



### Saints—Pathways of Prayer:

#### **St. John of the Cross-Part 8**

We continue this week examining the amazing writings and analogy of St. John of the Cross and the continuation of St. John's explanation of the "dark night of the soul"

As St. John explains, the dark night requires a passive experience of God freeing the spiritual faculties of their attachments and to their idols and says that the night of the spirit completes the purgation begun in the night of the senses. The first night is like cutting off a branch of a tree; this night of the spirit is like taking up roots. The first night is like removing a new stain; the second night rubs out an old deeply embedded stain. In Jesus' life the first night is like "The Son of Man has nowhere to rest his head" (Mt 8, 20); the second night is reminiscent of "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" (Mt27, 46).

In St. John's framework the passive night of the spirit "empties" the intellect, memory, and will of their content and replaces it with truly theological faith, hope and love. St. John understands this night to be an inflow of God into the soul ....that "contemplatives call infused contemplation or mystical theology" Nothing can be done to alleviate this midnight experience in our spiritual journey. The most difficult part of the experience is the sense that God has rejected the soul, that it is losing God.

St. John tells us that there is another very great benefit for the soul in this "dark night of the soul", which is that it practices several virtues together, as, for example, patience and longsuffering, which are often called upon in these times of emptiness, when the soul endures and perseveres in its spiritual exercises without consolation and without pleasure. It practices the charity of God, since it is not now moved by the pleasure of attraction and sweetness which it finds in its work, but moved only by God. It likewise practices here the virtue of fortitude, because, in these difficulties, which it finds in its work, it brings strength out of weakness and thus becomes strong. All the virtues, in short—the theological and also the cardinal and moral—both in body and in spirit, are practiced by the soul in these times of aridity. And that in this "dark night of the soul" it obtains four benefits which we have here described namely, delight of peace, habitual remembrance and thought of God, cleanness and purity of soul.

### Year of St. Joseph

#### This year, Let's Go to Joseph

God spoke to Joseph four times in dreams, and each time, Joseph reacted decisively and promptly. He put his neck on the line to bring Mary into his home when she was found to be pregnant before they were married. He packed up their lives *overnight* and fled to Egypt when danger loomed. And when they moved back, they settled in a strange place – Nazareth – to keep Jesus safe.

All of these actions were prompted by dreams, but they required Joseph to be in tune with God, to begin with. He was able to hear God speaking through these dreams – there was not a second line of thought competing in his head. I imagine Joseph being diligent in prayer – a quiet, humble man who had no trouble recognizing the truth when it found him, and who immediately re-organized his life to follow it.

The FAITHFULNESS of Joseph is inspiring to fathers. It calls fathers to be faithful in their actions with their families so that it's their EXAMPLE that speaks.

### During the “Our Father”...

There seems to be a controversy involving what people do with their hands during the “Our Father” prayer at Mass. It is a controversy that I find curious. There are no rubrics defining what the people should do, or should not do, with their hands during that prayer. When some hold out their hands, others accuse them of mimicking the priest.

One puzzling thing about that for me is that imitating the priest is likely not the origin of that gesture by the people. It is more likely a product of the charismatic movement. Another is that I would question whether that gesture is even the ideal one for the priest. I do it because the rubrics call for it. However, this “orans” posture is only used elsewhere in the Mass when the priest prays alone. During prayers that the priest prays with the people (examples would include the Gloria and the Creed), the priest prays with his hands together.

Will a future version of the Roman Missal change that rubric for the priest? I do not know. In any event, I do not see any value in getting concerned about what the people do with their hands during that prayer (as long as it is reverent).

## What is a Synod of Bishops?

Almost every two years since 1967, the Church has celebrated a Synod of Bishops. This is a special and unique moment in the life of the Church. Bishops from all over the world gather to assist the Bishop of Rome with “providing for the good of the universal Church”. In each Synod, the Church “journeys together”, along a specific path, focusing on a theme chosen by the Pope. In the end, the Pope “confirms his brethren in the faith” regarding “matters and situations that bear upon the internal life of the Church and upon the kind of action (s) that the Church should be carrying on in today’s world” (Pope St. Paul VI)

## The Role of the Synod of Bishops

In the words of Pope Francis, the Synod of Bishops is a body that, “manifests the solicitude of the College of Bishops for the needs of the People of God and for communion among the Churches.” The Synod is a means of gathering information on a particular theme from local Churches. The Synodal Assembly has a “consultative role, offering information and counsel to the Roman Pontiff on various ecclesial questions, under the guidance of the Holy Spirit.” (Pope Francis using the words of Pope St. Paul VI). The Synodal Process, then, is to be a suitable instrument to give voice to the entire People of God.


