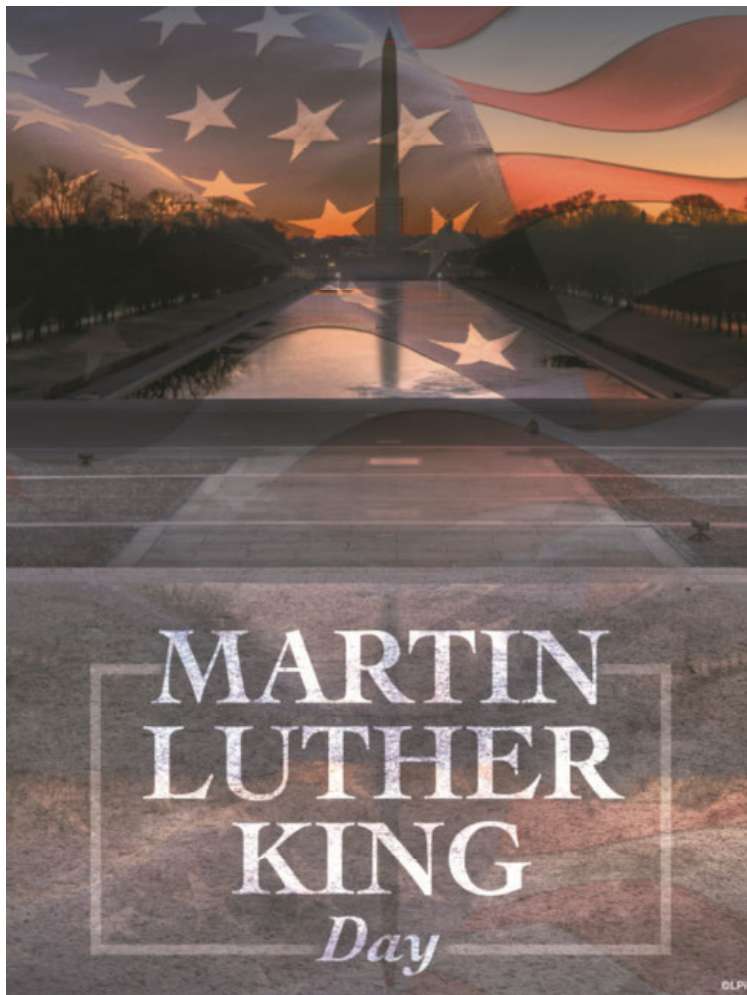

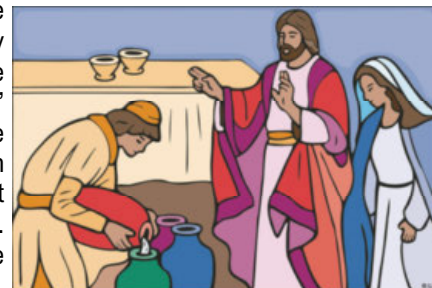
In all the dioceses of the United States of America, January 22 (or January 23, when January 22 falls on a Sunday) shall be observed as a particular day of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion. The liturgical celebrations for this day may be the Mass "For Giving Thanks to God for the Gift of Human Life" (no. 48/1 of the Masses and Prayers for Various Needs and Occasions), celebrated with white vestments, or the Mass "For the Preservation of Peace and Justice" (no. 30 of the Masses and Prayers for Various Needs and Occasions), celebrated with violet vestments (General Instruction of the Roman Missal, no. 373).

Gospel Teaching:

At the start of Jesus' ministry, he attends a wedding feast at Cana. We know the story of how Jesus is reluctant to do anything about the lack of wine that his mother told him about. But at the urging of Mary, Jesus does provide wine. Not a little, but an abundance of wine. The amount of wine that was provided was between 120 to 180 gallons. Much more than was needed. If we follow the words above that Mary said to the servers, we will also receive Jesus' gifts in abundance. The Gospels provide us with many lessons on what Jesus is telling us to do. Have we done what He wants us to do?

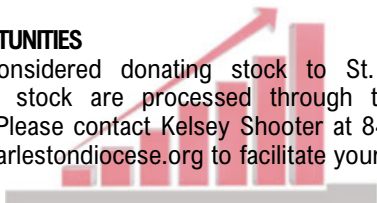

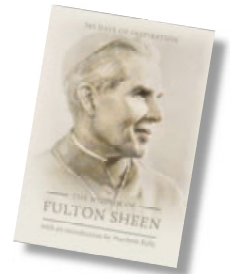

Holocaust Remembrance Day Commemoration

We are fortunate to have Ms. Suzanna Eibuszyc, author of "Memory is Our Home," present a two-part discussion of her family's experiences for us. The presentations will be on January 25 and 26, from 10:30am until 11:30am in the St. Francis Family Center.

The first day will include a short history of Poland, focusing on WWI and the interwar period, WWII including what was happening in Poland as well as Hitler and Germany and the ghastly reality of the Holocaust. Ms. Eibuszyc will also read a few passages from her book.

The second day focuses on Soviet Russia, Marxism, Communism, Stalin, and the Ukraine Famine as well as her mother's survival throughout Stalin's Russia and Uzbekistan. The talk will include the Soviet slave labor system in the Gulags and her uncle as a prisoner for two years in that system. The talk ends in the Middle East.

Both days will include time for questions and answers.

2º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Con la fiesta de la Epifanía y el Bautismo del Señor se cierra el Tiempo de Navidad, que siempre es precedido por el Adviento. Ahora, comenzamos el Tiempo Ordinario. Serán siete domingos de este corto periodo, que termina el día anterior al Miércoles de Ceniza. La segunda etapa de este Tiempo es más larga, da comienzo después del domingo de Pentecostés y termina hasta el sábado antes del primer domingo de Adviento. ¿Para qué sirve a los cristianos este Tiempo Ordinario? ¿Qué nos pide la Liturgia de este tiempo? Pues, es muy sencillo, nos pide meditar en el misterio de Cristo. En su invitación de participar en su Reino con alegría y compromiso verdadero. La Iglesia tiene diversidad de carismas, donde podemos entregarnos al servicio de los demás.



Por ejemplo, hoy el Evangelio nos invita a participar junto con María y Jesús en las bodas de Caná. Y es ahí en esa boda, donde Jesús hace su primer milagro a petición de su Madre María. El diálogo de ambos viene a ser a causa de la falta de vino. Por lo tanto, los novios estaban en apuros por esta razón. Este relato es muy profundo, el hecho de que Jesús participa en la boda, tiene como significado la boda de Dios con la humanidad, que más adelante será la Sangre de Jesús derramada para la salvación de la humanidad. “Alegrémonos, regocijémonos démosle honor y gloria, porque han llegado las bodas del Cordero” (Apocalipsis 19,7). También, el profeta en la primera lectura lo pone claro: “No te llamaran más ‘Abandonada’, ni a tu tierra ‘Desolada’, sino que te llamaran ‘Mi Preferida’ y a tu tierra ‘Desposada’. Porque Yavé se complacerá en ti y tu tierra tendrá un esposo” (Isaías 62,4).

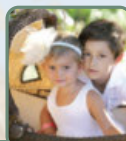
