



#### LIVE THE LITURGY

#### Inspiration for the week

People can easily lose a sense of the sacred and transcendent. When we lose a sense of God's special presence, we need to be brought back. Ezra brought people back to the word of God and they realized what they were missing. Jesus proclaims God's word in the synagogue with true conviction and tells those gathered that he is the fulfillment of all that Isaiah taught. Even though people get lost, distracted, discouraged, and often journey down the wrong path, God's timeless law remains. When we allow ourselves to truly hear God's word and act on it, that living word slowly, over time, changes us. It has the power to soften and mold us, creating within us a joyful spirit. We realize the truth in what God speaks and become open to God's love. Gradually and gently God leads us back where we belong. We discover again the sacred character of life and the wonder of God's power. It is no wonder that Luke addresses his remarks to Theophilus. It is a name that means "beloved of God," a name that can be used by anyone who desires friendship with God.



# LAPTOP DONATION DRIVE FOR AREA FOSTER KIDS

The Children's Guardian Fund (CGF) & Sarasota Technology Users Group (STUG) have teamed up to collect used computer laptops or tablets.

With a long history of recycling and safety, the STUG sanitizes the hard drive with a seven-step process that protects the donor's information.

The STUG employs software similar to that used by the

U.S. Department of Defense to completely eliminate all data on the hard drives.

They then refurbish the laptop and install software that is typically required for school. Refurbished laptops are distributed to area students in foster or state care through the CGF and the Guardian ad Litem Program.



# 98% of Window Match Collected

We are thrilled to announce that as of 12/31/21 we have collected \$245,800 (98%) towards the \$250,000 Match Grant for the Window Replacement Project. Thanks to all our faithful and generous parishioners who have made this achievement possible, and especially to the anonymous donors who offered the \$250,000 match as an incentive.

While 100% of the Match Grant goal will be reached during the month of January, it is not too late to financially support the project. *Our total estimated cost is \$600,000*, so we still need another \$100,000 to fully fund the project. Ideally, we will have all funds in place by the end of March 2022 to prevent the need for a short-term loan with the Diocese of Venice.

We are on schedule to have windows delivered by the end of January, so please watch the bulletin for future updates as the project progresses.





