

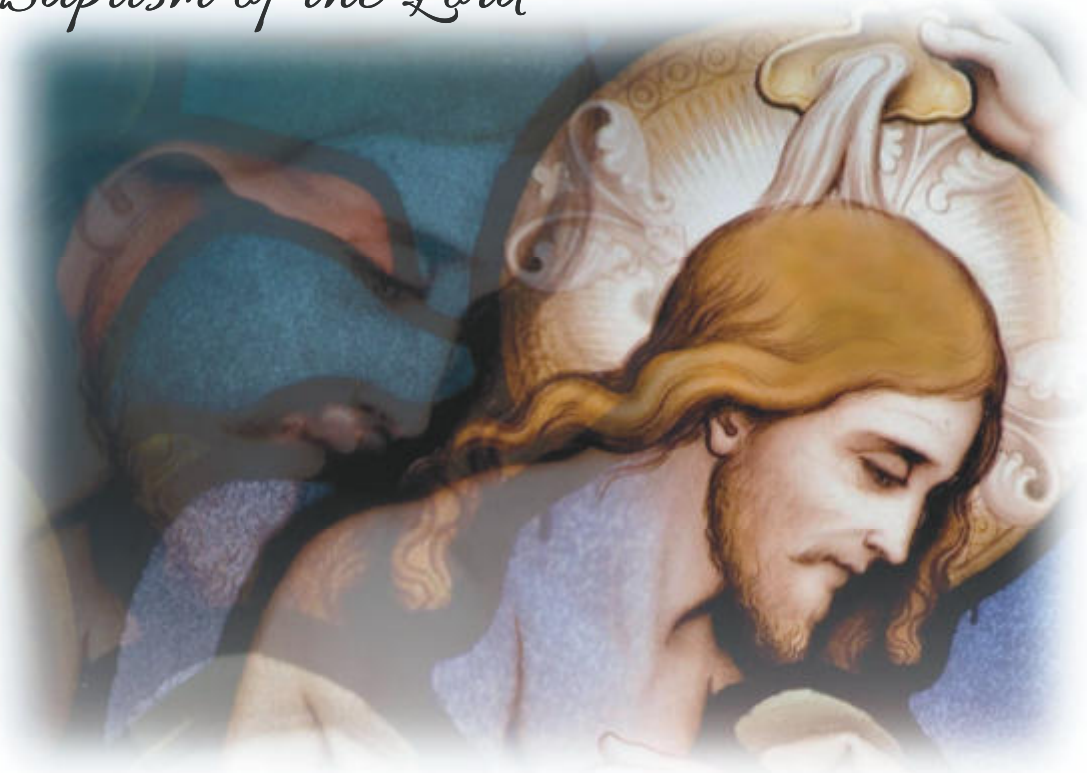

GOSPEL MEDITATION ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

“We are called to live our baptism every day, as new creatures, clothed in Christ.”

— Pope Francis

What reference point do you use when making decisions? Many times, impulse takes control and decisions are made based solely on emotion and desire. We all know that these types of decisions can often get us into trouble. When a person has a confident sense of who they are and a real understanding of what is important and of value, the likelihood of kneejerk impulsive choices diminishes. Baptism gives us what we need to make well informed and purposeful decisions. By this simple gesture, God claims us as His own and provides us with the identity and purpose we need to properly live life.

It is tremendously reassuring, when we truly embrace this revelation and realize that we no longer have to wonder about the purpose of our lives or struggle to find our way. The answer of who we are in God has been given to us. We no longer have to fumble around, trip over ourselves or walk aimlessly about. Issues surrounding the sacredness of life, the meaning of death, the protection of those most vulnerable, care for the weak and the poor, offering hospitality to those in search of a home, the purpose and proper place of

work, how to create a just social order, caring for creation, and understanding our roles as heralds and stewards are just a few of the wonderful gifts baptism brings. When we make decisions based on things such as these core Gospel truths we really act as Christ himself, revealing to others the new creations that we are. This is how we live our baptism.

It is difficult to walk against the tide. Yet, that is precisely what baptism calls us to do. Although we are sinners, in need of mercy and far from perfection we are called to order our life and make decisions based upon the wisdom and guidance of Almighty God. He alone is the one who can claim us as His sons and daughters. Standing up for our principles will not make us popular. But who ever said Christianity is a popularity contest? Baptism calls us to stand up for that which goes against the grain of secularism. Standing in line with other sinners, we have our anchor to steady us in the tempests of life and God is very pleased. Forge ahead. There is nothing to fear.

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

ALENTAR UN ENTENDIMIENTO MÁS PROFUNDO DE LA ESCRITURA

Con la celebración del Bautismo del Señor se da por terminado el tiempo de Navidad. El Bautismo de Jesús es como una nueva epifanía, es decir, una nueva manifestación de Dios por medio de Jesús ahora en el Jordán. *“El Espíritu Santo bajó sobre él y se manifestó exteriormente en forma de paloma, y del cielo vino una voz: Tú eres mi Hijo, hoy te he dado la vida”* (Lucas 3,22). La revelación del Padre se manifiesta proclamando a Jesús como su Hijo.

