



I With the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost, Christ's Paschal Mystery was brought to completion. The Holy Spirit, by his presence within us, causes

us to be true Christians—other Christs. He frees us from being "debtors to the flesh" and strengthens us with his gifts. He reconciles us to God, giving us the status of adopted sons and daughters. Saint Thomas Aquinas says that the Holy Spirit interiorly perfects our spirit, communicating to it a new dynamism so that it refrains from evil, not simply out of fear of punishment, but for love. "The first gift of love is love itself, and all the other gifts emanate from this supreme gift, as from their source. Therefore, the Gift of the love of God is the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit does not give himself to us without pouring charity into our heart" (Servant of God Luis María Martínez).

Although not one of the Twelve, Barnabas has since ancient times been accorded the title "Apostle" for his labors alongside Paul. After he recruited Paul for the mission to Antioch, the two preached in cities in Asia Minor and Cyprus. In each town, they began their preaching in the synagogue. They were repeatedly attacked and stoned by the Jews—once so severely that Paul almost died. Yet their preaching was not in vain. Returning to Antioch, they

"reported what God had done with them and how he had opened the door of faith to the Gentiles" (Acts 14:27). Barnabas was martyred in Cyprus sometime before the year 63.

GOSPEL REFLECTION

Gospel: John 20: 19-23 "Receive the Holy Spirit."

Gospel Teaching:

It may be strange to hear a Gospel on Pentecost Sunday and find that the description of the Descent of the Holy Spirt is not in it. The four Gospels deal with the life of Jesus while he was on earth, and they end at the Ascension. Luke wrote a second volume of Scripture, Acts of the Apostles, which tells us about the early church. The First Reading today was from that book and contained the events of Pentecost. But that doesn't mean that the Gospel doesn't contain a reference to the Holy Spirit.

We clearly see а reference to the Holy Spirit being the "breath of God" when Jesus breathes on them, gives them the gift of the Holy Spirit and grants them the power to forgive sin. This Gospel also contains a commissioning - "As the Father has sent me, so I send you."
