

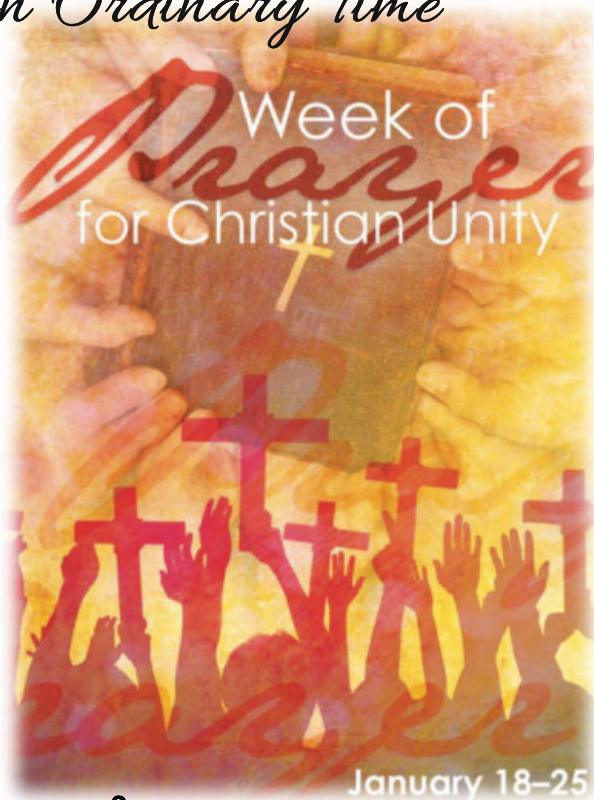

## GOSPEL MEDITATION ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

God delights in you. How do you feel when you hear that? Delight usually comes with an exuberant flow of joy that seemingly arises from one's toes with the expression of great glee. Reflecting upon the deep measure of joy God has in us can be a source of joy for ourselves. Delight is infectious. A very young brother and sister were playing on the beach when the all too familiar ice cream truck made its daily rounds. The boy shook with excitement and delight as he took his sister's hand and exclaimed, "The ice cream man is here, isn't it great!" As they ran off toward the truck, one could hear the girl reply, "Yeah, I can't wait!" The experience of a child's delight in something so simple as ice cream, lifts our spirits from our burdens and transports us to the lighter, more innocent side of life.

Life is not meant to be a burden. Believe it or not, God actually wants us to be happy! In fact, the wedding feast at Cana shows us that God even puts His blessing on our happiness. It is okay to celebrate the wonder of ourselves and others. Life is good. It is always interesting to note that Jesus saves the good wine until last. You would think it would be the other way around. The superb quality of Jesus' wine points to the superior quality of life we find in Christ. It is not a life of burdens but a life of wonder and delight! In Christ, we are lifted from the superficial and mundane to a life of purpose, hope, and love.

God is with us through the long haul, through the challenges and sorrows as well as the successes and accomplishments. In spite of the fact that we often wander from the path, God's celebratory delight in us remains. As spouses are asked to remain faithful to each other through whatever life brings, God remains faithful too. This promise remains through this life and into the next. All we have to do is take the advice of Jesus' mother to heart when she says, "Listen to him." This wisdom saves us from foolishly giving in to the illusion that we can make better wine than Jesus.

## MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

### ALENTAR UN ENTENDIMIENTO MÁS PROFUNDO DE LA ESCRITURA

Con la fiesta de la Epifanía y el Bautismo del Señor se cierra el Tiempo de Navidad, que siempre es precedido por el Adviento. Ahora, comenzamos el Tiempo Ordinario. Serán siete domingos de este corto periodo, que termina el día anterior al Miércoles de Ceniza. La segunda etapa de este Tiempo es más larga, da comienzo después del domingo de Pentecostés y termina hasta el sábado antes del primer domingo de Adviento. ¿Para qué sirve a los cristianos este Tiempo Ordinario? ¿Qué nos pide la Liturgia de este tiempo? Pues, es muy sencillo, nos pide meditar en el misterio de Cristo. En su invitación de participar en su Reino con alegría y compromiso verdadero. La Iglesia tiene diversidad de carismas, donde podemos entregarnos al servicio de los demás.

Por ejemplo, hoy el Evangelio nos invita a participar junto con María y Jesús en las bodas de Caná. Y es ahí en esa boda, donde Jesús hace su primer milagro a petición de su Madre María. El diálogo de ambos viene a ser a causa de la falta de vino. Por lo tanto, los novios estaban en apuros por esta razón. Este relato es muy

profundo, el hecho de que Jesús participa en la boda, tiene como significado la boda de Dios con la humanidad, que más adelante será la Sangre de Jesús derramada para la salvación de la humanidad. *“Alegrémonos, regocijémonos démosle honor y gloria, porque han llegado las bodas del Cordero” (Apocalipsis 19,7)*. También, el profeta en la primera lectura lo pone claro: *“No te llamaran más ‘Abandonada’, ni a tu tierra ‘Desolada’, sino que te llamaran ‘Mi Preferida’ y a tu tierra ‘Desposada’. Porque Yavé se complacerá en ti y tu tierra tendrá un esposo” (Isaías 62,4)*.

# FROM OUR DIRECTOR OF PARISH LIFE

Welcome to the Second Week of Ordinary Time. We didn't skip a week but since last Sunday's celebration of Baptism of the Lord constituted the end of the Christmas Season we spent this past Monday-thru-Saturday in Ordinary Time which makes today the

commencement of our second week. This is a long way around to say, "time flies; happy Ordinary Time!"

