**WHY DO WE DO THAT? - CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED**

**Latern Basilica**

**Question:**

November 9 is the feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome. What is the significance of this feast?

**Answer:**

Every diocese has a mother church, the bishop's cathedral where the diocesan church gathers and celebrates. The cathedral is the seat of the bishop's authority over the diocese. That authority is intended to be one of service to God's people, shepherding and guiding them in a truly pastoral mode.

The pope is first and foremost the Bishop of Rome, as well as the head of the Roman Catholic Church. St. John Lateran is his cathedral, and its prominence derives from that reality. St. John Lateran cathedral traces its origins to Emperor Constantine who converted a portion of the Laterani family palace into a church, and gave it to Pope Sylvester (314-335) as the papal church and residence; St. John refers to the two saints in whose honor the church is dedicated, John the Baptist and John the Evangelist. It became known as the cathedral of the pope, and its facade's inscription refers to it as "the Mother and Head of all Churches, in the City and of the World." The universal celebration of this feast stresses the unity among Roman Catholics, as they unite themselves with the chair of Peter. ©LPi



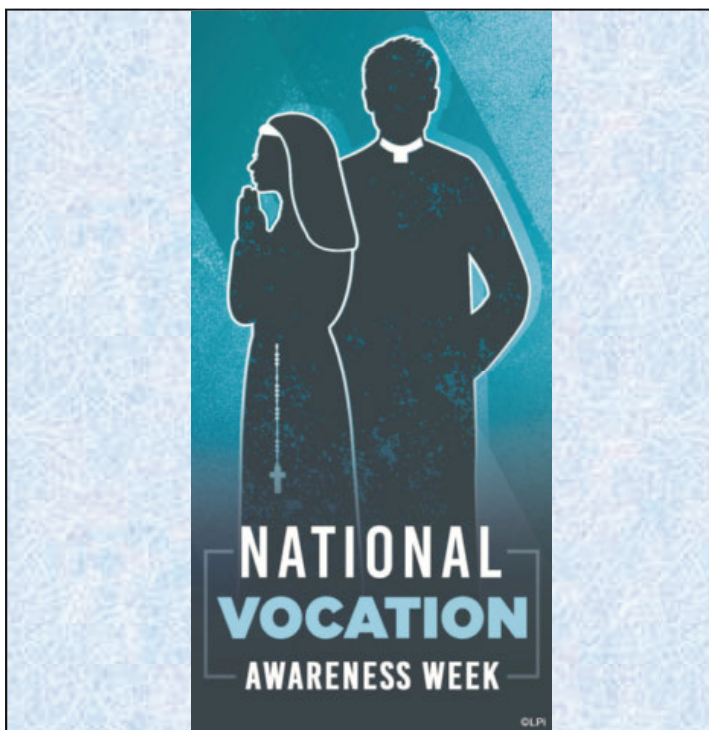

## Pope at Angelus: 'Jesus looks at us to restore our dignity'

Pope Francis reflects on the story of Jesus encountering Zacchaeus the tax collector, and says the Lord always gazes upon broken humanity with a desire to restore our dignity.

Pope Francis prayed the Angelus on Sunday with pilgrims gathered in St. Peter's Square, and reflected on the day's Gospel (Lk 19:1-10), which recounts the story of Jesus inviting Himself to stay with Zacchaeus.

The Pope focused his comments on the "gaze" shared by Zacchaeus and Jesus, as the chief tax collector looked down on Jesus from a tree.

Zacchaeus, who was the chief tax collector in the city of Jericho, was seeking to see "who Jesus was", but was short in stature and so had to climb a tree to see over the crowd.

Always a chance to start over

Pope Francis noted that Zacchaeus, as a tax collector for the Roman occupiers of Israel, surely took advantage of his position to extort money from others. Therefore, he was hated by everyone and branded a sinner.

Despite his short stature and public persona, Zacchaeus greatly desired to see Jesus, even though he does not yet know Him.

"Zacchaeus teaches us that, in life, all is never lost. We can always find space for the desire to begin again, to start over, to convert."

God humbles Himself to lift us up

The Pope then turned his thoughts to the gaze of Jesus, who was sent by the Father to seek those who are lost.

The Gospel of Luke says Jesus looked up and said to him, "Zacchaeus, come down quickly, for today I must stay at your house."

Pope Francis said these words present a beautiful image of Jesus "looking up" at Zacchaeus from below.

"This is the history of salvation: God has never looked down on us to humiliate and judge us. On the contrary, He lowered Himself to the point of washing our feet, looking at us from below and restoring our dignity to us."

This episode, added the Pope, sums up all of salvation history. "Humanity, with its miseries, seeks redemption, but firstly, God, with mercy, seeks His creature to save it," he said.

Compassionate gaze of the Church

Turning his attention what this Gospel means for us, Pope Francis pointed out that God never dwells on our past with all its errors, but rather looks "with infinite confidence at what we can become."

Even when we are unable to confront the challenges of life, he added, Jesus always "looks on us with love" and invites Himself into our home, if we are willing to welcome Him.

We too, concluded the Pope, are called to consider both how we look upon ourselves and how we gaze upon others who struggle to arise from "the dust of their mistakes".

"We Christians must have the gaze of Christ, who embraces from below, who seeks those who are lost, with compassion. This is, and must always be, the gaze of the Church." (www.vaticannews.va)

Son esas personas que tienen muchas posesiones y dinero y pareciera que no les importara, son desprendidos y bondadosos. *“Jesús le da un giro a esta perspectiva y afirma que nuestra peregrinación va de muerte a la vida: la vida plena, nosotros estamos de camino, en peregrinación hacia la vida plena, y esa vida plena es la que ilumina nuestro camino” (Papa Francisco).* Jesús, en la última frase del Evangelio lo afirma así: *“Él no es un Dios de muertos, sino de vivos, y todos viven por él” (Lucas 20,38).* Ojalá que entendamos este mensaje de la vida eterna. ©LPi

Las lecturas de esta semana nos invitan a contemplar la pregunta: ¿qué es exactamente inmortal? ¿Qué dura más allá de nuestra estancia terrenal?

Los siete hermanos y su madre cuyo martirio se narra este fin de semana en Macabeos no murieron por la letra de la ley, murieron por Aquel que dio la ley. De la misma manera, un contrato de matrimonio no se extiende a la eternidad, pero los frutos de un amor sacrificado vivirán para siempre.

Las buenas obras, la devoción, la gratitud, el desinterés, la bondad, la responsabilidad: todo esto es de Dios. Él no es Dios de muertos; Él es Dios de vivos, y estas son las cosas que duran una eternidad.
