## Profession of Faith (Nicene Creed)

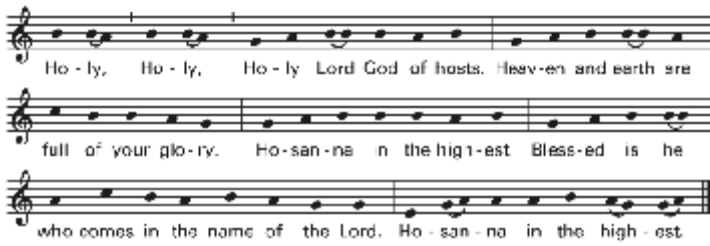

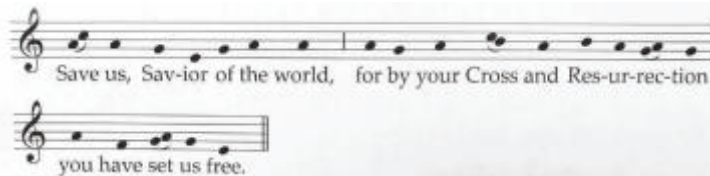

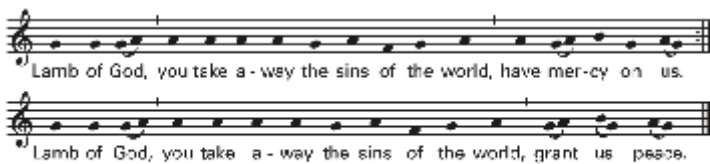

Our visits to Jesus in the Adoration chapel are starting to add up! During Advent, we are trying to give Jesus the special Christmas gift of our time, taking some quiet moments out of the holiday rush to be with him in the Holy Eucharist.

Each time someone visits Jesus in the Adoration chapel, he or she can put a piece of “straw” into the manger in the chapel. (Really they’re just short pieces of rope!) In our first week, we counted 540 visits, and by last weekend, we were up to 1140 visits. Let’s keep visiting Jesus and fill up the manger with loving visits to him!

(If you aren’t aware, our Adoration chapel is located on the back side of Saint Peter’s main church. It is open throughout the day, as well as at night with a security code, which we can give you.)

# Examination of Conscience for Adults from The National Catholic Register

## 1. I am the Lord your God. You shall not have strange gods before me.

- Do I give God time every day in prayer?
- Do I seek to love Him with my whole heart?
- Do I study Scripture and my Catholic faith?
- Have I been involved with superstitious practices, or have I been involved with the occult?
- Do I seek to follow Christ's teachings, as he teaches through the Catholic Church?
- Have I received communion in the state of mortal sin?
- Are there other "gods" in my life, such as money, security, power, popularity?

## 2. You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.

- Have I used God's name in vain: lightly or carelessly?
- Have I been angry with God?
- Have I wished evil upon any other person?
- Have I insulted a sacred person or abused a sacred object?

## 3. Remember to keep holy the Lord's Day.

- Have I deliberately missed Mass on Sundays or Holy Days of Obligation?
- Have I tried to observe Sunday as a family day and a day of rest?
- Do I do needless work on Sunday?

## 4. Honor your father and your mother.

- Do I honor and obey my parents?
- Have I neglected my duties to my spouse and children?
- Have I given my family good religious example?
- Do I try to bring peace into my home life?
- Do I care for my aged and infirm relatives?

## 5. You shall not kill.

- Have I had an abortion or encouraged or helped anyone to have an abortion?
- Have I physically harmed anyone?
- Have I abused alcohol or drugs?
- Did I give scandal to anyone, thereby leading him or her into sin?
- Have I been angry or resentful?
- Have I harbored hatred in my heart?
- Have I mutilated myself through any form of sterilization?
- Have I encouraged or condoned sterilization?
- Have I participated in or encouraged sins against human life such as artificial insemination or in vitro fertilization?
- Have I participated in or approved of euthanasia?

## 6. You shall not commit adultery.

- Am I careful to dress modestly?
- Do I seek to be chaste in my thoughts, words, actions?
- Do I seek to control my thoughts and imaginations?
- Have I been impure with myself?
- Have I been impure with someone else?
- Am I living with someone (cohabitation)?
- Have I respected all members of the opposite sex, or have I thought of others as mere objects?
- Have I been guilty of any homosexual activity? (Married Persons) Have I been faithful to my marriage vows in thought and action?
- Have I used any method of contraception or artificial birth control in my marriage?
- Has each sexual act in my marriage been open to the transmission of new life?

## 7. You shall not steal.

- Have I stolen what is not mine?
- Have I returned or made restitution for what I have stolen?
- Do I waste time at work, school, and home?
- Do I gamble excessively, thereby denying my family of their needs?
- Do I pay my debts promptly?
- Do I seek to share what I have with the poor?
- Have I cheated anyone out of what is justly theirs? (creditors, companies, etc.?)

## 8. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.

- Have I lied? Have I gossiped?
- Do I speak badly of others behind their back?
- Am I sincere in my dealings with others?
- Am I critical or uncharitable in my thoughts of others?
- Do I keep secret what should be kept confidential?
- Have I injured the reputation of others by slanders?

## 9. You shall not desire your neighbor's wife.

- Have I consented to impure thoughts?
- Have I caused impure thoughts by impure reading, movies, television, or conversation?
- Do I pray at once to banish impure thoughts and temptations?
- Have I behaved in an inappropriate way with members of the opposite sex: flirting, etc.?

## 10. You shall not desire your neighbor's goods.

- Am I jealous of what other people have?
- Do I envy the families or possessions of others?
- Am I greedy or selfish?
- Are material possessions the purpose of my life?

## Father Andrew Isn't Psychic!

We always want to visit Catholics who are sick. This is one of our highest priorities. However, neither Father Andrew nor anyone on the staff is psychic!

In other words, we only know that you are in the hospital if you or one of your loved ones tell us that you are there. Or if you are suffering at home, we have no way of knowing unless you share this with us.

So if you have a loved one in the hospital who would like to be visited, or someone who is seriously ill at home, please call the parish office!

Also, make sure that they tell the hospital that they are Catholic. Did you know that when a family member is admitted into Beaufort Memorial Hospital, one of the forms given indicates whether they would like to be visited by a pastor/chaplain? If your family member fails to indicate that they are Catholic and wish to be visited and/or receive Holy Communion, then he or she will not be on the list of Catholics that our volunteers receive from the hospital.

At this time, we are looking for parishioners who are interested in making hospital visits. Please contact us at the parish office. With enough participants, you can help us reach our goal of bringing Holy Communion to the hospital each day of the week!
