GOSPEL MEDITATION ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

Families can be very difficult things to negotiate. This is true not only of our families of origin, the current family of which we are a part, the family of our Church, our society, and our global family as well. Everything human can be found in family stories. Those stories speak of wonderful life-giving successes as well as painful spirit-robbing abuses. Our greatest joys and our greatest wounds are usually connected with the experience of family. Our needs, experiences, and unresolved baggage often color what we bring to our familiar relationships. They contribute to our level of defensiveness, how guarded and protected we become, and what prejudices we believe.

In order to break the cycle of dysfunction we have to remember that it is not only by human effort that we negotiate the difficult and challenging events of our lives. There is a Divine Effort at work as well. For sure, the human effort can create quite a mess and easily destroy lives. This is true of any family with which we are associated. Today's Feast of the Holy Family serves to help us understand that there is a Divine Story being told as well. It is a story of perseverance in the face of hardship, determination in the face of despair, healing when we see nothing but wounds, and light where there is darkness.

Do we believe that God is always working, guiding, restoring, and leading? Unless we do, we will never be free from the imperfections and wounds that bind us and never be able to understand what it really means to forgive. Pope Francis tells us that the "light which comes from the Holy Family encourages us to offer human warmth to other families." While this is most certainly true, we can only really begin to do this when we realize that we are still works in progress, not anchored to the wounds and sins of our past, and still a leading star in God's continually unfolding story of love. The Holy Family persevered and radiated warmth because they knew they were not alone. We can too.

Merry Christmas!

Our celebration of the mystery of God's nativity continues with today's Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. Family is an important part of Christmas – not only for the gatherings and memories that flood our minds, hearts, and experiences, but also because family is the modus operandi through which God's plan of salvation unfolds. Jesus was born into a family – as an innocent, vulnerable human infant. He was dependent on his parents for care and sustenance. The love of the family is most often expressed through sacrifice and service to one another. This echoes God's own movement in our lives as Christ sacrifices Himself in service to humanity – a story that begins with Jesus' birth with Mary and Joseph.

Some years ago, I was involved with some ecumenical and interreligious initiatives for the diocese I was serving, and I got to know a Jewish Rabbi who taught me a little bit about the Festival of Lights (a.k.a. Hanukkah). This eight-night event typically falls somewhere within the Christian seasons of Advent and Christmas. It commemorates the rededication of the Second [Jewish] Temple and is symbolized through the lighting of the menorah –

which includes eight candles, plus a ninth located in the center, that stands above the other eight. This special candle is known as the Shammash (literally, "attendant" in Hebrew). It has much to teach us about the true meaning of Christmas and about the ideal framework for the family.

The role of the Shammash is to be a servant to the other candles. It is the light that is used to ignite the other candles of the menorah and it serves as a constant presence throughout the festival. In Christianity our ritual use of the Paschal Candle, a symbol of the light of Christ, occupies a similar purpose. We light baptismal candles from the paschal candle as a way of passing-on the light of Christ that came into the world through the Nativity.

Today's celebration of Christmas with its emphasis on the Holy Family sets out our place in the family – both nuclear and Christian – of being a shammash, a servant, to others. This is what it means to be part of the Body of Christ. This is the example Jesus' incarnation presents to us. It is the witness we are called to be to others.

¡Feliz Navidad!

Nuestra celebración del misterio de la natividad de Dios continúa con la fiesta de la Sagrada Familia de Jesús, María y José. La familia es una parte importante de la Navidad, no solo por las reuniones y los recuerdos que inundan nuestras mentes, corazones y experiencias, sino también porque la familia es el modus operandi a través del cual se desarrolla el plan de salvación de Dios. Jesús nació en una familia, como un niño humano inocente y vulnerable. Dependía de sus padres para su cuidado y sustento. El amor de la familia se expresa con mayor frecuencia a través del sacrificio y el servicio mutuo. Esto se hace eco del propio movimiento de Dios en nuestras vidas cuando Cristo se sacrifica a sí mismo en servicio a la humanidad, una historia que comienza con el nacimiento de Jesús con María y José.

Hace algunos años, estuve involucrado en algunas iniciativas ecuménicas e interreligiosas para la diócesis a la que servía, y conocí a un rabino judío que me enseñó un poco sobre el Festival de las Luces (también conocido como Hanukkah). Este evento de ocho noches generalmente cae en algún lugar dentro de las temporadas cristianas de Adviento y Navidad. Conmemora la reedificación del Segundo Templo [judío] y se simboliza a través de la iluminación de la menorá: que incluye ocho velas, más una novena ubicada en el centro, que se encuentra por encima de las otras ocho. Esta vela especial se conoce como el Shammash (literalmente, "asistente" en hebreo). Tiene mucho que enseñarnos sobre el verdadero significado de la Navidad y sobre el esquema ideal de la familia.

El papel del Shammash es ser un sirviente de las otras velas. Es la luz que se utiliza para encender las otras velas de la menorá y sirve como una presencia constante durante todo el festival. En el cristianismo nuestro uso ritual del cirio pascual, un símbolo de la luz de Cristo, ocupa un propósito similar. Encendemos las velas

bautismales del cirio pascual como una forma de transmitir la luz de Cristo que vino al mundo a través de la Natividad.

La celebración de la Navidad de hoy, con su énfasis en la Sagrada Familia, establece nuestro lugar en la familia, tanto nuclear como cristiana, de ser un shammash, un siervo, para los demás. Esto es lo que significa ser parte del Cuerpo de Cristo. Este es el ejemplo que la encarnación de Jesús nos presenta. Es el testimonio que estamos llamados a ser para los demás.

Minor-aged participants enrolled in parish-based catechesis are encouraged to participate in this programming. *The Circle of Grace program* helps children and young people learn about relationships, sexuality, chastity, and abuse from a Catholic perspective. Sessions are designed to cover these sensitive topics in an engaging, interactive manner, using language and activities that are age appropriate.

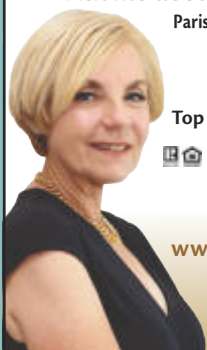
