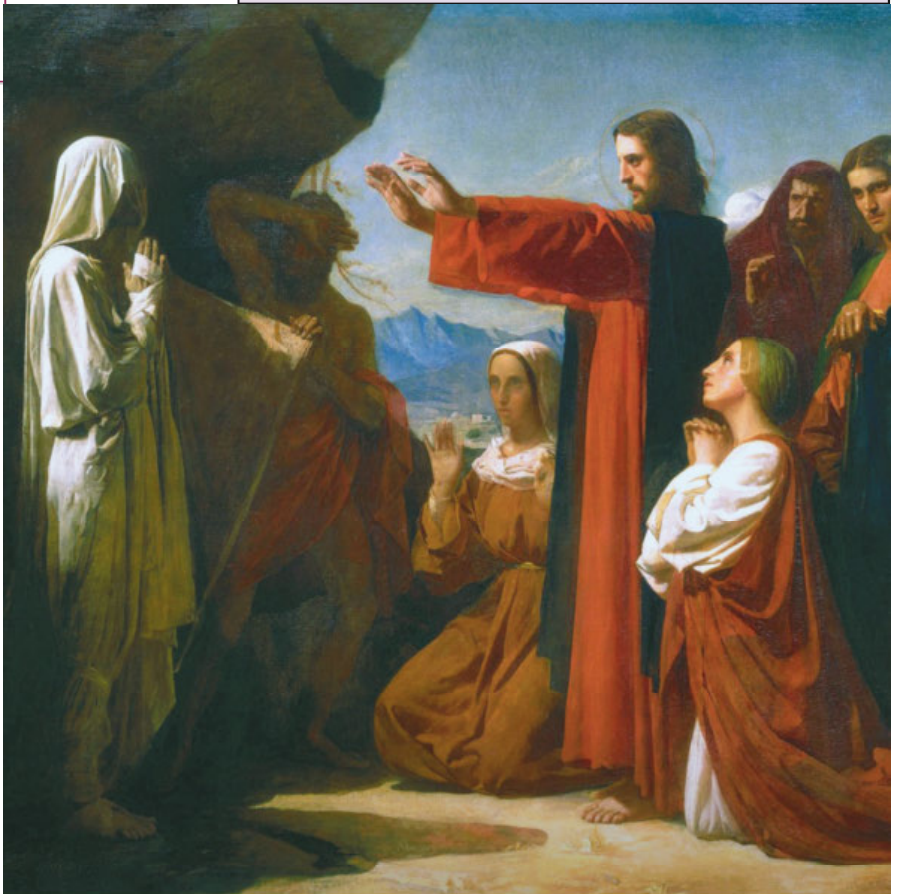

## WHY DO WE DO THAT? - CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

### Stations of the Cross

#### Question:

Who invented the Stations of the Cross?

#### Answer:

The first Stations of the Cross were walked by Jesus himself on the way to Calvary. Known as the "Via Dolorosa" ("The Way of Suffering") or the "Via Crucis" ("The Way of the Cross"), it was marked out from the earliest times and was a traditional walk for pilgrims who came to Jerusalem. The early Christians in Jerusalem would walk the same pathway that Jesus walked, pausing for reflection and prayer. Later, when Christians could not travel to the Holy Land, artistic depictions of "The Way of the Cross" were set up in churches, or outside and Christians would walk from station to station, reading the Gospel account of the Passion, or simply praying and reflecting on each event. While the content or place of each station had changed, the intention was to make a mini-pilgrimage and follow--literally--in the footsteps of Jesus.

This devotion became better known in the Middle Ages, and the Franciscans are credited with its spread. Lent is a time when many people make the Stations and some churches present Passion plays or Living Stations. But anyone can pray the Stations at any time. It is a simple and personal reflection on the passion of Jesus and what it means to us. ©LPi

## Estaciones de la Cruz viernes por la noche a las 7:00

**Evangelio: Juan (11): Nuestra victoria sobre la muerte, en Jesús**

1. Estamos en lo que podemos llamar el «climax» de nuestro evangelio. Debemos estar muy atentos, no a lo sucedido, sino a lo que se nos quiere decir o enseñar en nuestro relato. Desde luego el evangelista no duda ni un instante de que Jesús ha devuelto a la vida a su amigo Lázaro; pero ¿cómo lo interpreta y qué significa eso? No es tanto la resurrección de Lázaro lo que interesa, sino el misterio de la muerte y de la vida que tiene su fuente en la misma persona de Jesús. Se trata de lo que los hombres buscan, y de lo que Dios ofrece. Ya nos vamos in-tro-duciendo en el pensamiento de Juan y vamos conociendo su talante, que aunque mis-te-ri-o-so nos sirve mucho para conocer al Señor Jesús. Y es que Jesús no es para nosotros una fi-gura histórica que existió en un tiempo, sino que sigue existiendo y está presente en nues-tras vidas, aunque nuestra mediocridad no lo experimente a veces. Este capítulo lo debemos ver como una enseñanza poderosa sobre la muerte y la re-su-rrec-ción de Jesús que se prolonga en los cristianos. Si nos fijamos bien, no se nos quiere re-latar solamente la tradición del hecho de la resurrección de Lázaro, que se trata de una simple reviviscencia (una vuel-ta a la vida), sino aprovechar esta coyuntura para ahondar en lo que Jesús significa pa-ra la fe cristiana y muy concretamente ante el misterio de la muerte.

2. Se dice que si Lázaro está enfermo es «para mostrar la gloria de Dios» (v.4). Fi-jémonos, más que en cualquier otra cosa, en las palabras que pronuncian los personajes y, sobre to-do, en las palabras que el evangelista ha puesto en boca de Jesús durante todo el relato. Lo mismo se nos decía en la curación del ciego de nacimiento: «para que se manifiesten las obras de Dios» (Jn 9,3). Son dos narraciones bastante semejantes. Las dos gravitan en torno a las ex-pre-sio-nes del don de Dios: la luz y la vida. En el primero, la luz verdadera, Jesús, se enfrenta con las tinieblas del pecado; la luz en los ojos del ciego no era sino el signo de la otra luz que le fue dada: la fe. Y aquí, en nuestro relato, el que regala la vida a Lázaro, está en ca-mi-no hacia la muerte. Y la vida que aparece de nuevo en el cuerpo de Lázaro no es más que el signo de la otra vida, la del creyente, la que Dios dará a todos a partir de la resurrección salvadora de su Hijo.

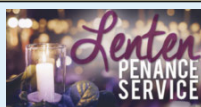
