- Provide our phone number: (850) 516-8927.
- Give the person our card which you can obtain from the church office or from a Vincentian.
- Do not give out the personal number of one of us, we cannot use our phones to communicate with neighbors in need.
- Do not send the person needing help to the church office as they will be directed to call our phone to make the contact.
- Tell anyone who asks that we do not discriminate but try to help regardless of race, religion, personal beliefs or living situation of those coming with requests.
- Tell anyone who asks that we do not hand out cash but we learn the needs through a home visit to which they must consent, and then offer the assistance we can through bill paying, advice as to where help can be obtained, car repair, directions to resources, home repairs and a host of other ways.
- Explain that it is the generosity of St. Sylvester members which allows us to the work of St. Vincent de Paul and we welcome their phone call if they need assistance. **THANK YOU!**

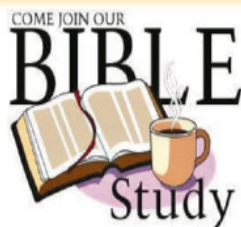

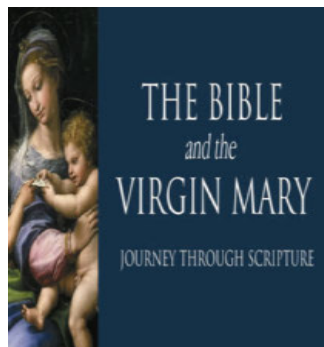
