

# Fr. John Britto's Weekly Message

Sunday December 26, 2021

Dear friends,

We celebrated together our four-week Advent preparation for the birth of Jesus Christ on 25 December, and now the secular world tells us that Christmas is over. NO! Please do not give into such deceptions. **The Christmas season of the liturgical year has just begun**, and Catholics celebrate its beauty and joy through 9 January 2022, the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. Please cherish these days, continue to enjoy the music of the season, and contemplate on the beauty of the God who became one of us by putting on human flesh in all its vulnerability.

**This weekend, we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family**, and the theme of Christmas continues. We cannot be fully immersed in the mystery of God pitching his tent among us without the cooperation of Mary and Joseph, and He longs for our cooperation as well to bless our families with the same holiness of obedience to the Father's will. Today, Luke presents the story of Jesus remaining in Jerusalem after the feast of the Passover and those agonizing moments when Mary and Joseph returned to search for him; we can only imagine the relief they must have experienced upon finding him in the Temple and the very cheeky answer Jesus would give them. But the beauty comes in the way Mary and Joseph handle Jesus' response, in how they begin to collect all of these treasures and ponder them throughout the course of their lives. Our children, too, give us ample reason to be stressed about their attitudes and behaviors, often in stark contrast to how they were raised. Look to Mother Mary and Joseph for their guidance and inspiration.

Moving on to SJE family matters, I am once again amazed at your generosity with our campaign 2.0. If you have not yet responded, please take a moment to prayerfully complete your pledge details. On Friday, 31 December 2021, the last day of the year, we will pray in thanksgiving for all the blessings we have received by spending an hour in Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 4 to 5 p.m. Immediately following, we will celebrate the Vigil Mass of the Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God.

**Saturday, 1 January 2022, is the Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God. Although not a Holy Day of Obligation this year** because it falls on a Saturday, we will celebrate with Mass at 10 a.m., a great way to begin the New Year. The Vigil Mass of the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord will be celebrated at 4.30 p.m.

**Please know that the office will be closed beginning 24 December to give our staff time to celebrate with their families. We will reopen on Monday, 3 January 2022.**

The month of January will be another busy one as we **celebrate the 4<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the dedication of our beautiful sanctuary**. This year, we will celebrate it on Sunday, 16 January, during the 11 a.m. Mass. In addition, we will take a moment to **recognize Misty Huff, our Business Manager**, who will be receiving the **Spirit of Holy Cross Award** given by the Congregation of Holy Cross for her meritorious service to our parish. A luncheon will follow in the Holy Cross Hall, with special guests from Notre Dame to celebrate the occasion.

Each year, the Church celebrates the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph to both celebrate their lives as the holiest of families and to remind us that our families are likewise called to be holy. In the redemptive mission of the Word Incarnate, Jesus came to make all things new, and His very first act was to renew the human family, to sanctify it and set it apart for holiness. They were holy because they placed God at the center of their family life, they lived and sacrificed for one another, and they radiated that love to others.

Our family life becomes sanctified when we live the life of the Church in our home. In making Christ the center of family and individual life, we become the “church in miniature” or the “domestic church.” It is within the family that our children are first introduced to the faith and where they first encounter the Risen Lord, experience His love, and come to believe.

Mothers and fathers, do we teach our children to pray, do we pray with them both in and outside the home? Do we show them the love of God by our own love and affection for one another and our concern and care and for all those in need?

Do we teach them about the suffering of Jesus borne for them when they are sick and hurting?

Do we dedicate our children to the Lord? Do we diligently prepare them for the sacraments and invoke the angels and saints, especially Mary and Joseph to assist them and us?

Children, do you humbly follow the example of Jesus, who loves you so much, by honoring and obeying your parents as Jesus honored and obeyed Joseph and Mary?

The Holy Family of Jesus is the greatest example and model for all human families. Like yours and mine, they knew and experienced hardships and tensions.

Let us pray to Jesus our God, asking the intercession of St. Joseph and our Blessed Mother, that like these two greatest of saints, we will place Him at the center of our homes.

Let us remember that Jesus is *Emmanuel* - “God with us” - and He is with our families, always.

## Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph

Families can be very difficult things to negotiate. This is true not only of our families of origin, the current family of which we are a part, the family of our Church, our society, and our global family as well. Everything human can be found in family stories. Those stories speak of wonderful life-giving successes as well as painful spirit-robbing abuses. Our greatest joys and our greatest wounds are usually connected with the experience of family. Our needs, experiences, and unresolved baggage often color what we bring to our familiar relationships. They contribute to our level of defensiveness, how guarded and protected we become, and what prejudices we believe.

In order to break the cycle of dysfunction we have to remember that it is not only by human effort that we negotiate the difficult and challenging events of our lives. There is a Divine Effort at work as well. For sure, the human effort can create quite a mess and easily destroy lives. This is true of any family with which we are associated. Today's Feast of the Holy Family serves to help us understand that there is a Divine Story being told as well. It is a story of perseverance in the face of hardship, determination in the face of despair, healing when we see nothing but wounds, and light where there is darkness.

Do we believe that God is always working, guiding, restoring, and leading? Unless we do, we will never be free from the imperfections and wounds that bind us and never be able to understand what it really means to forgive. Pope Francis tells us that the "light which comes from the Holy Family encourages us to offer human warmth to other families." While this is most certainly true, we can only really begin to do this when we realize that we are still works in progress, not anchored to the wounds and sins of our past, and still a leading star in God's continually unfolding story of love. The Holy Family persevered and radiated warmth because they knew they were not alone. We can too.
