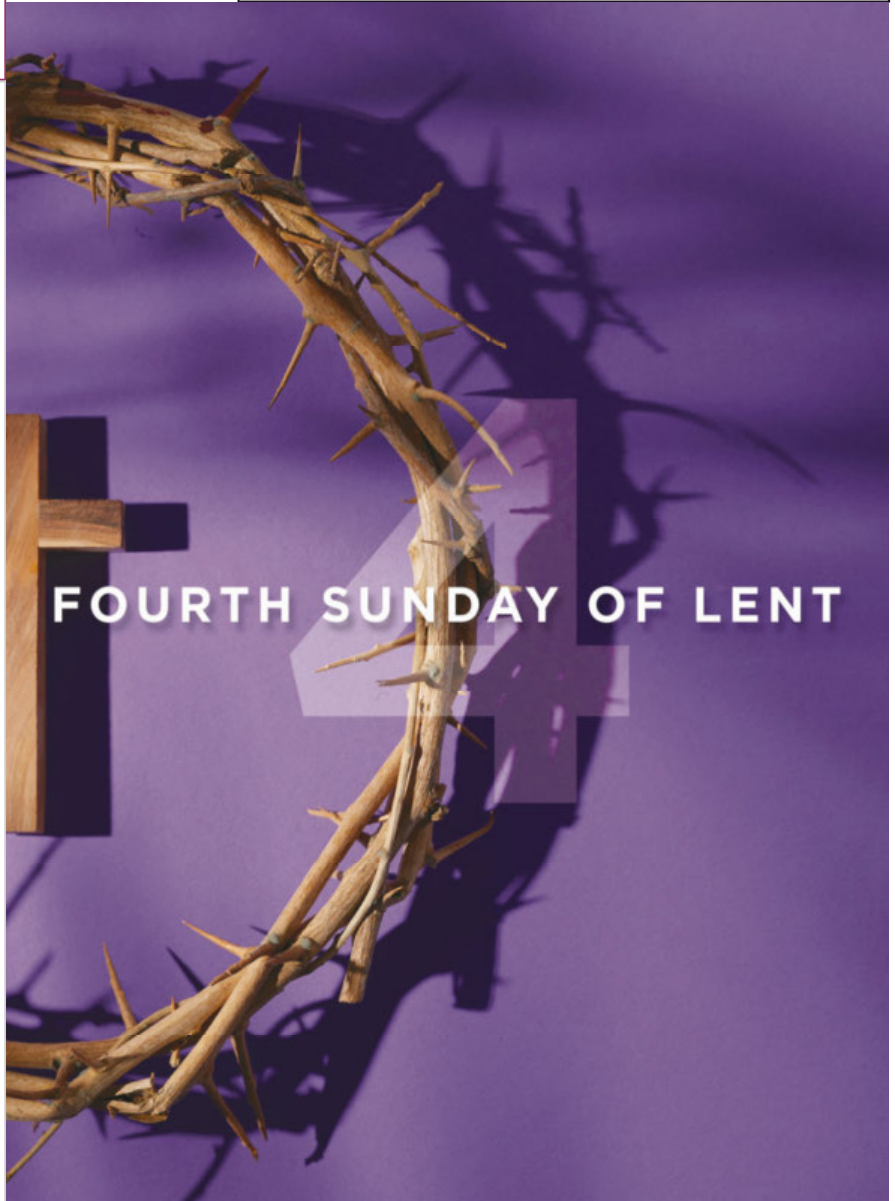

WHY DO WE DO THAT? - CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

Daily Faith

Question:

What can I do to help our family practice our faith each day?

Answer:

Some families practice their religion together as just another event on their schedule: go to church, observe Lent, help at the parish picnic, go to a meeting, volunteer time, make your confession, use your envelope... But the focus needs to be on who we are—God's people, in relationship with him, loved, forgiven, and redeemed, and called to live and proclaim the Gospel. Our awareness of God's presence and our sense of mission are supported by the daily rituals, celebrations, and traditions that help us stay focused. Sharing our faith strengthens us and clarifies the beliefs and values of Christian living. Daily family practices include time for prayer—before meals, before bed, before important meetings and activities. Attend Sunday Mass together and discuss the homily afterward. Create family celebrations for holy days and holidays. Make religion a regular part of your discussions. Include others, especially the elderly and the less fortunate, in your activities and charitable efforts. By applying the virtues of faith, hope, and love to each day, faith becomes part of who your family is. It influences how you act towards others, what you value, and how mindful of God you are. Faith is the leaven of life that helps all of us rise to our calling and dignity as God's people. ©LPi

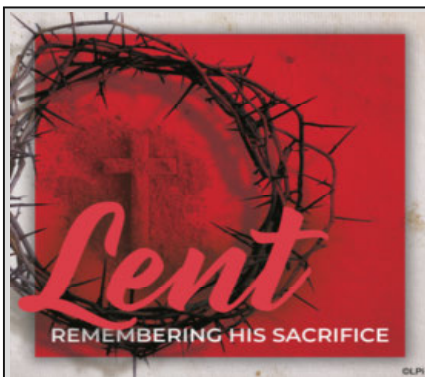

TERCER DOMINGO DE CUARESMA:

En este tercer domingo de cuaresma, se nos invita a considerar nuestro Bautismo y ver las implicancias para nuestra vida de fe. Para eso, se nos presenta en el Evangelio la imagen del agua como fuente de vida frente a la sed. Como comunidad de fe que va en camino a celebrar la Pascua, estamos invitados a reconocer de qué manera Cristo es nuestra agua viva que nos renueva de nuestras sequedades y nos da la vida en abundancia.

En el diálogo con la Samaritana, se puede simbolizar el diálogo de Jesús con la humanidad. Jesús entra en su historia, habla su lenguaje, se hace cercano y compañero de camino. Va con las "manos vacías". Jesús rompe los prejuicios y las categorizaciones de su época y ve que detrás de esas búsquedas de "aguas superficiales" hay una búsqueda de la fuente de la vida eterna. Ante la Revelación de su identidad como Mesías que viene a traer el agua viva, la Samaritana se reconoce en su realidad: sedienta, confundida y necesitada de algo más. Este estado, nos recuerda nuestra humanidad necesitada de algo que nos llene el corazón. Sin embargo, las necesidades simbolizadas con la sed, no problema para Jesús quien se presenta como el Mesías quien apagará toda la sed, con el agua de la vida eterna.

Ante Él, la Samaritana "baja las defensas" deja a un lado el escepticismo, la tristeza y la soledad. Lo reconoce como "el marido definitivo" que está esperando y como ella, estamos invitados a reconocernos, como somos, de una manera misericordiosa y compasiva y así dar testimonio ante nuestros hermanos, como hizo la Samaritana frente a los suyos, para que varios se acerquen al Señor y tengan su agua viva.