Ordinary Time is an opportunity for spiritual maturation and personal growth because it falls outside the liturgical seasons of Advent, Christmas, Lent, and Easter; it provides a perfect opportunity to focus on self. What might you do?... Perhaps try some spiritual reading or Bible study or one of the programs on our parish subscription to Formed.org (it's free Catholic streaming of amazing content). Another pathway to consider is to take part in our Formation programming.

Ordinary Time is so named from the Latin, "ordinalis" which means "ordered or numbered" since Ordinary Time Sundays and Weeks consecutively flow from Christmas to Lent and from Pentecost to Advent. This year's first phase of Ordinary Time could be very beneficial for us as Catholics and as parishioners because the Church has commenced its process of local consultation for the Synod on Synodality. Particular churches, i.e., dioceses, are at the forefront of the consultation process with an input period that began in October 2021 and extends until April 2022.

A key theological underpinning in the synod process is the

idea that we stand before the Holy Spirit as a united People of God. An important aspect of ecclesial life is the understanding that the faithful – clergy and laity – are qualified and called to serve one another through the gifts they have each received from the Holy Spirit by virtue of their baptism. For a synodal Church the entire community, rich in diversity, is called to pray, to listen, to analyze, to dialogue, to discern and to offer input about pastoral decisions so that they correlate to God's will. While this approach to ecclesiology, i.e., the way the Church is structured is not new, this is likely to be a moment of renewal for us. We will have to see. But don't take my word for it, read a little about the Synod yourself. Here are the links for the preparation documents:

Bienvenidos a la Segunda Semana del Tiempo Ordinario. No nos saltamos una semana, pero dado que la celebración del Bautismo del Señor del domingo pasado constituyó el final de la temporada navideña, pasamos el pasado lunes a sábado en el Tiempo Ordinario, lo que hace que hoy sea el comienzo de nuestra segunda semana. Este es un largo camino para decir: "el tiempo vuela; ¡feliz Tiempo Ordinario!"

El Tiempo Ordinario es una oportunidad para la maduración espiritual y el crecimiento personal porque cae fuera de los tiempos litúrgicos de Adviento, Navidad, Cuaresma y Pascua; proporciona una oportunidad perfecta para centrarse en uno mismo. ¿Qué podrías hacer?... Tal vez leer alguna lectura espiritual o hacer un estudio bíblico o participe en uno de los programas de nuestra suscripción parroquial a Formed.org (es una transmisión católica gratuita de contenido increíble). Por otro lado, consideren a participar en nuestra programación de Formación.

El Tiempo Ordinario se llama así del latín, "ordinalis" que significa "ordenado o numerado" ya que los Domingos y Semanas del Tiempo Ordinario fluyen consecutivamente de Navidad a Cuaresma y de Pentecostés a Adviento. La primera fase del Tiempo Ordinario de este año podría ser muy beneficiosa para nosotros como católicos y como feligreses porque la Iglesia ha comenzado su proceso de consulta local para el Sínodo sobre la Sinodalidad. Las iglesias particulares, es decir, las diócesis, están a la primera parte del proceso de

consulta con un período de aportes que comenzó en octubre de 2021 y se extiende hasta abril de 2022.

Una base teológica clave en el proceso sinodal es la idea que estamos parados juntos ante el Espíritu Santo como un Pueblo de Dios. Un aspecto importante en eso es la idea que en la vida eclesial los fieles – clero y laicos – están calificados y llamados a servirse unos a otros a través de los dones que cada uno ha recibido del Espíritu Santo en virtud de su bautismo. Para una Iglesia sinodal, toda la comunidad, con su diversidad, está llamada a orar, a escuchar, a dialogar, a discernir y a ofrecer información sobre las decisiones pastorales para que ellas sean correlacionadas con la voluntad de Dios. Si este enfoque eclesiológico, es decir, la forma en que está estructurada la Iglesia no es nuevo, es probable que este sea un momento de renovación para nosotros. Habrá que ver. Pero no se tome mi palabra, lea un poco sobre el Sínodo usted mismo. Aquí están los enlaces para los documentos de preparación:

Minor-aged participants enrolled in parish-based catechesis are encouraged to participate in this programming. *The Circle of Grace program* helps children and young people learn about relationships, sexuality, chastity, and abuse from a Catholic perspective. Sessions are designed to cover these sensitive topics in an engaging, interactive manner, using language and activities that are age appropriate.

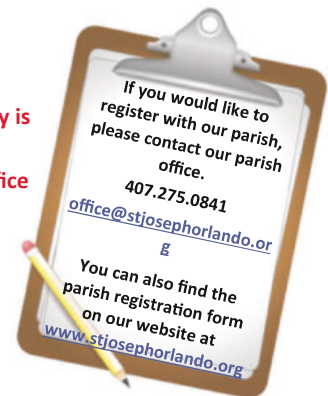

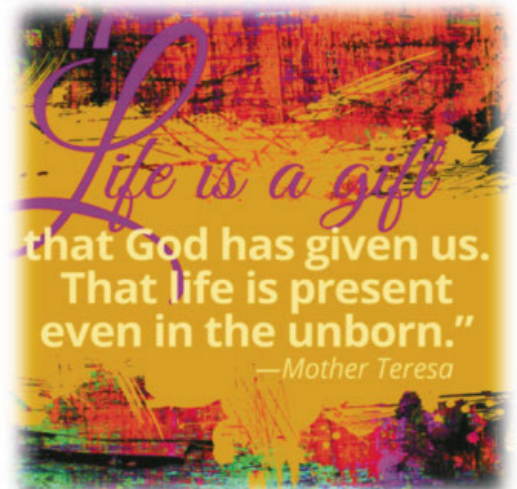


## “Choice-Making” A Women’s Afternoon of Reflection

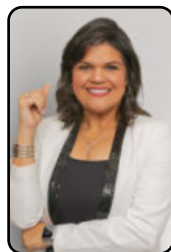