El Papa Francisco en una de sus catequesis lo muestra en tres puntos muy importantes para todos los que hemos sido bautizados en Cristo Jesús: *“Jesús quiso recibir el bautismo predicado y administrado por Juan el Bautista en el Jordán. ¡Cuánta humildad tiene Jesús! Y al hacerlo, manifestó lo que hemos celebrado en Navidad: sumergirse en el río de la humanidad”. Jesús, va con todo a lo que refiere la cuestión humana, menos en el pecado. “El Evangelio subraya que Jesús, apenas salió del agua vio rasgarse los cielos y el Espíritu que bajaba hacia él como una paloma. El Espíritu Santo desciende en plenitud sobre Jesús para*

darle la fortaleza de cumplir su misión”. Por medio de nuestra vocación es que tenemos nuestra misión en la vida. ¿Cómo la estamos cumpliendo? *“La fiesta del bautismo de Jesús invita a cada cristiano a recordar su bautismo”.* ¿Sabes, o recuerdas la fecha de tu bautismo? Hay que preguntar sobre ese día y de cómo se celebró la fiesta de hacernos hijos e hijas de Dios. (Papa Francisco 1/7/2018).

Merry Christmas!

Today is our last day of the Christmas Season and how appropriate that it ends with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord.

Jesus' baptism was not a Christian baptism in the sense that you and I understand it. Jesus was a Jew. His baptism is referent to a Jewish purification rite – after all, Jesus did not have sin so baptism in the Christian context of original sin was not necessary. However, Jesus' baptism is a marker that points to the beginning of His public ministry. In this sense, it may seem strange that it shows up on the liturgical calendar at the end of our Christmas celebration, but I assure you it is not. Let me explain.

Our Christmas focal point has been the mystery of the incarnation – that God becomes flesh and dwells among us. Jesus is born of Mary and Joseph where he lives and grows. Obviously, His baptism comes much later when he already into adulthood. How do we bridge the gap and connect these aspects together as part of the Christmas Season?

The fullness of Christmas is a spiritual lesson in the framework of discipleship. God comes and dwells among us through the mystery of the incarnation so that our fallen nature can be restored. In response, we need an epiphany – an awakening – each of us needs to encounter His presence and seek Him, as did the magi.

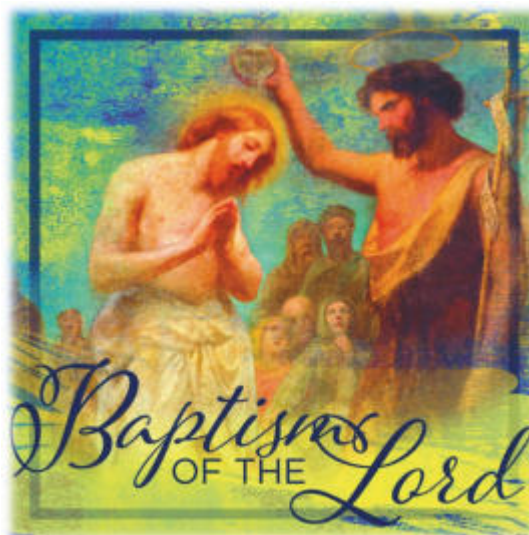
Our baptism marks in sacramental ritual the connection and commitment we have to the Lord. Baptism begins the path of discipleship – i.e., of intentionally following Jesus. This is precisely why it makes sense to include the Baptism of the Lord as a feast of Christmas because Christ shows us that our faith must be alive and active. The Church has two complimentary terms for this spiritual metanoia that aligns us to Jesus as His followers. One is

orthodoxy (right-praying) which focuses our mind and heart on Christ. The other is orthopraxis (right-action) which aims our spirit and behavior to do as Jesus would do. Together, Christian orthodoxy and orthopraxis ensure that we believe and live in Christ and for others. This is an essential and necessary part of the Christmas story because ultimately it is about “gift” – God's gift to us in the person of Jesus incarnate and our gift to God through our service to others – this is the faith we hold dear and express with the witness of our lives.

Christmas leaps from infant Jesus – God born among us – to servant Jesus in ministry to heal and save humanity because it is never enough to focus on the Christ child. The implications of our faith go profoundly deeper. May we be cognizant of this throughout the year.

¡Feliz Navidad!

Hoy es nuestro último día el tiempo de la navidad y qué apropiado que termine con la fiesta del Bautismo del Señor.

