends must have been astonished. Then, He says to the disciples, "why are you terrified, do you not yet have faith?"

All of us go through storms in our lives. Not just the natural ones, but situations that cause us great concern, anxiety and doubt. We need to remember that if we turn our trust, our faith, our troubles, our storms to the Lord, then what is there to fear? Jesus asks the same to you as He did to the disciples, "Why are you terrified? Do you not have faith?" On my sailing trip, we were fortunate to have an experienced captain at the helm who guided us through the storm to safety. With Jesus in control of your life, you WILL have the courage to face life's storms with faith and trust that He is in control. Bishop Gregory Parkes

**Reading II 2 Cor 5:14-17** Brothers and sisters: The love of Christ impels us, once we have come to the conviction that one died for all; therefore, all have died. He indeed died for all, so that those who live might no longer live for themselves but for him who for their sake died and was raised. Consequently, from now on we regard no one according to the flesh; even if we once knew Christ according to the flesh, yet now we know him so no longer. So whoever is in Christ is a new creation: the old things have passed away; behold, new things have come.

Then he asked them, “Why are you terrified? Do you not yet have faith?” They were filled with great awe and said to one another, “Who then is this whom even wind and sea obey?”

It is little over two months now that I am serving here at St. Luke the Evangelist Parish, Palm Harbor as the associate Pastor. I came directly from India to St. Luke's and my experience here so far has been quite a happy and enjoyable one. Your words of welcome and good wishes have been heartening and encouraging. Father Paul our Pastor has been particularly encouraging and supporting me to overcome the tide of cultural transition and get into the life of the Parish. With your support and encouragement, I hope to give my best to the parish and to the Diocese of St. Petersburg in Courageously living the gospel.

During this time, some of you have been asking me about myself and my Religious Congregation. So, I thought, for the benefit of all, I could share it in this Parish bulletin. My full name is Father Pedro Camilo Simoes, but you can call me Father Camilo. I am a Religious priest belonging to the Society of the Catholic Apostolate, (commonly known as The Pallottines) a Congregation founded by Saint Vincent Pallotti ((21 April 1795- 22 January 1850) a priest of the Diocese of Rome in the year 1835, with its headquarters in Rome. His charism was to revive faith and rekindle charity among Catholics and serve the growing needs of the Church in the missions. His motto: "The love of Christ impels us" (Caritas Christi Urget Nos). His incorrupt body is enshrined in the church of San Salvatore in Onda, in Rome. Our Congregation is blest with over 2400 members serving the Church in over 50 countries.

In the United States of America, we have "Catholic Apostolate Center" in Washington DC. The Center is collaborating with various Church entities at the international, national, diocesan, and local levels to provide in-person and online formation programs for the New Evangelization and assists in fostering deeper collaboration and greater co-responsibility among all the baptized. ~Father Pedro Camilo Simoes SAC

### WHY DO WE DO THAT? Catholic Life Explained:

#### Question:

What do the colors of the priest's and deacon's vestments mean?

#### Answer:

In the Roman Rite of the Catholic Church, the colors of the vestments evolved over the course of several centuries and there was wide variation both in the colors used, and in the feasts and seasons associated with particular colors. It was Pope Innocent III (d. 1216) who gave us the basic outline that was later prescribed by Pope Saint Pius V in 1570. The various colors remind us of the dominant themes of a particular season or celebration.

- White: Used for the seasons of Christmas and Easter and in celebrations of the Lord, of Mary, the angels, and saints who were not martyrs. This color is also used in Masses for the dead, at baptisms, weddings and other festive celebrations.
- Red: As the color of both blood and fire, red is used on Palm Sunday and Good Friday, as well as Pentecost and special celebrations of the Holy Spirit. Moreover, red is used on the feasts and memorials of the Apostles and those saints who died as martyrs.
- Violet: The color for Advent and Lent. Violet may also be used in Masses for the dead and on All Souls Day (November 2).
- Green: A color of life and hope, green is used throughout Ordinary Time.

Other colors: Rose may be used on the Third Sunday of Advent and the Fourth Sunday of Lent; black may be used in Masses of the dead and on All Souls Day; gold or silver may be used on solemn occasions in place of white, red, or green.


