

"The Ascension of Jesus into heaven," Pope Francis said, "acquaints us with this deeply consoling reality on our journey: in Christ, true God and true man, our humanity was taken to God. Christ opened the path to us. If we

entrust our life to him, if we let ourselves be guided by him, we are certain to be in safe hands, in the hands of our Savior." This is why, as Pope Benedict XVI wrote, it would be a mistake to interpret the Ascension as "the temporary absence of Christ from the world." Rather, "we go to heaven to the extent that we go to Jesus Christ and enter into him." Heaven is a person: "Jesus himself is what we call 'heaven."

St. Joan of Arc (1412 – 1431) has had her story told throughout history through many books, movies and plays. She was born in the village of Domrémy, near the province of Lorraine, to a French peasant family. At a young age, she began to experience visions and voices, which were later identified to be of St. Michael, St. Catherine of Alexandria, and St. Margaret of Antioch. At the age of 13, all three saints told her that she was to drive the English from French territory, and that she must bring the Dauphin to Reims for his coronation. Trusting in God, she did as she was told.

During the Hundred Years War, St. Joan of Arc led French troops against the English and recaptured the

cities of Orléans and Troyes. Captured near Compiegne the following year, she was sold to the English and placed on trial for heresy and witchcraft, eventually being found guilty and burned at the stake in Rouen. St. Joan of Arc was canonized by Pope Benedict XV on May 16, 1920, and is the patron saint of military members. © LPi

GOSPEL REFLECTION

Gospel: Luke 24:46-53 "And behold I am sending the promise of my Father upon you"

Gospel Teaching:

This week's Gospel is from the end of Luke's Gospel and has a brief description of the Ascension. The first reading today was from the beginning of Acts of the Apostles, also written by Luke, contains some additional details. Both readings include instructions to stay in Jerusalem until the coming of the Holy Spirit. The power from the Holy Spirit will allow them to preach

"in his name to all nations" that Christ had died and rose from the dead on the third day. The Apostles are his witness to these things. They are also witness to his Ascension into heaven. Repentance for our sins and asking for forgiveness can provide us with a way to gain our heavenly reward.