El bautismo de Jesús no fue un bautismo cristiano en el sentido de que tú y yo lo entendemos. Jesús era judío. Su bautismo es referente a un rito de purificación judío – de hecho, porque Jesús no tenía pecado, el bautismo en el contexto cristiano del pecado original no es necesario. Sin embargo, el bautismo de Jesús es un marcador que apunta al comienzo de su ministerio público. En este sentido, puede parecer extraño que aparezca en el calendario litúrgico al final de nuestra celebración navideña, pero les aseguro que no lo es. Déjame explicarles.

El punto fijo de la Navidad ha sido el misterio de la encarnación: que Dios se hizo carne entre nosotros. Jesús nació de María y José, donde vivió y creció. Obviamente, Su bautismo viene mucho más tarde cuando ya está en la etapa adulta. ¿Cómo podemos cerrar la brecha y conectar estos aspectos como parte de la temporada navideña?

La plenitud de la Navidad es una lección espiritual en el esquema del discipulado. Dios viene y vive entre nosotros a través del misterio de la encarnación así nuestra naturaleza caída pueda ser restaurada. Para responder a esto, necesitamos una epifanía, tenemos que despertarnos cada uno, para que encontremos Su presencia y lo busquemos, como lo hicieron los magos.

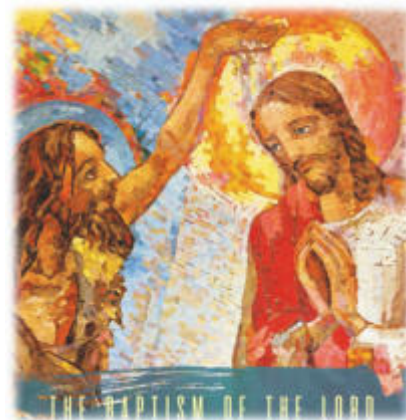
Nuestro bautismo marcado en un rito sacramental demuestra la conexión y el compromiso que tenemos con el Señor. El bautismo comienza el camino del discipulado, es decir, de seguir intencionalmente a Jesús. Esta es precisamente la razón por la cual está incluido el Bautismo del Señor como una fiesta navideña porque Cristo nos muestra que nuestra fe tiene que ser viva y

activa. La Iglesia tiene dos términos complementarios para esta metanoia espiritual que nos alinea con Jesús como Sus seguidores. Una es la ortodoxia (oración correcta) que enfoca nuestra mente y corazón en Cristo. La otra es la ortopraxis (acción correcta) que apunta a que nuestro espíritu y comportamiento hagan lo que Jesús haría. Juntos, la ortodoxia cristiana y la ortopraxis aseguran que creamos y vivamos en Cristo y para los demás. Esta es una parte esencial y necesaria de la historia de la Navidad porque, al final la navidad se trata de un "regalo" – el regalo de Dios para nosotros a través de la persona de Jesús encarnado y el regalo a Dios que le ofrecemos a través de nuestro servicio a los demás – esta es la fe que apreciamos y expresamos con el testimonio de nuestras vidas.

La Navidad empiece del niño Jesús, Dios nacido entre nosotros, y termina atado a Jesús el sirviente cuyo ministerio es sanar y salvar a la humanidad; nunca es suficiente enfocarse solo en el niño Jesús. Las implicaciones de nuestra fe son profundamente más profundas. Que seamos conscientes de esto durante todo el año.

Minor-aged participants enrolled in parish-based catechesis are encouraged to participate in this programming. *The Circle of Grace program* helps children and young people learn about relationships, sexuality, chastity, and abuse from a Catholic perspective. Sessions are designed to cover these sensitive topics in an engaging, interactive manner, using language and activities that are age appropriate.

We have a great group of volunteer counters who process the weekly collections. We are so grateful for their service to the parish.

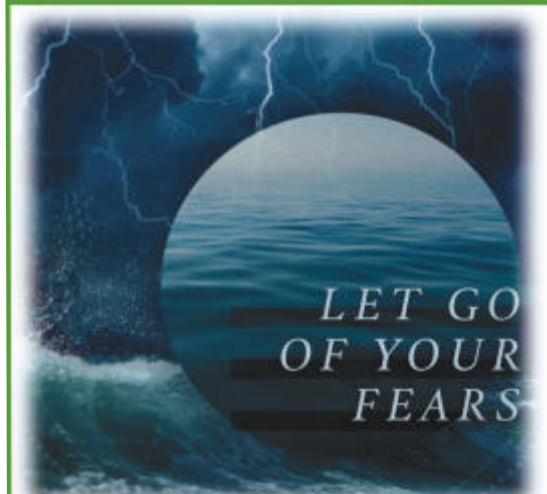
They have a few requests:

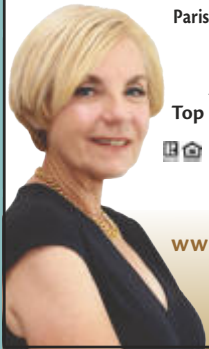
