





Window Replacement Project

Long before this year's rainy season arrived, it was obvious that our 30-year-old windows were beginning to fail and needed attention.

If you happen to be inside the Church during a typical afternoon summer shower, you will see the puddles of water form on the windowsills as the rain cascades down the glass. Several of the window openings also have visible drywall damage from years of slow leaks developing.

Additionally, our beautiful stained-glass windows in the Church, Chapel and Entrance areas are currently not protected from the elements. In the event of a hurricane or other local wind event, damage to these fragile windows would be inevitable.

Back in May of this year, we enlisted the involvement of the Diocese of Venice Building Department to determine the scope of the project and to recommend a course of action based upon an on-site walk through of the property.

At that time, it was decided that the most costeffective way to proceed would be to replace all the current windows on the property (*Church*, *Chapel*, *Office*, & *Parish Hall*) with hurricane impact-rated glass windows as one large project vs. several smaller projects over the course of 3-5 years.

As part of the project, the stained-glass windows would be reset into a double frame with the stained-glass panel on the inside and the clear, hurricane impact-rated glass on the outside, forming a protective barrier.

Measurements were taken and formal quotes were provided. The Finance Council held a special meeting on July 13, 2021 and recommended that we move forward with the window replacement project, including necessary fundraising to cover the associated costs of the project.

Fr Paul then sent a letter to Bishop Frank Dewane to request his approval of the project and to request a loan of up to \$300,000, which would only be used as a last resort – in the event the speed of the project exceeds the fundraising goals - as contractor payments become due.

Contracts were finalized and signed on September 9, 2021 totaling \$464,300 for all of the windows, plus the cost to repair window openings at a '*worst case*' cost of \$1,569.30 per opening. We were fortunate to benefit from a 'bulk' purchase price, by placing our window order at the same time as two (2) other parishes in the Diocese of Venice.

Update: Installation has been delayed and is now scheduled to begin by the end of January 2022 with completion expected within two (2) months. The Diocese of Venice Building Department will oversee the installation and inspections and will authorize progress payments according to the contract. The day-to-day supervision of the window contractor and scheduling will be handled by the on-site staff and select volunteers.

Fundraising for the project began October 1st and, in addition to the \$250,000 MATCH GRANT, proceeds of both the Jewelry Raffle and the Christmas Concert will be used 100% towards the Window Project. Our goal is to raise \$600,000 in order to complete the project, debt free.
