

\$250,000 MATCH GRANT

Now through the end of March 2022, all funds collected via the BLUE Capital Fund Envelopes will be used 100% for the Window Replacement Project. A generous parish family has offered a \$250,000 Match Grant during this same period, so all funds will be matched dollar-for-dollar.

If you wish to gift funds to the church above and beyond your regular Offertory contribution, we ask that the funds be directed to the Capital Fund so that we can remain DEBT FREE while completing this major construction project on our property.

As part of the overall Window Replacement Project, we have decided to add six (6) new stained-glass windows in the back of the Church where there is currently clear glass. As of this writing, four (4) of the six (6) new stained-glass windows have been spoken for, with only two (2) remaining.

The cost for each window has been set at \$30,000 which will pay for the cost of the stained-glass window and also contribute TOTAL \$153,800 funds to support the overall Window Replacement Project.

The style and colors of the new stained-glass windows will blend with all existing windows in the Church and the themes / scenes will be predetermined and approved by Fr. Paul. Donors will be recognized with a plaque located near the window purchased.



Protect Yourself from Social Security Scams Be on the lookout for fake calls and emails



Telephone and email scammers are pretending to be government employees. They may threaten you and may demand immediate payment to avoid arrest or other legal action. Do not be fooled!

If you receive a suspicious call:

- 1. HANG UP
- 2. DO NOT GIVE MONEY OR PERSONAL INFORMATION
- 3. REPORT THE SCAM AT OIG.SSA.GOV



What to look out for



The caller says there is a problem with your Social Security number or account.



Scammers pretend they're from Social Security or another government agency. Caller ID or documents sent by email may look official but they are not.



Any call asking you to pay a fine or debt with retail gift cards, wire transfers, pre-paid debit cards, internet currency, or by mailing cash.



Callers threaten you with arrest or other legal action.

Be Alert

Social Security may call you in some situations but will never:

- » Threaten you
- » Suspend your Social Security number
- » Demand immediate payment from you
- » Require payment by cash, gift card, pre-paid debit card, or wire transfer
- » Ask for gift card numbers over the phone or to wire or mail cash





Be Active

Protect yourself, friends, and family!

- If you receive a questionable call, hang up and report it at oig.ssa.gov
- » Don't return unknown calls
- » Ask someone you trust for advice before making any large purchase or financial decision
- » Don't be embarrassed to report if you shared personal information or suffered a financial loss


