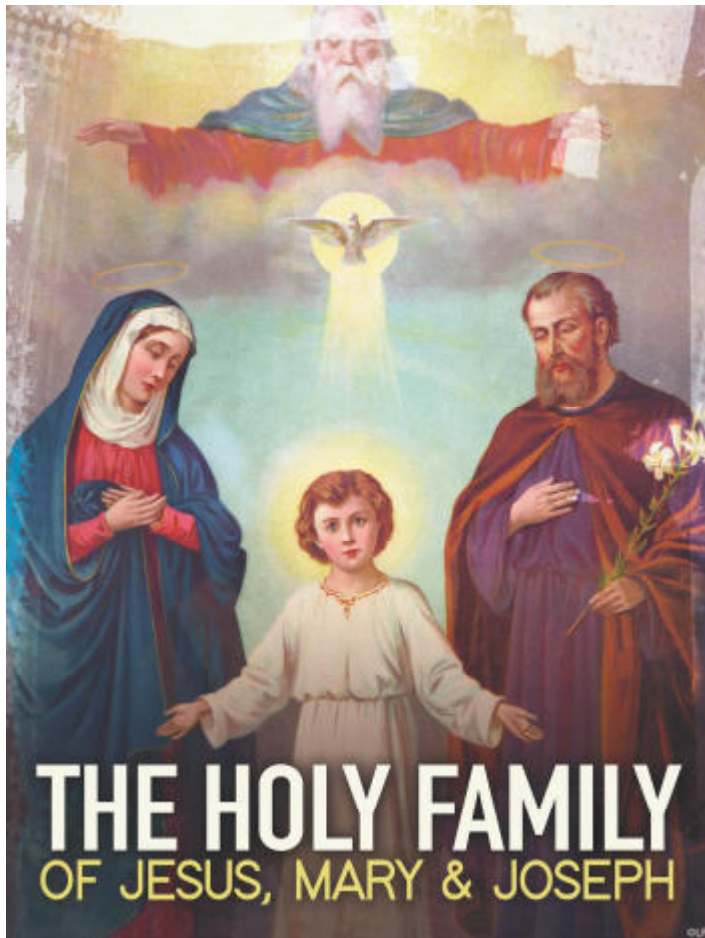

Gospel: Luke 2:41-52

“Why were you looking for me? Did you not know that I must be in my Father’s house?”

Gospel Teaching:

In this Sunday’s Mass, we celebrate the Feast of The Holy Family and hear the only story in the Gospels (apart from the infancy narratives) that includes all the family members – Jesus, Mary and Joseph. We hear of a family that celebrated the Jewish feast days in a devout manner, by traveling to Jerusalem. We hear that the 12 year old Jesus stays behind when the feast is over to learn more about the Law. The quote above shows that Jesus was aware of his divine nature, but he also understood that he was part of a human family when, “He went down with them and came to Nazareth, and was obedient to them”. There are duties within the family – parents teach and protect their children; and children honor their father and mother.
