### A NOTE FROM OUR PASTOR FR. DAVID SCOTCHIE



While our country c e l e b r a t e s l n d e p e n d e n c e Day with firework displays and patriotic music, the Church prays for our country. Every Mass we pray for public

authorities and the salvation of the whole world. During the Universal Prayer following the creed, the deacon reads a petition such as, "That the Spirit guide our leaders to serve the common good. We pray to the Lord." We respond, "Lord, hear our prayer." The petition for public authorities is one of four petitions required at every Mass.

By custom, Nativity displays the Stars and Stripes in the main entrance. You can find in the narthex a second flag, the gold and white flag of Vatican City, with the papal coat of arms—the keys of Peter and the papal tiara—imposed upon its vertical white band.

Nationalism trumpets, "My country. Love it or leave it!" While uncritical of its own leaders, nationalism criticizes and looks down on other countries. The Nazi political party corrupted patriotism into an extreme nationalist ideology that led Germany into World War II and national suicide.

### MORE FROM THE MISSION TRIP FROM JENNIFER CHELLBERG

Last week I shared about the mission trip that our teens took to Morganton, NC earlier this month. While the work they accomplished throughout

the community that week was incredibly important, equally important was the impact that the mission trip experience had on helping them to grow in their own faith lives and their relationship with God and how they will continue to live their faith back home.

At the end of the week, we did some shared journaling. One of the questions that the teens were asked to reflect on was "how have you grown in your faith this week?" Here are just a few snippets from their responses....

"During this week I have noticed what I was lacking in my life.... Now I am looking for any way I can to serve and live every moment... I am going to pray every day, go to Mass at least once a week, and give God back a central role in my life."

"I used to think my religion and church was boring. I felt empty and would try to fulfill myself with social media and other people's love. Little did I know, it was God's love that I needed. When I first arrived at camp, I was unsure but over the week I was able to be myself and I was enjoying every second of it, serving others and being in the presence of Christ. During these days, I realized that whatever I was craving in my life only comes from God."

"From this trip I have realized how peaceful it feels to be with God and how much we push him out of control because we want something different. I have learned to let God in and to listen to him."

"I've never felt more happy before than in these moments. A time where I felt understood, loved, and enough. God's love and mercy is the only thing that I needed in my life, and to have a relationship with him, to be seen by him, has really impacted my life in general and I've felt so joyful since then. I'm so grateful that I got the chance to go on this trip and learn that I am made for so much more than what is here on Earth."

#### SMART GIVING

Every year senior citizens must withdraw an RMD (Required Minimum Distribution) from their IRA (Individual Retirement Account). Uncle Sam taxes it. However, you can bypass the IRS. Simply tell the person who controls your IRA to send a check directly to your charity such as Nativity. This is called an QCD (Qualified Charitable Deduction). Although you cannot write it off as a tax deduction, you do not have to pay income taxes on the amount withdrawn. It is not declared as income. If you're feeling charitable, you can add the amount saved in taxes to your contribution to Nativity. Call the Catholic Foundation of Central Florida at 407-246-4802.
