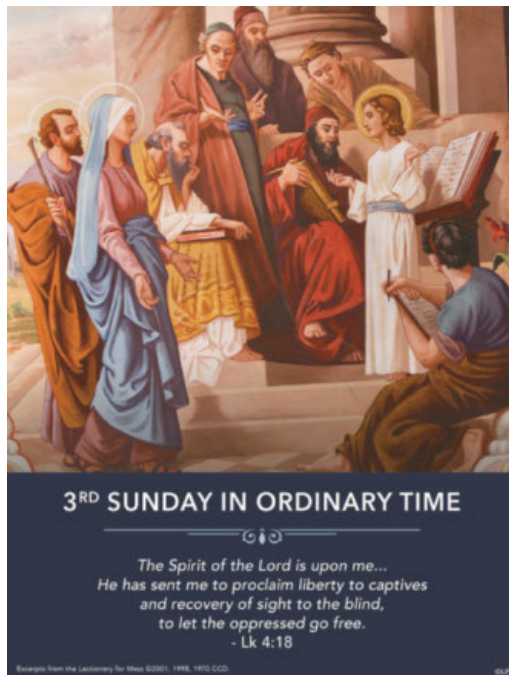

Fr. John Britto's Weekly Message

Sunday, January 23, 2022

Dear friends,

Oh, how good it is to worship you, Lord, in your sanctuary! It was so wonderful to have celebrated the 4th anniversary of the dedication of our church last weekend. I remembered all of you at the Masses and thanked God for you and your families. We have a beautiful sanctuary in which to worship and honor our God, and it is all because of your generosity.

I wish to **thank Misty and congratulate her** for her selfless service to our community. Thanks to all of you for making the celebration a memorable one for her. I also thank our liturgical ministries and the Knights for their participation, the kitchen crew, the welcome committee, and all the volunteers including our catechists, teens, and the scouts for putting together a very special lunch for those in attendance. **Our special guests from Notre Dame were truly impressed** by the involvement of so many of our parishioners in ministry to the parish. Finally, I thank those who attended Fr. John DeRiso's presentation on Monday, 17 January, about Fr. Basil Moreau and the charism of the Congregation of Holy Cross.

The Third Sunday in Ordinary Time is also celebrated as **the Sunday of the Word of God**. 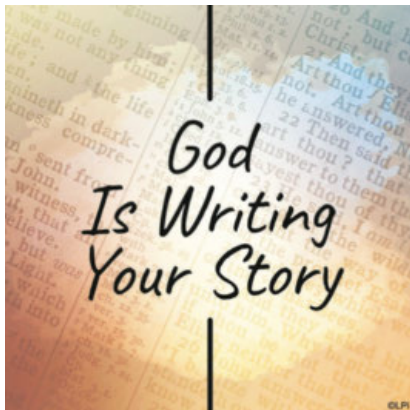

OUR 2022 MISSION COOPERATIVE APPEAL

The Propagation of the Faith office of our archdiocese has invited the Diocese of Kumbakonam, India to participate in the Mission Cooperative Appeal in our parish this year.

Rev. M.S. Selva Raj will speak about this on the weekend of January 29/30.

This Diocese, started in 1899 in the state of Tamil Nadu, India, has an area of 7824 sq km, a Catholic population of 213,000 (6% of the population) living in 94 parishes and 610 missions served by 224 diocesan and 79 religious priests, 620 nuns, 12 trained catechists, 330 untrained lay catechists, and two social service centers.

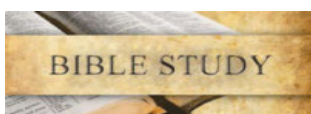
Adult Confirmation Preparation

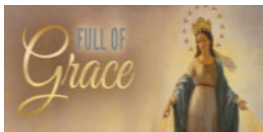

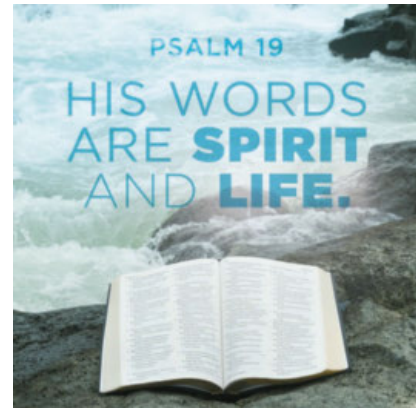

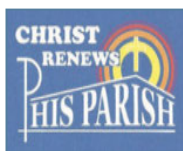

You will establish a **closer relationship with Jesus** . . . you will also establish a **close relationship with your fellow** retreatants and gain life-long friends.

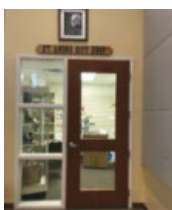

Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

Human history reveals many periods where people lost a sense of God's transcendence. It may even be argued that human beings have been wandering and lost more than they have been at home and focused. Human nature being what it is, we struggle with who God really is — the God of our salvation history or the “gods” of human constructs. Relying on our own designs and pursuits, we forget that we really are meant to listen to One upon whom the Spirit of the Lord rests, Jesus Christ, and not to ourselves. That same history that reveals our fickleness and infidelity also reveals God's constancy and faithfulness. God always finds us.

As people wander and fumble to find their way, God is there bringing them back to holiness and giving them the assurance of His presence. We have to allow God's Word, God's life, to touch us and change us. It can make us more flexible and attentive to the sacred in all facets of life so that every day is one that is holy. Every day is a time when fulfillment is possible for one's soul. Jesus stood before those gathered in the synagogue as the fulfillment of words of promise that were echoed long ago. God doesn't forget. He always comes for us.

Now it is time to remember to go to God. Sometimes our lives are so confused and tangled that it is difficult to see the Word and hand of God. But when we realize, deep within, the depth of friendship God offers to us it really has the power to turn sadness to joy. The promise is fulfilled. Going frequently to God's Word, allowing ourselves to be enriched and rejuvenated, and pondering the certainty of God's fidelity and promise permanently transforms us. We will be more aware of the sacred and the holy and less invested in things that pull us away.

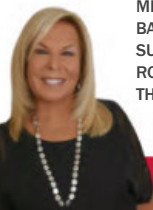
